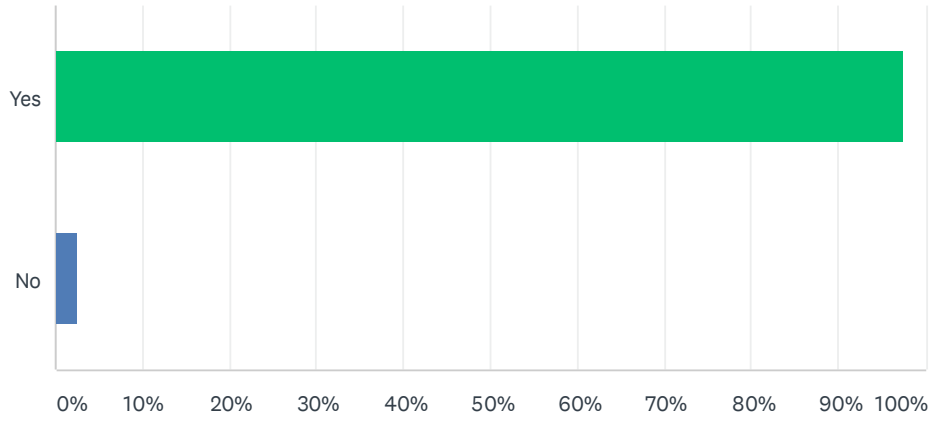


# Q1 Looking at the map on page three, do you understand the location and boundaries of the East Rome Choice Neighborhood Plan?

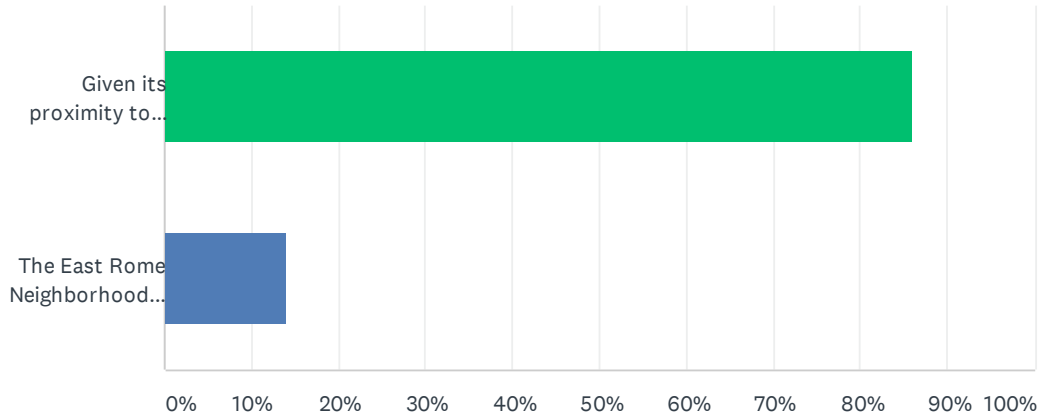

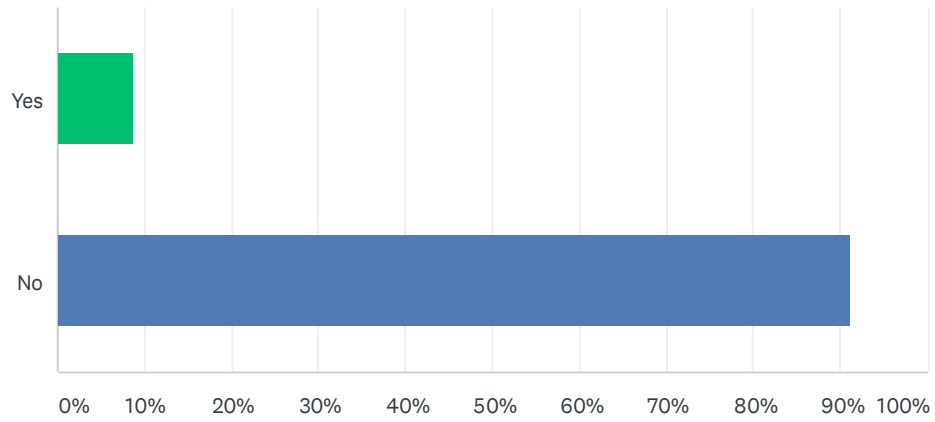

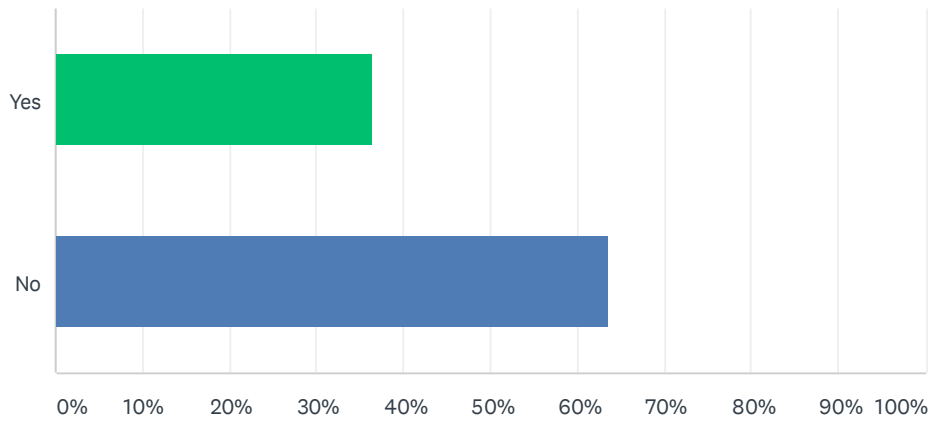

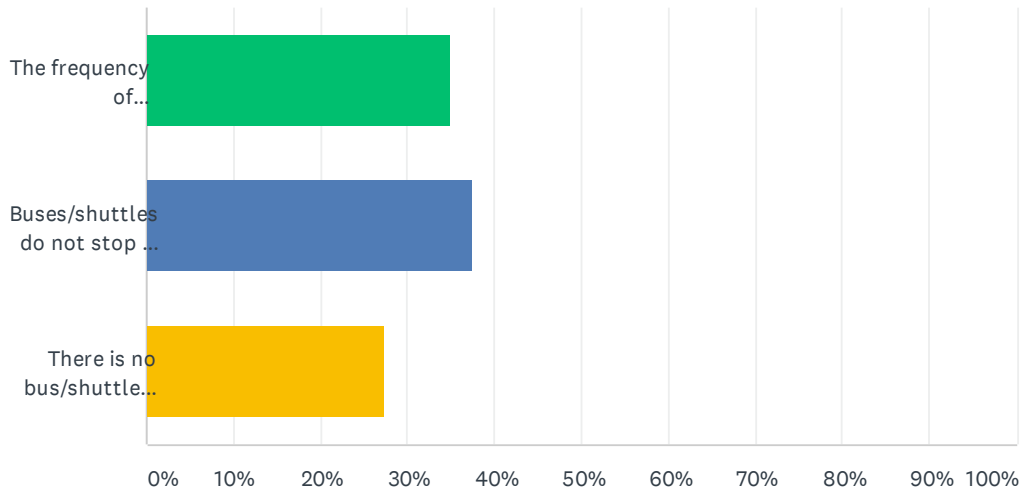

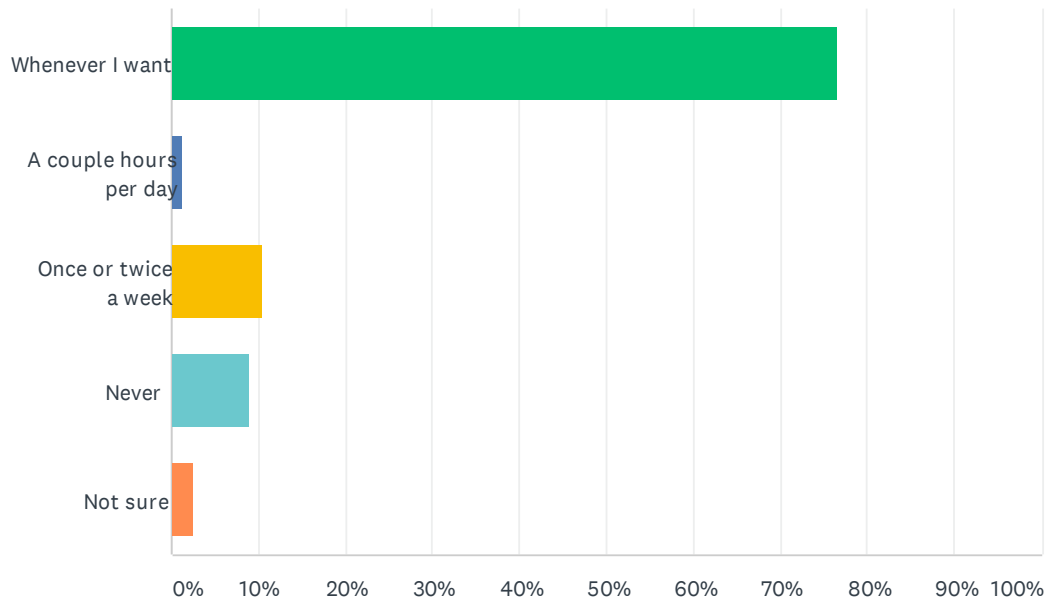

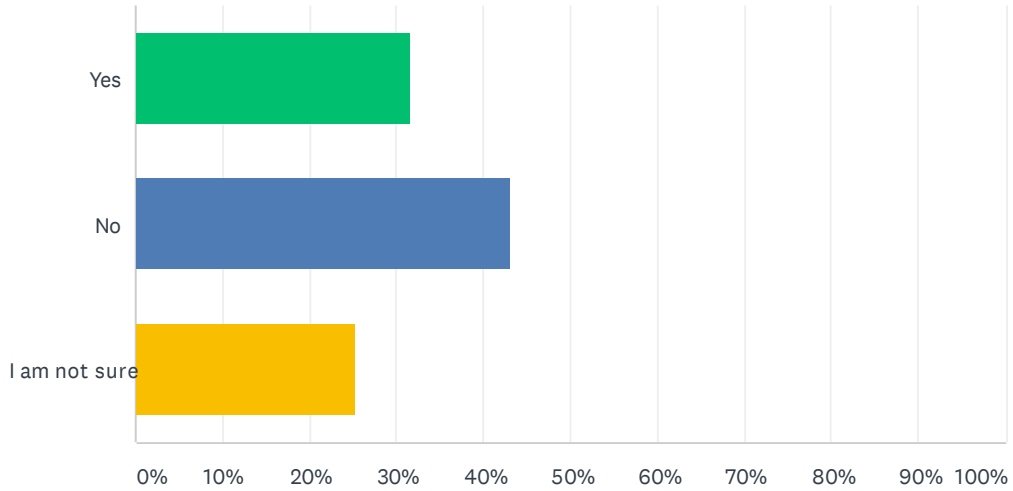

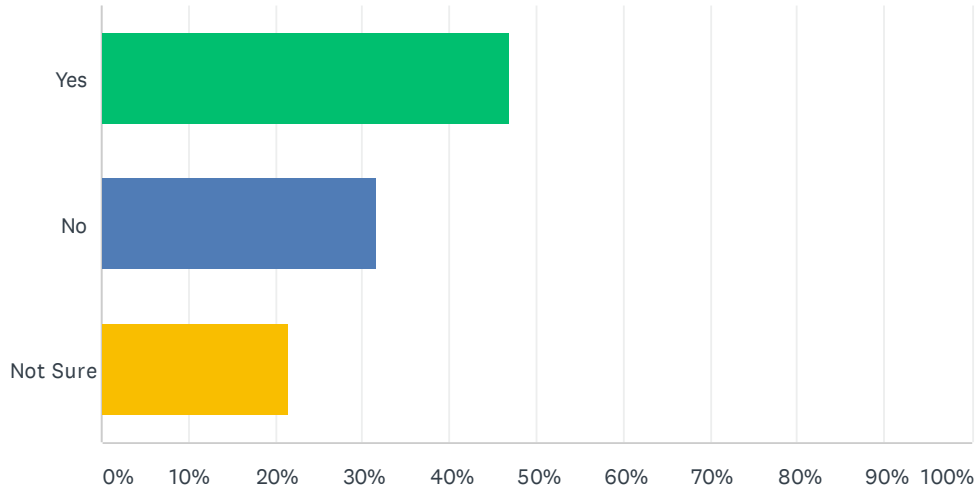

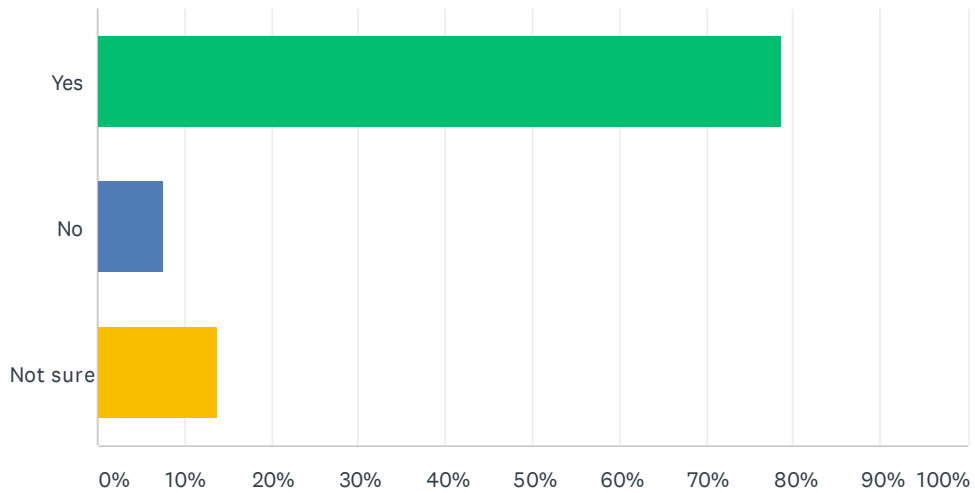

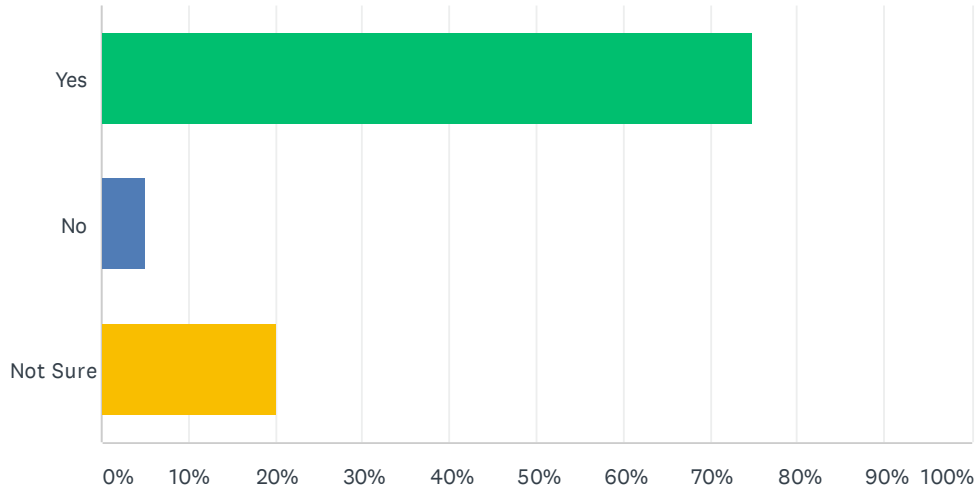

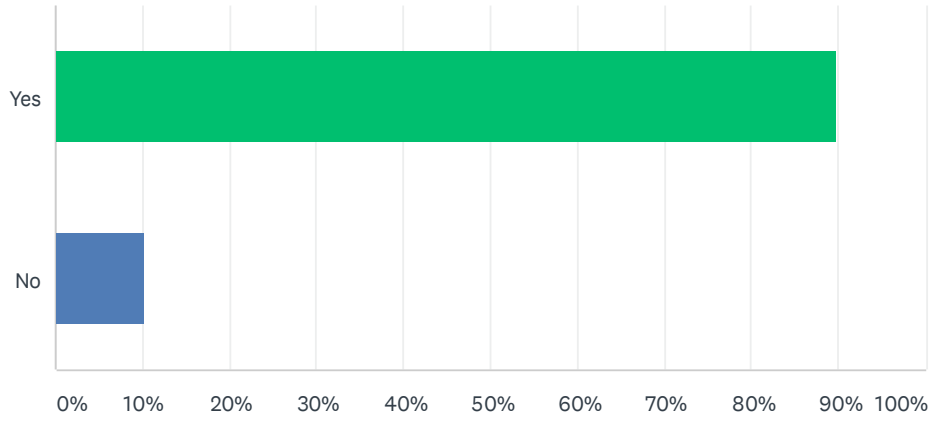

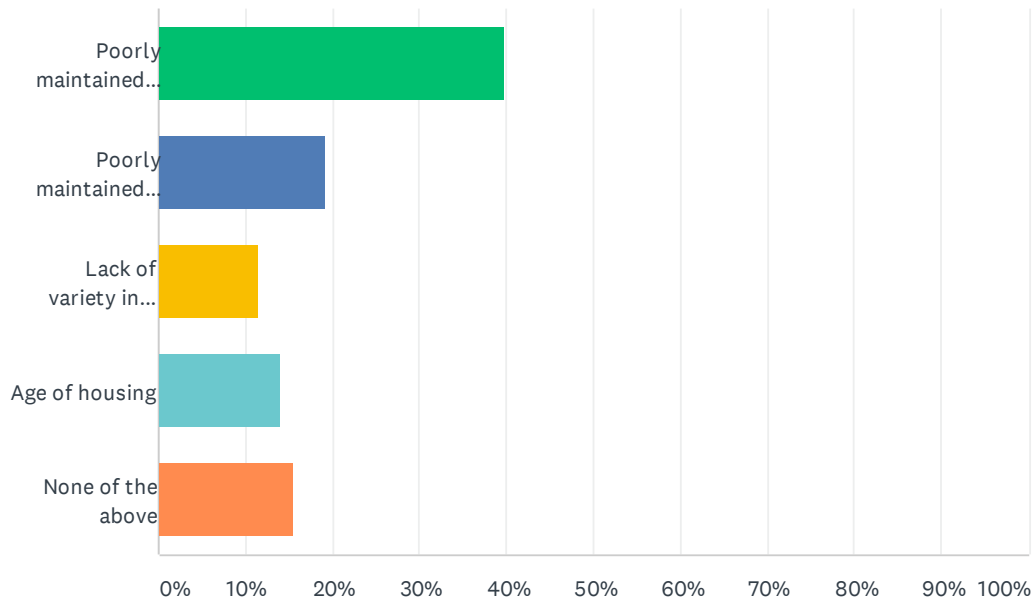

### Q17 Excluding the housing provided by NWGHA, what do you see as the biggest problem with existing housing in the neighborhood?

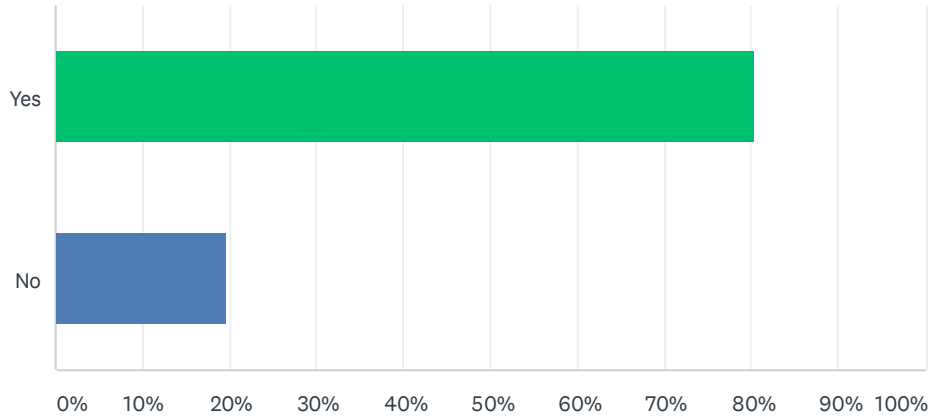

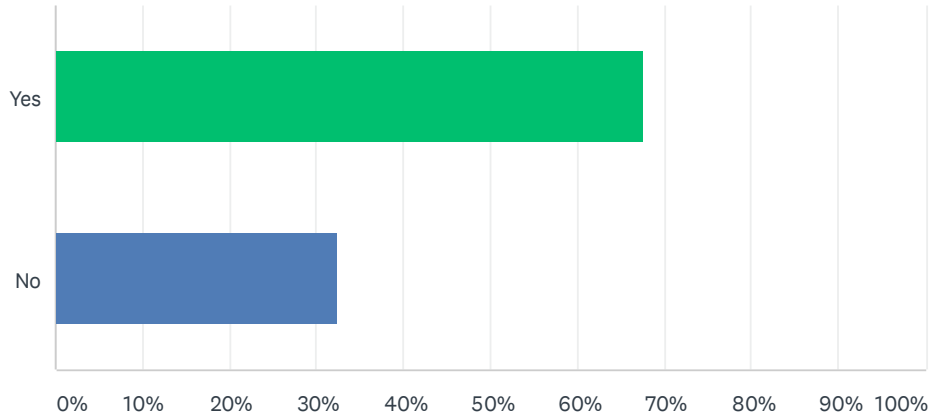

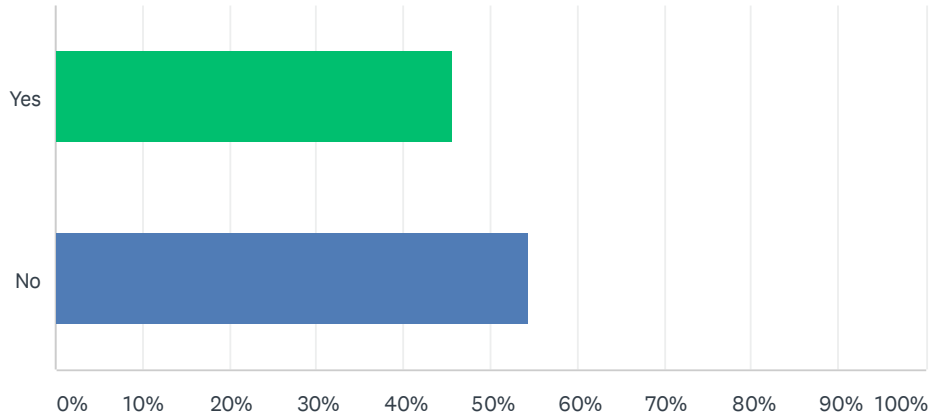

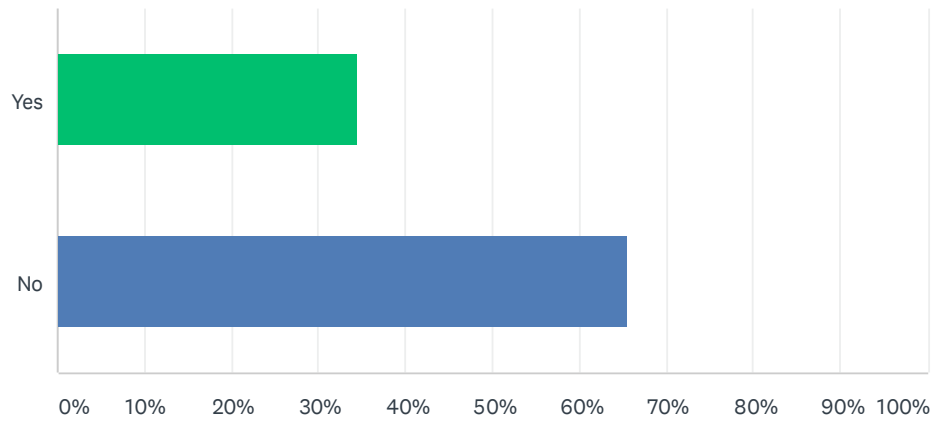

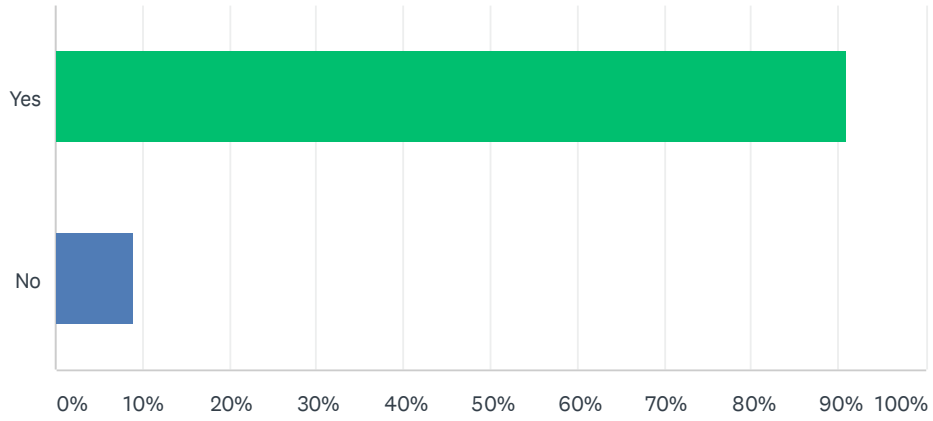

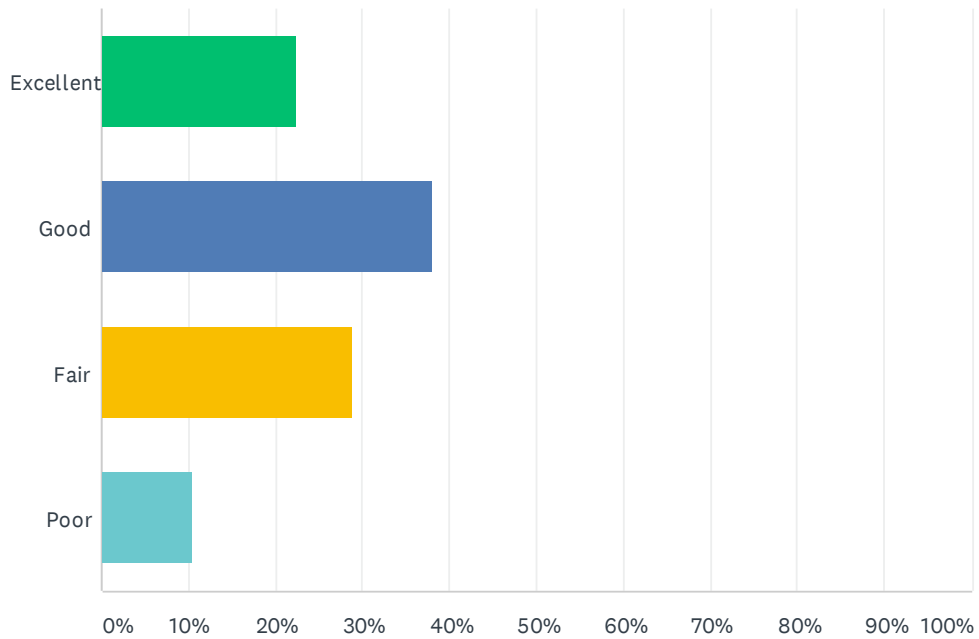

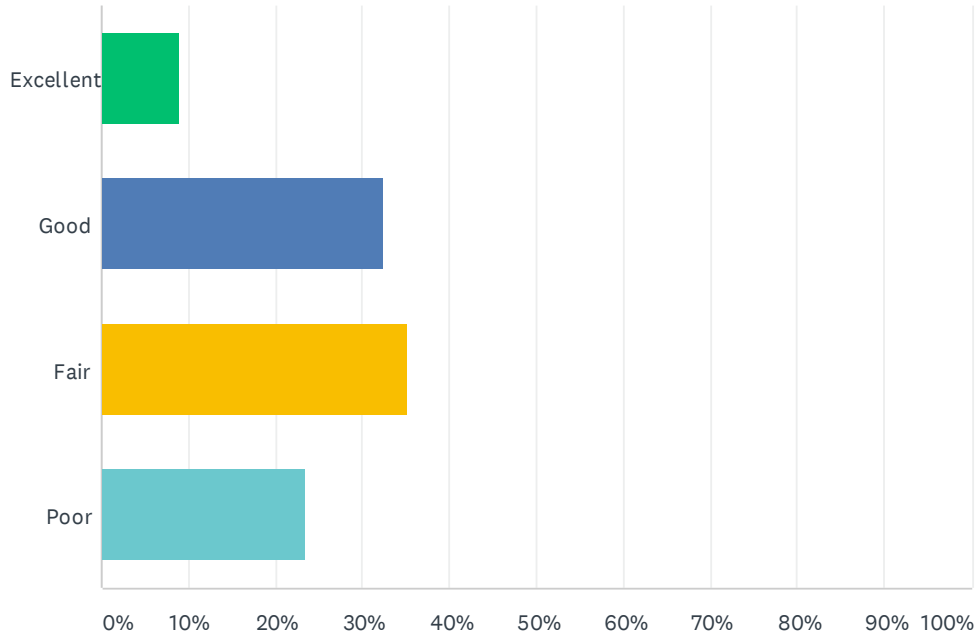

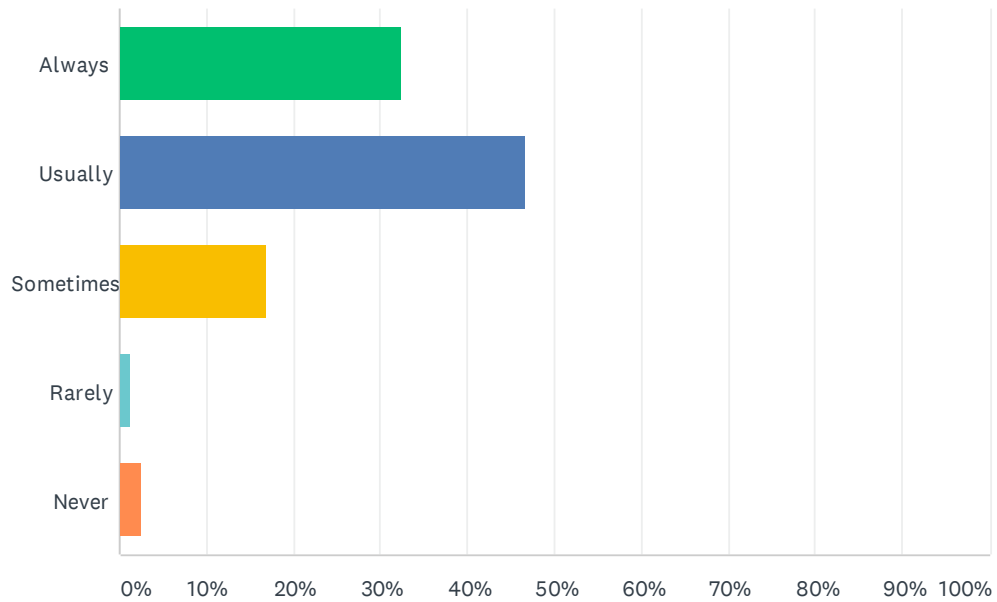

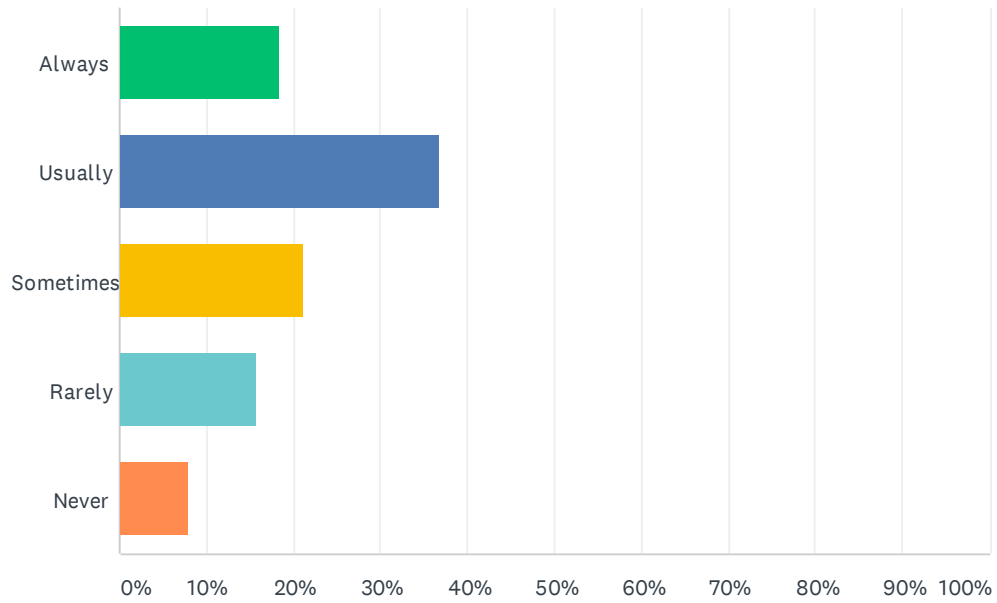

## Q29 Do you feel safe in the neighborhood outside of your home at night?

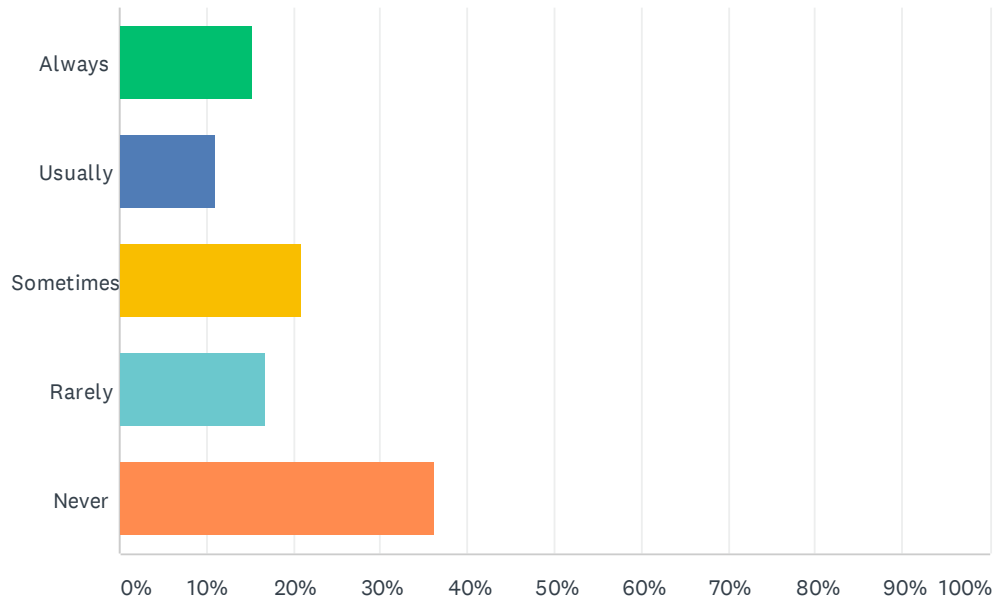

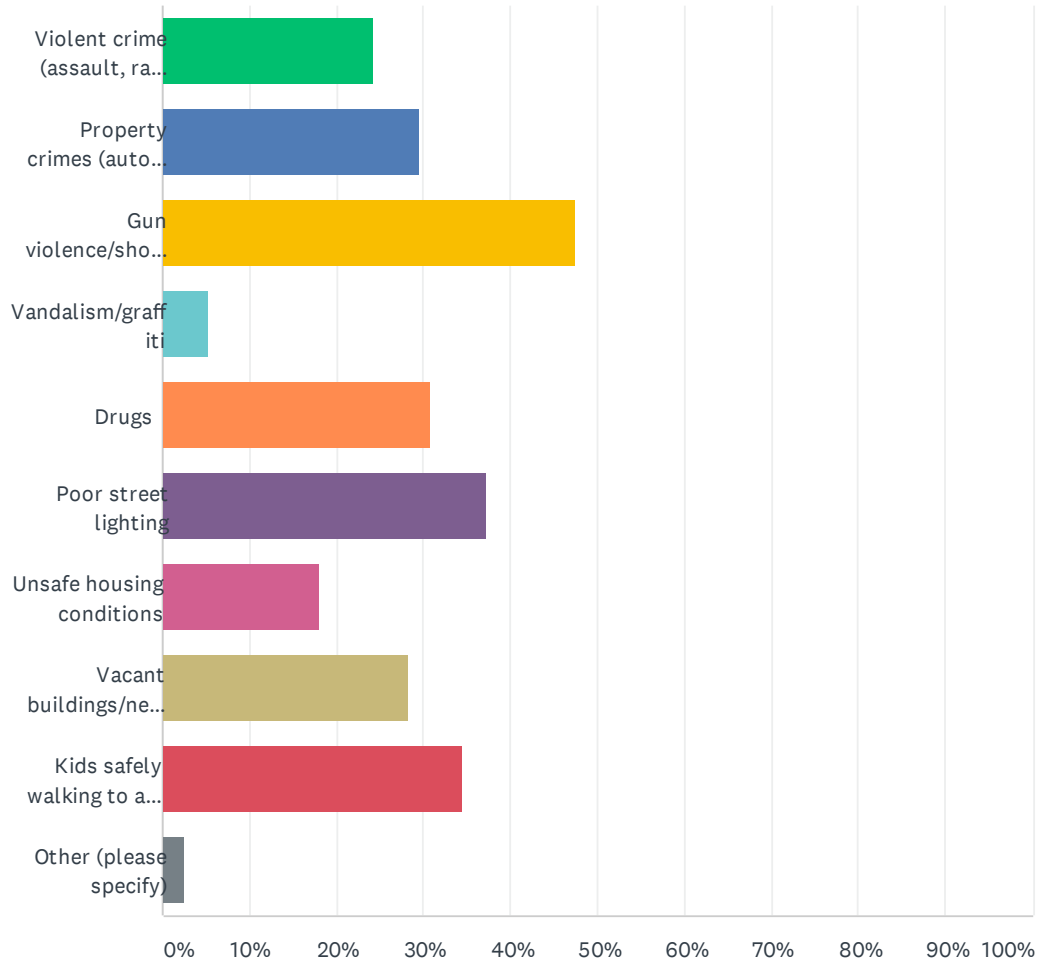

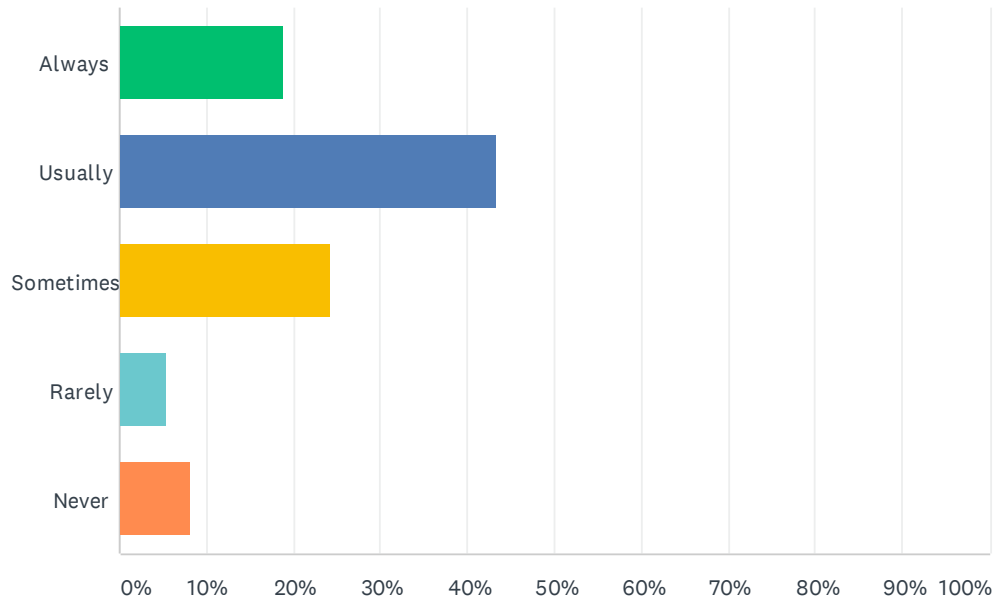

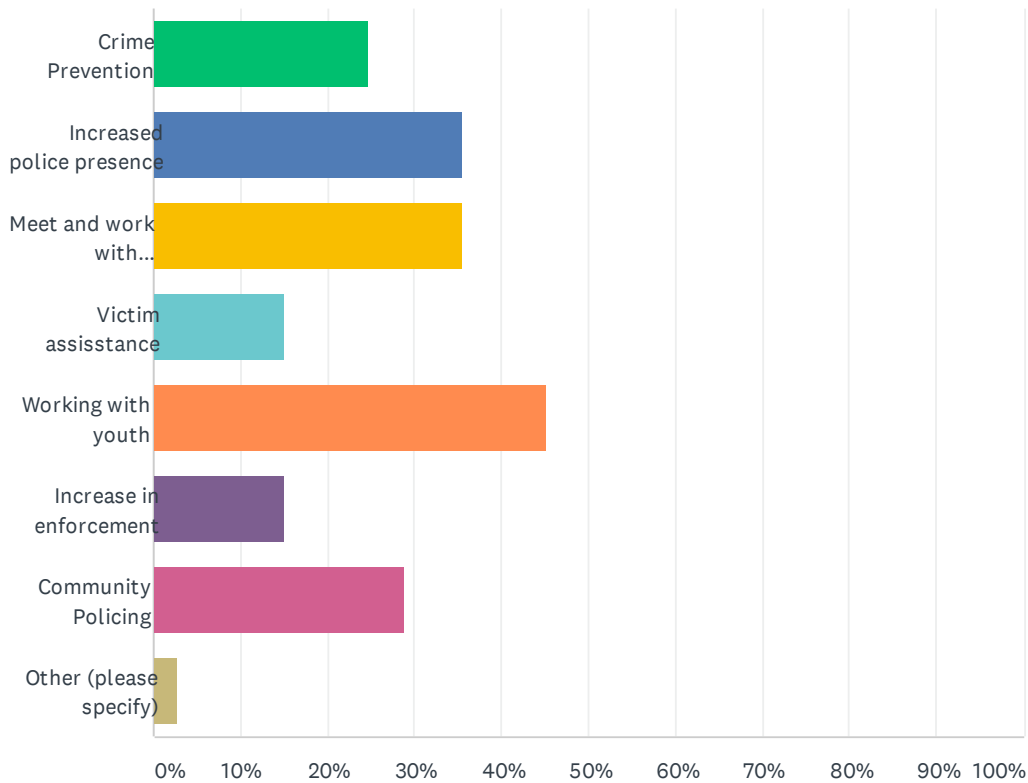

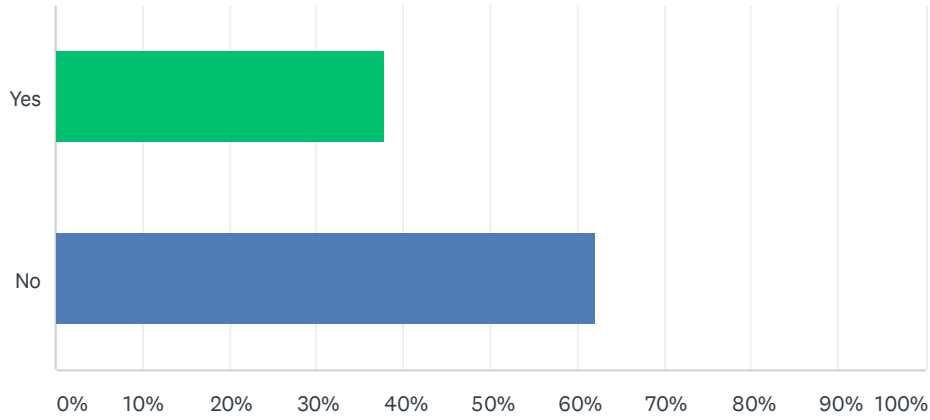

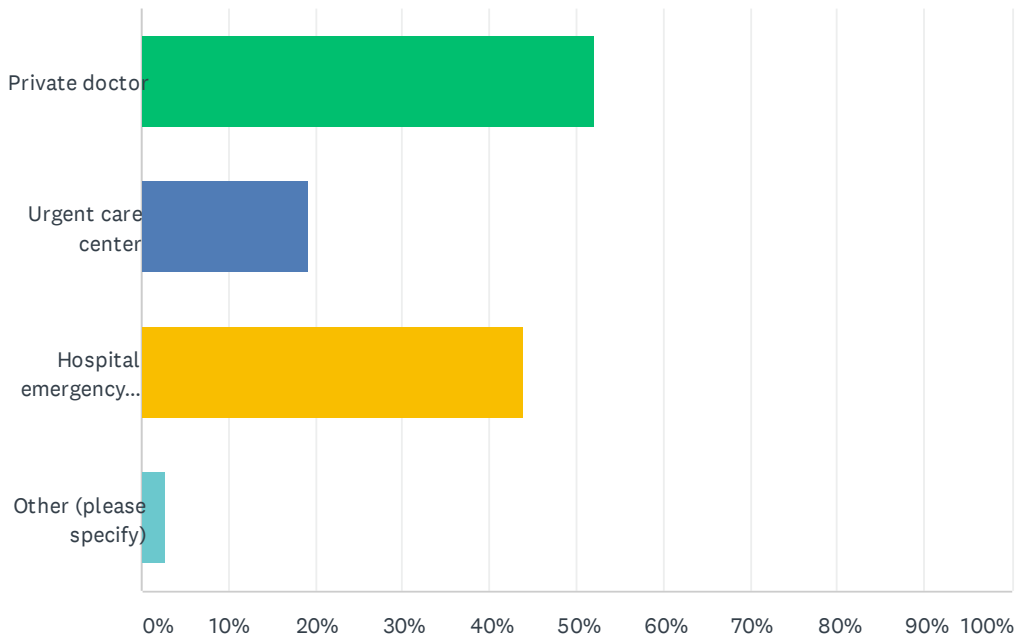

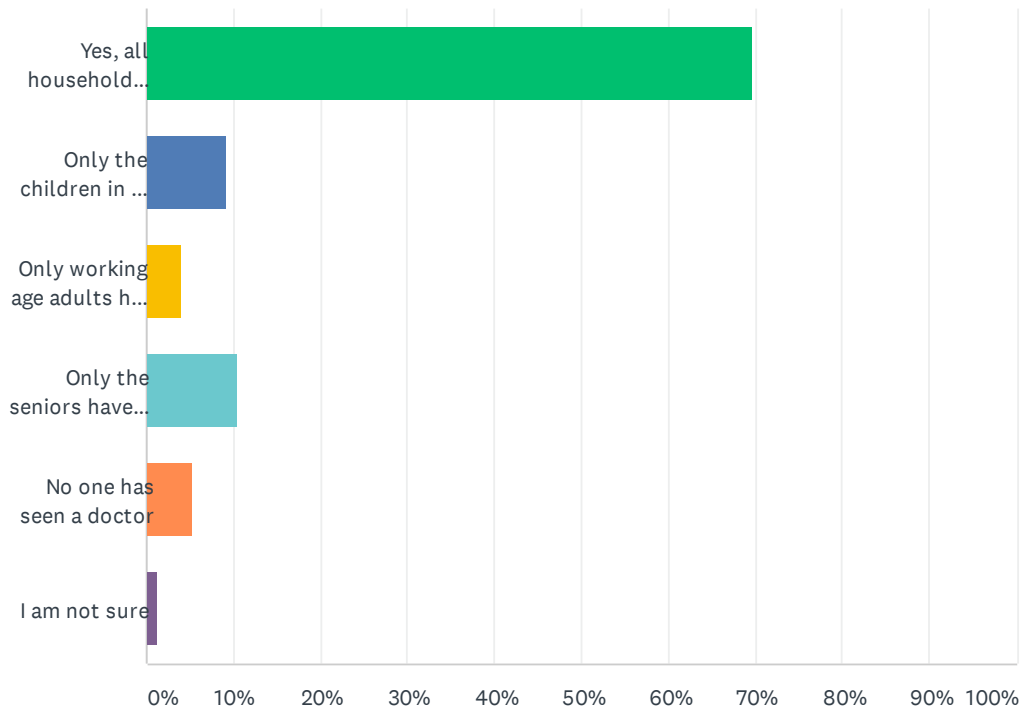

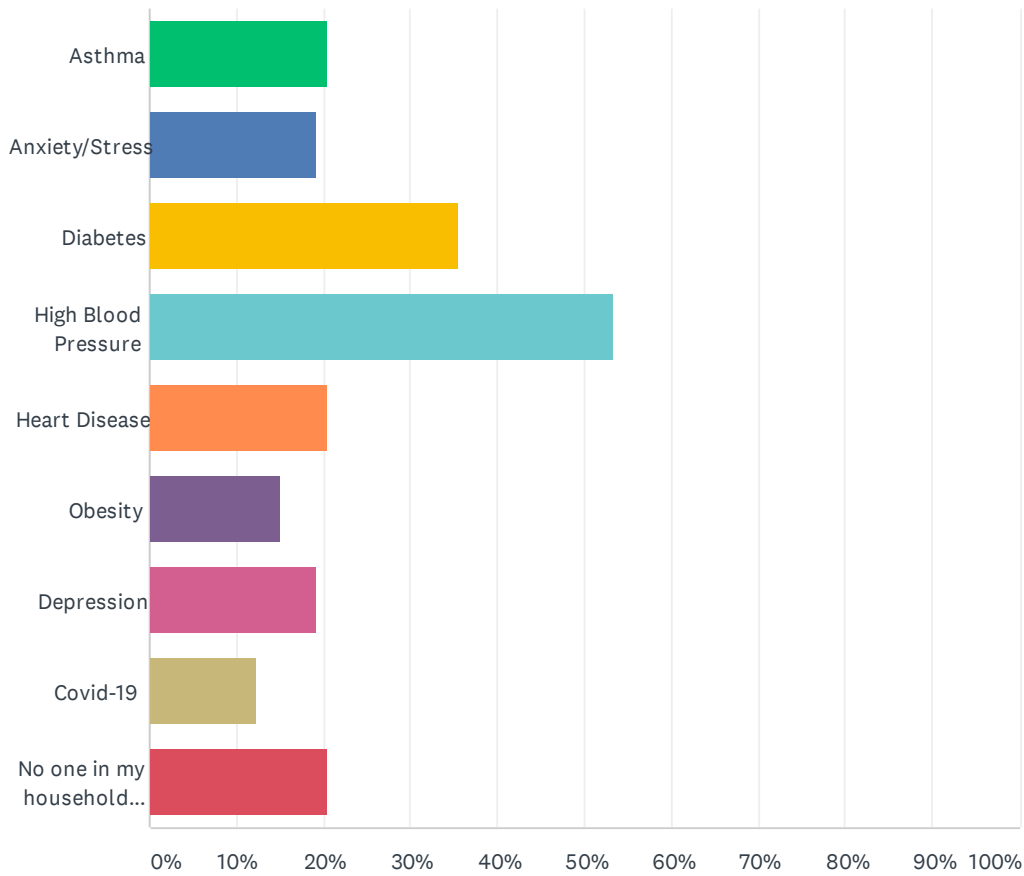

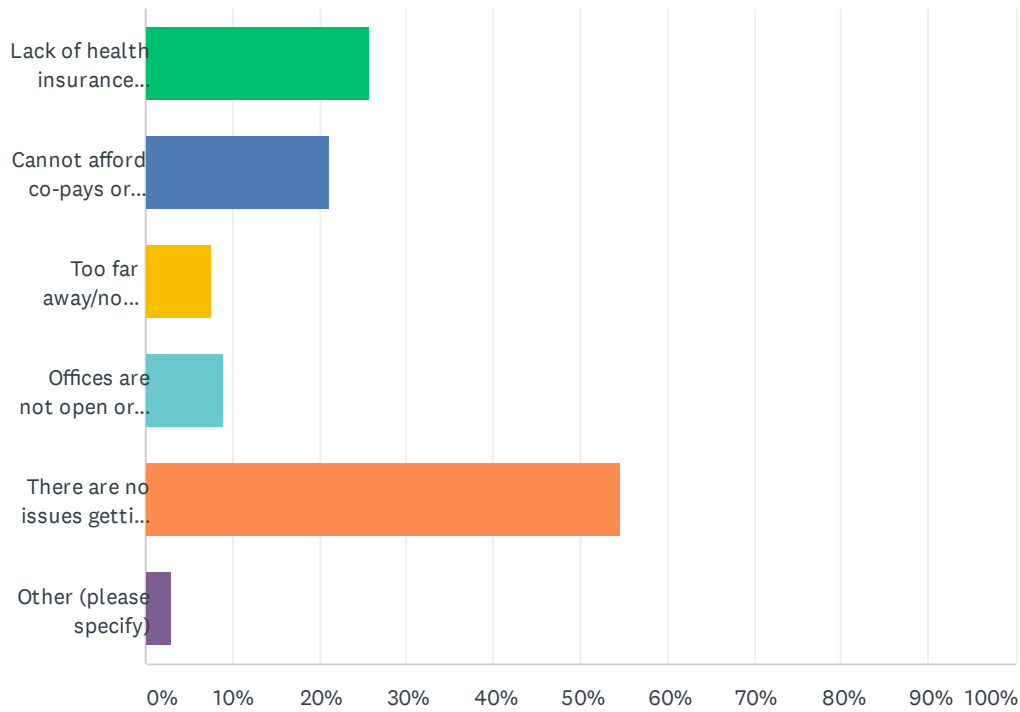

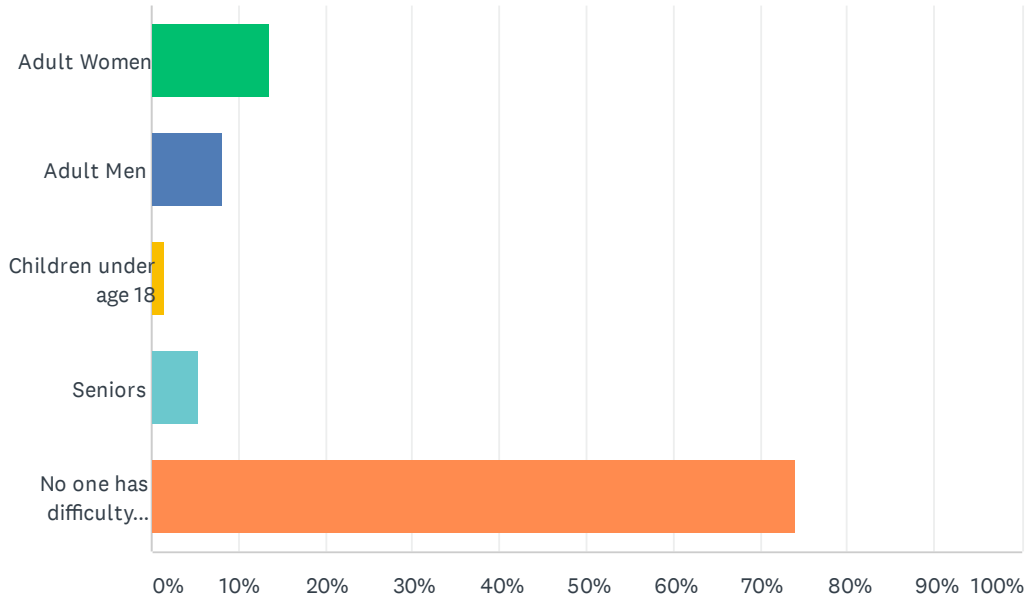

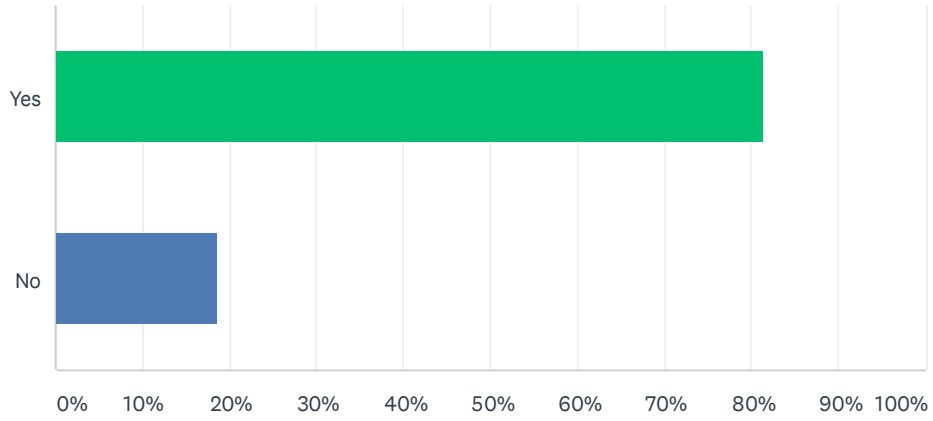

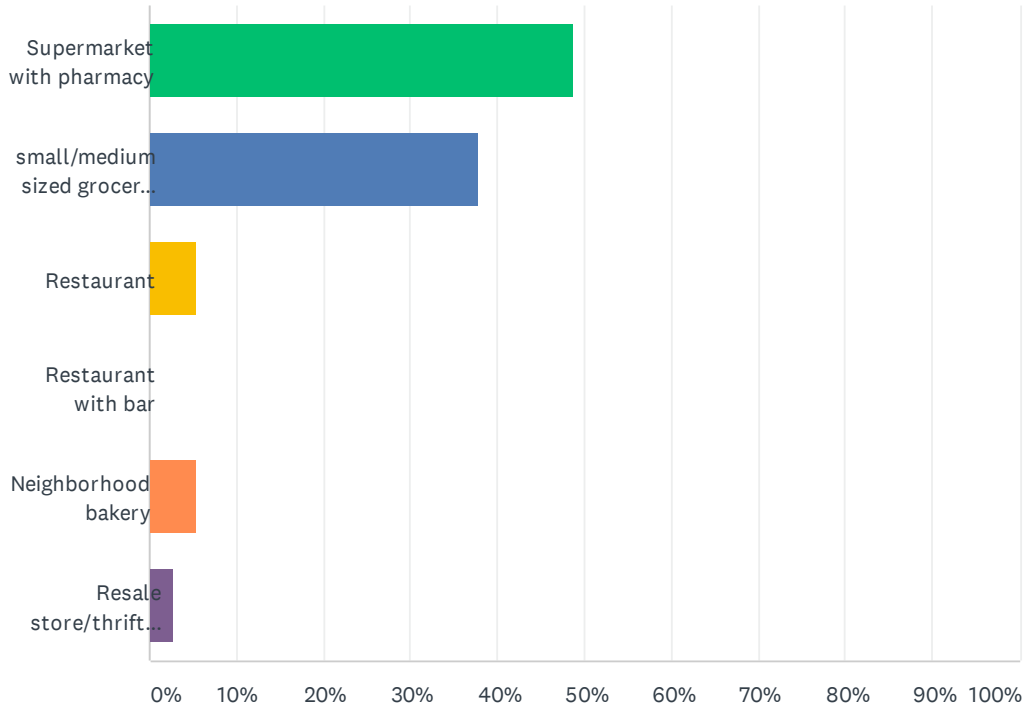

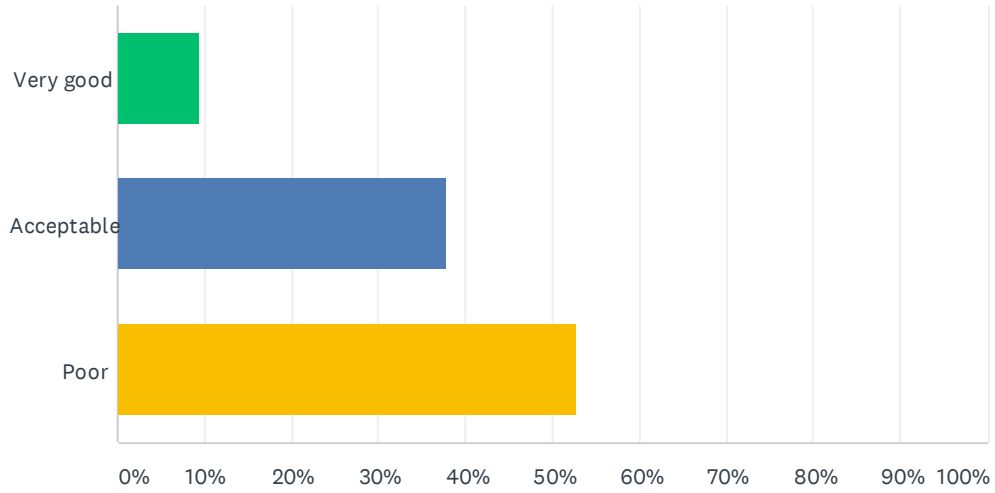

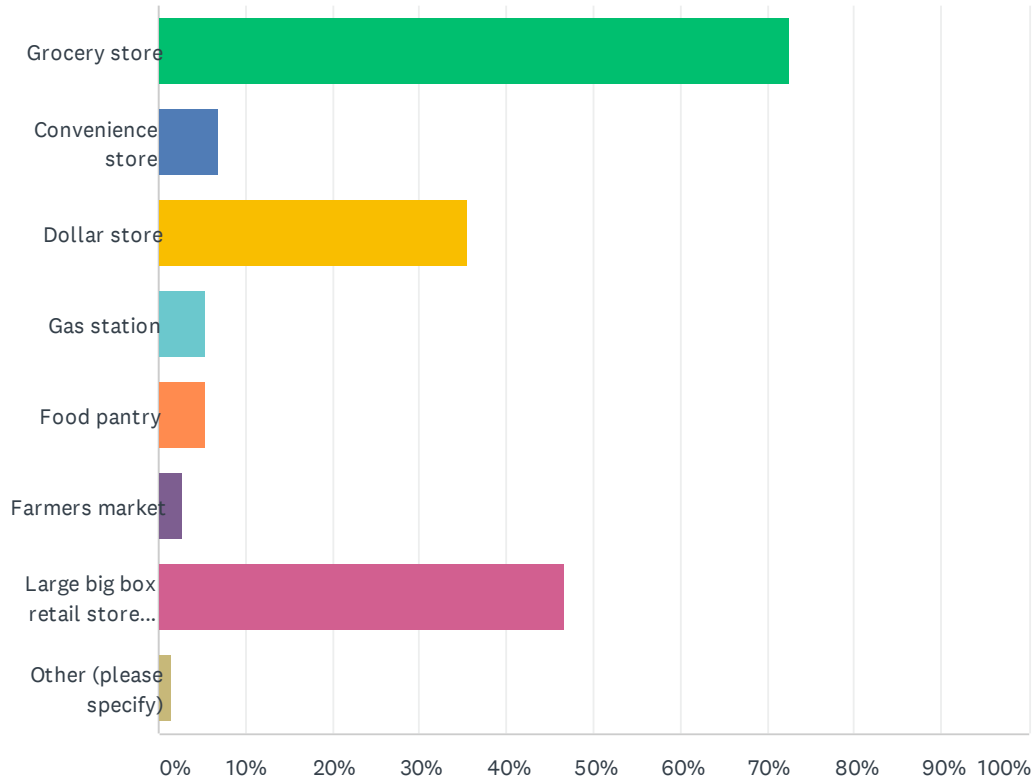

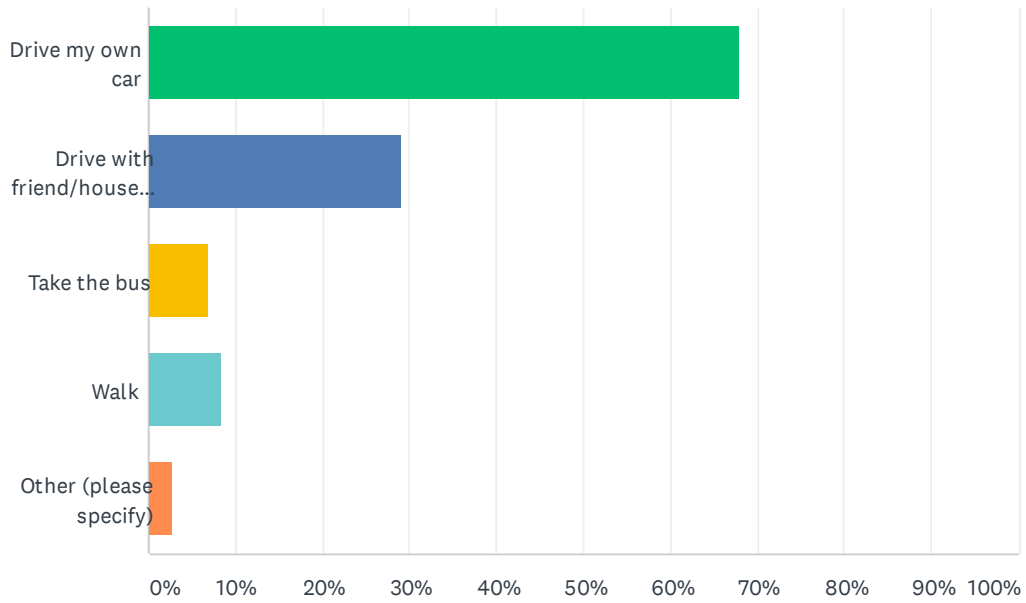

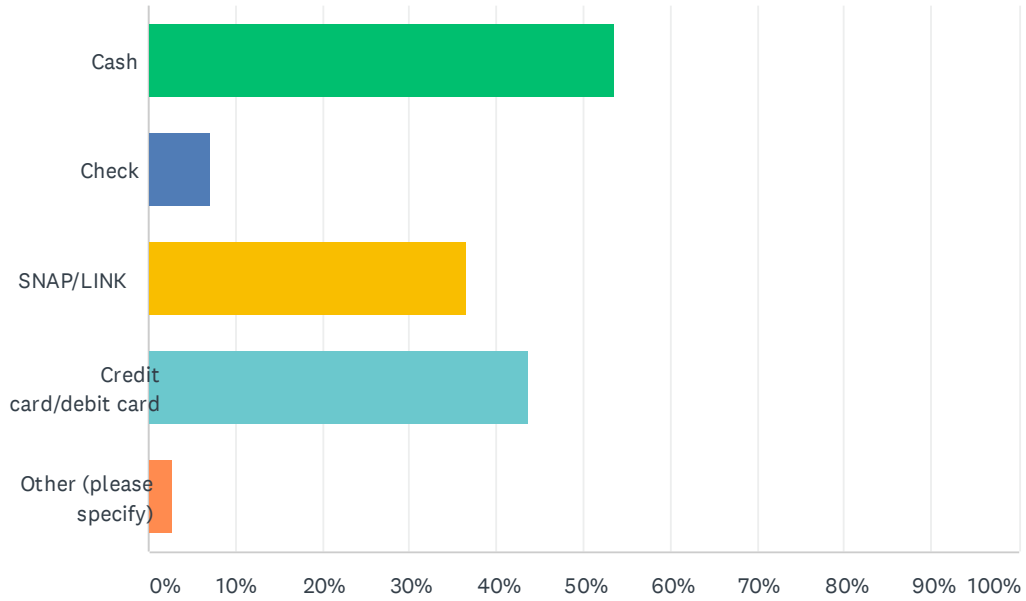

## Q47 How do you generally pay for groceries?

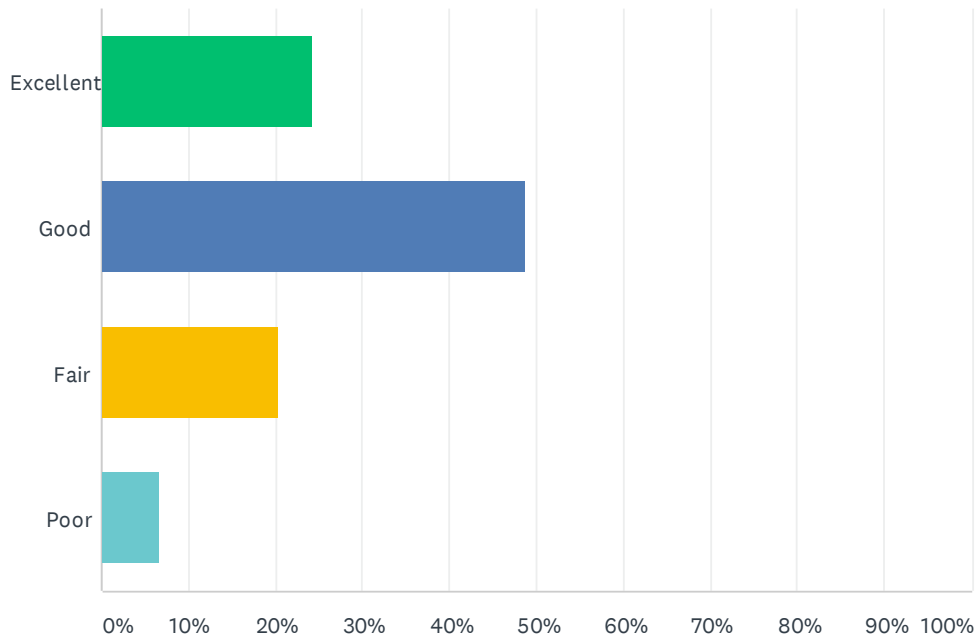

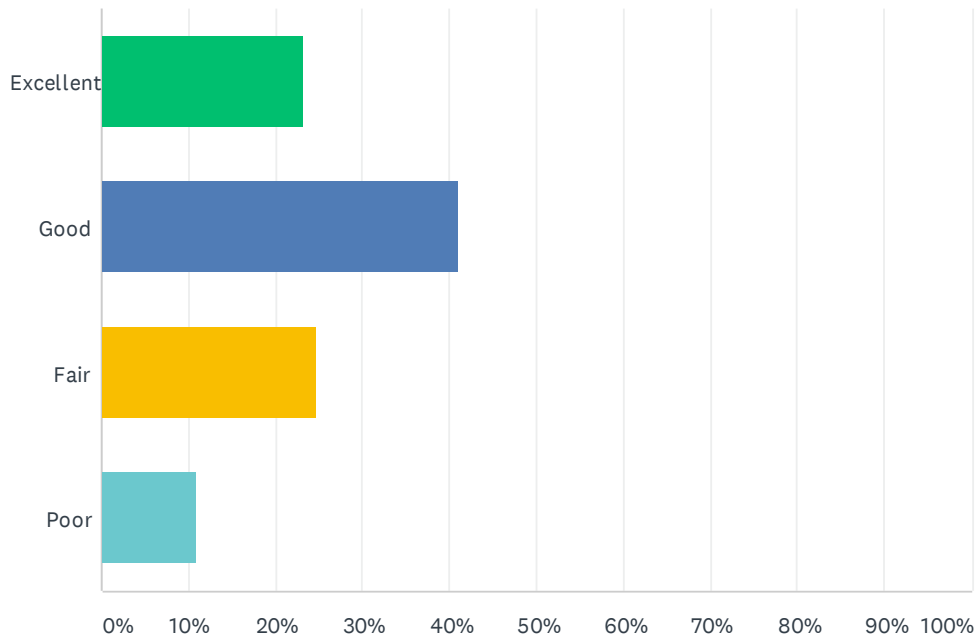

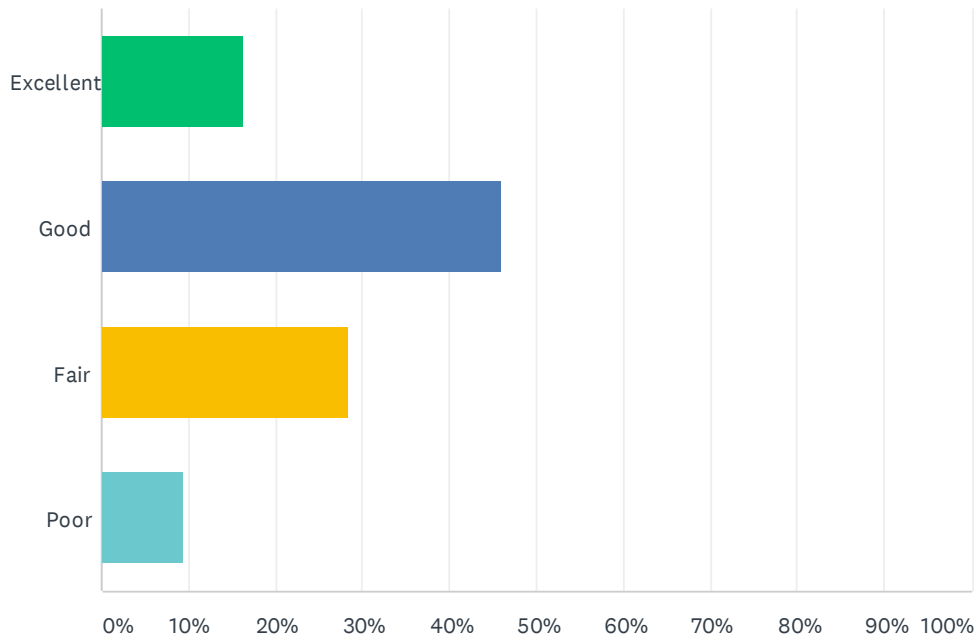

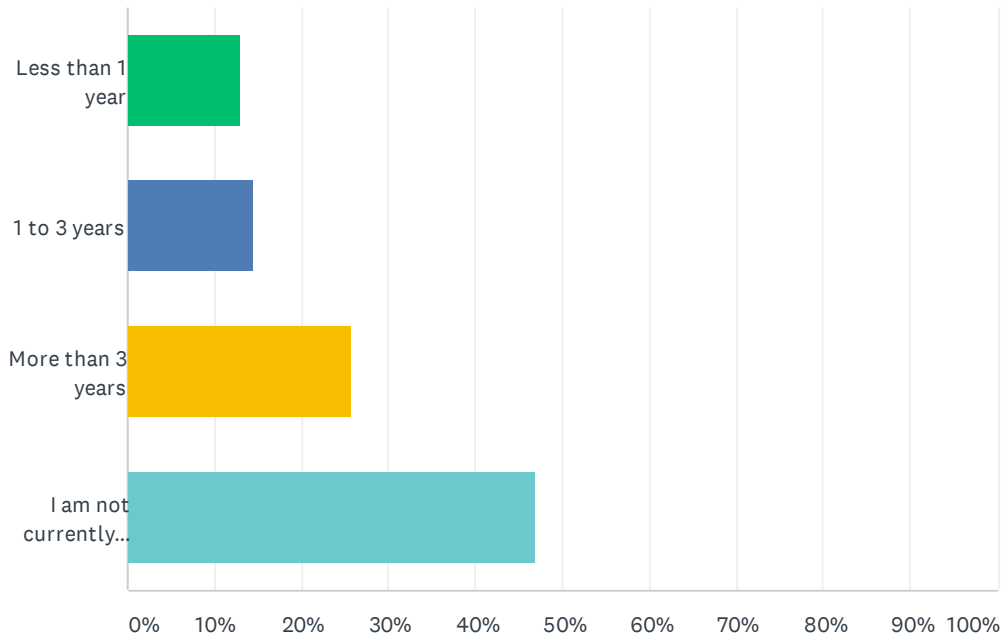

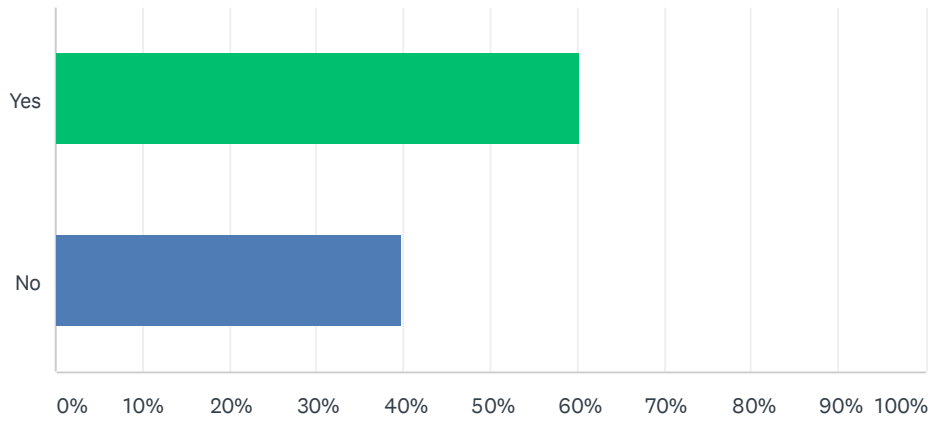

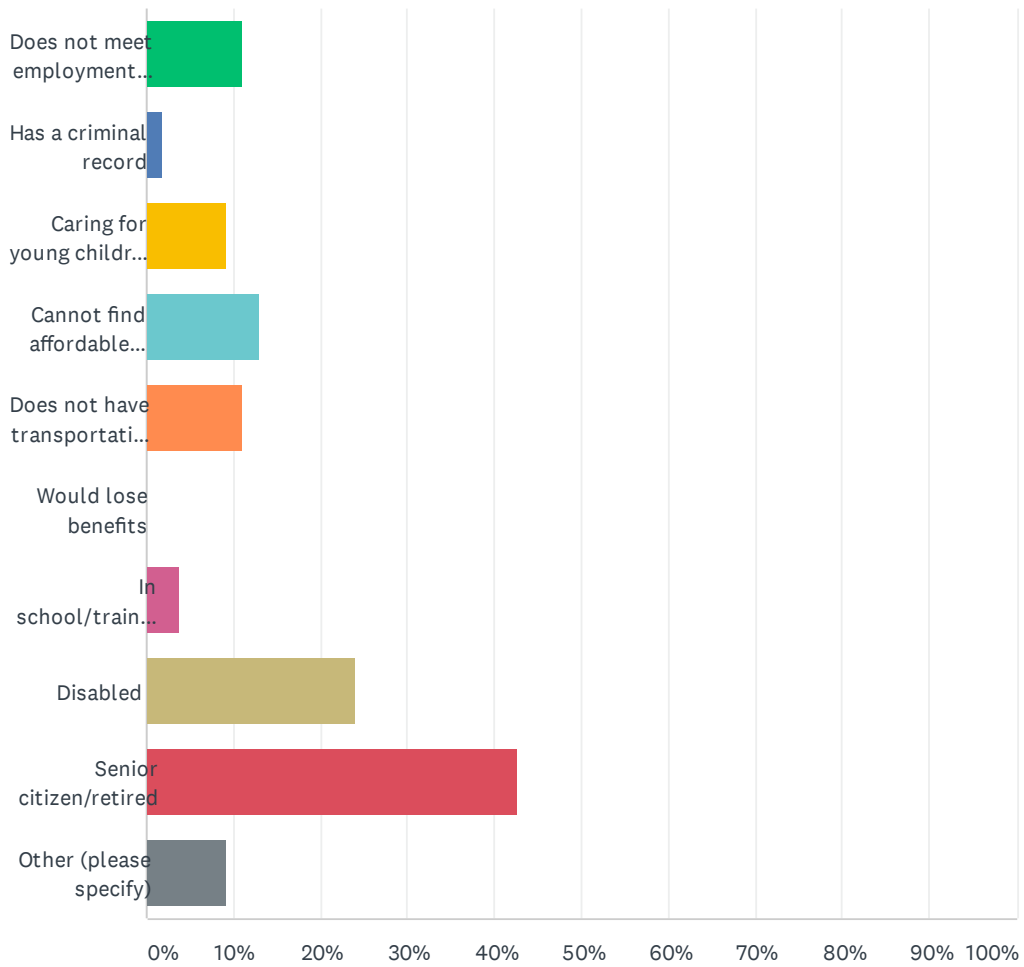

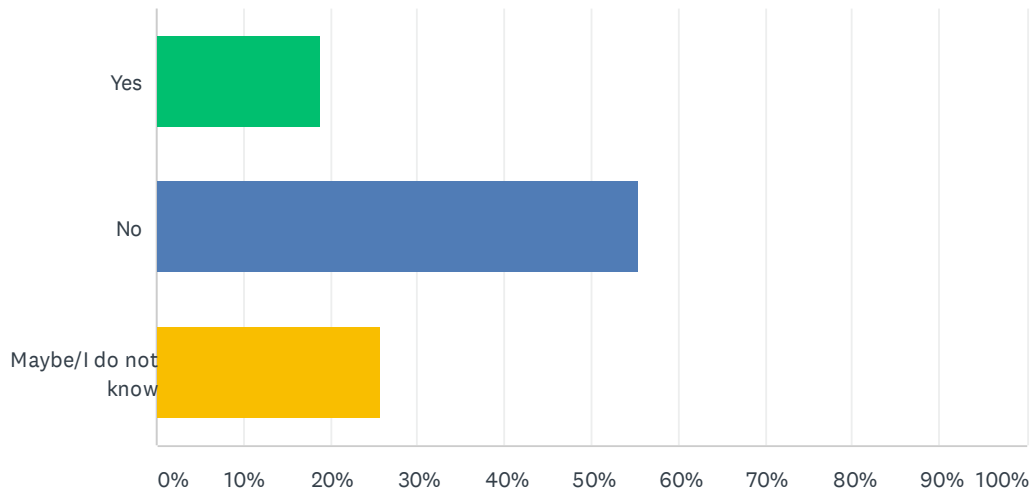

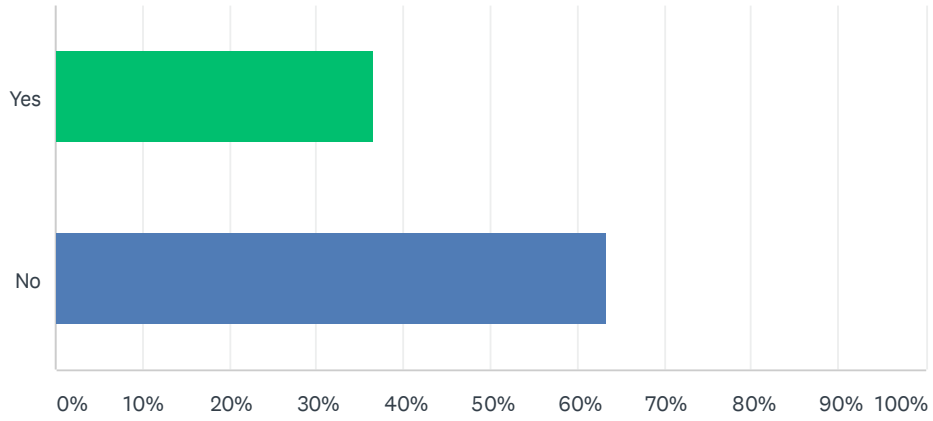

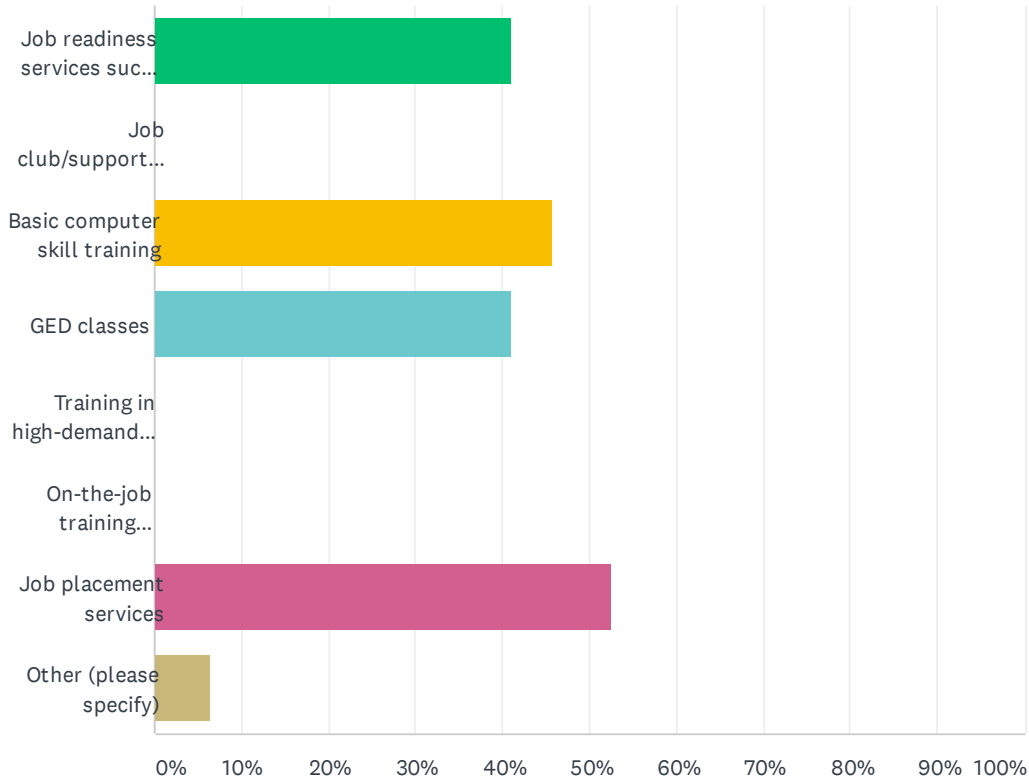

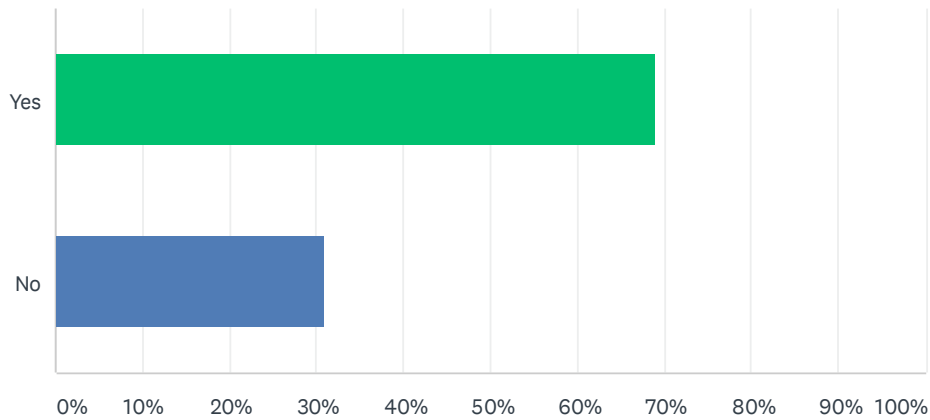

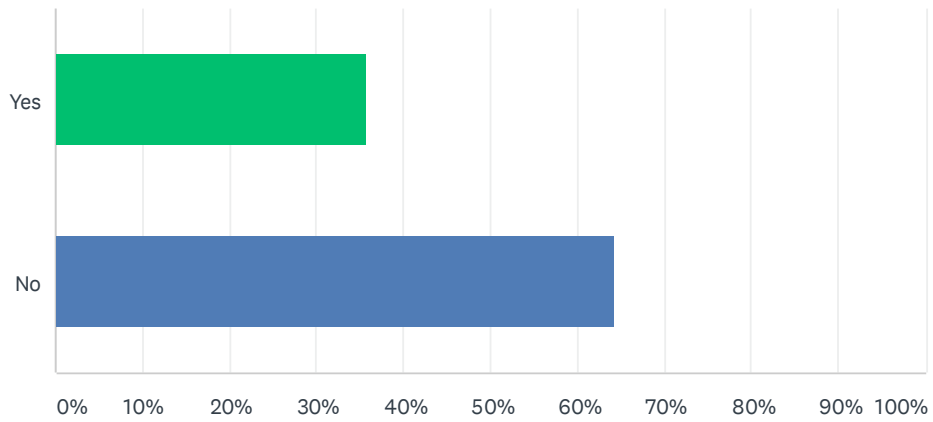

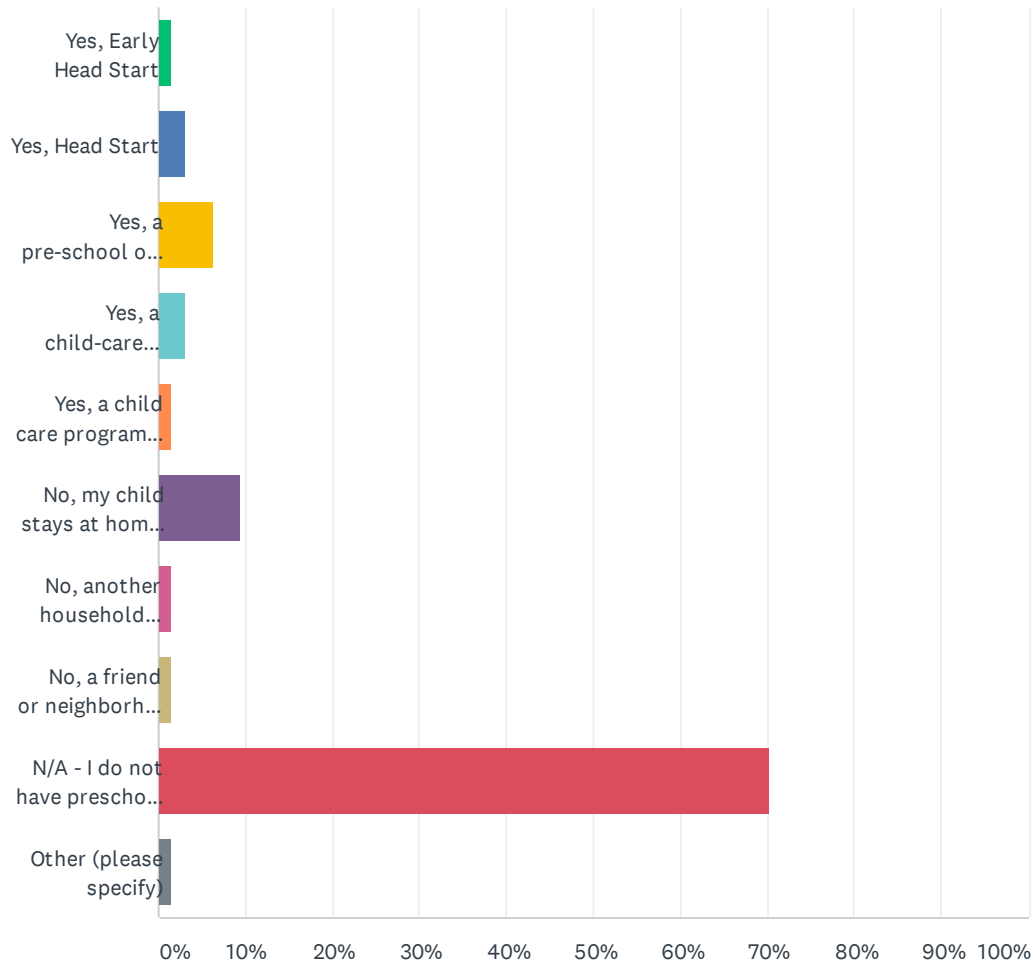

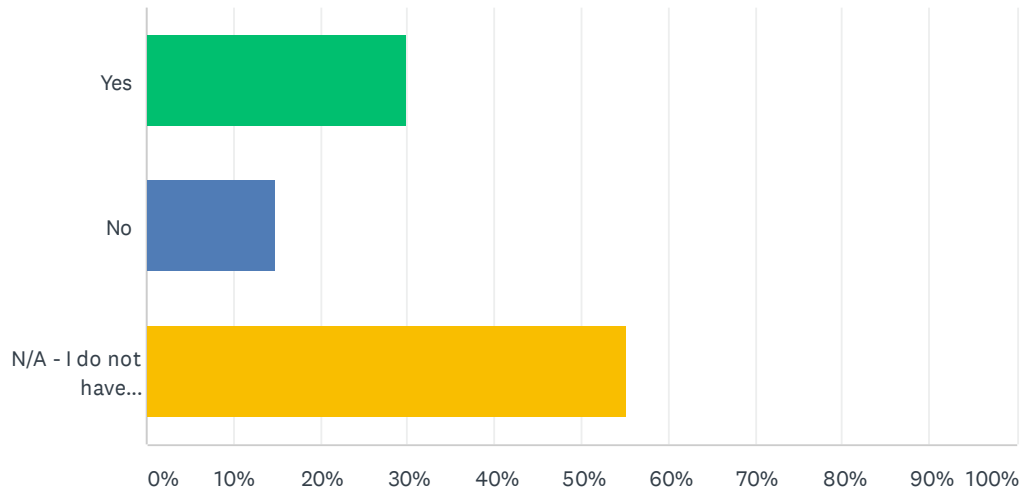

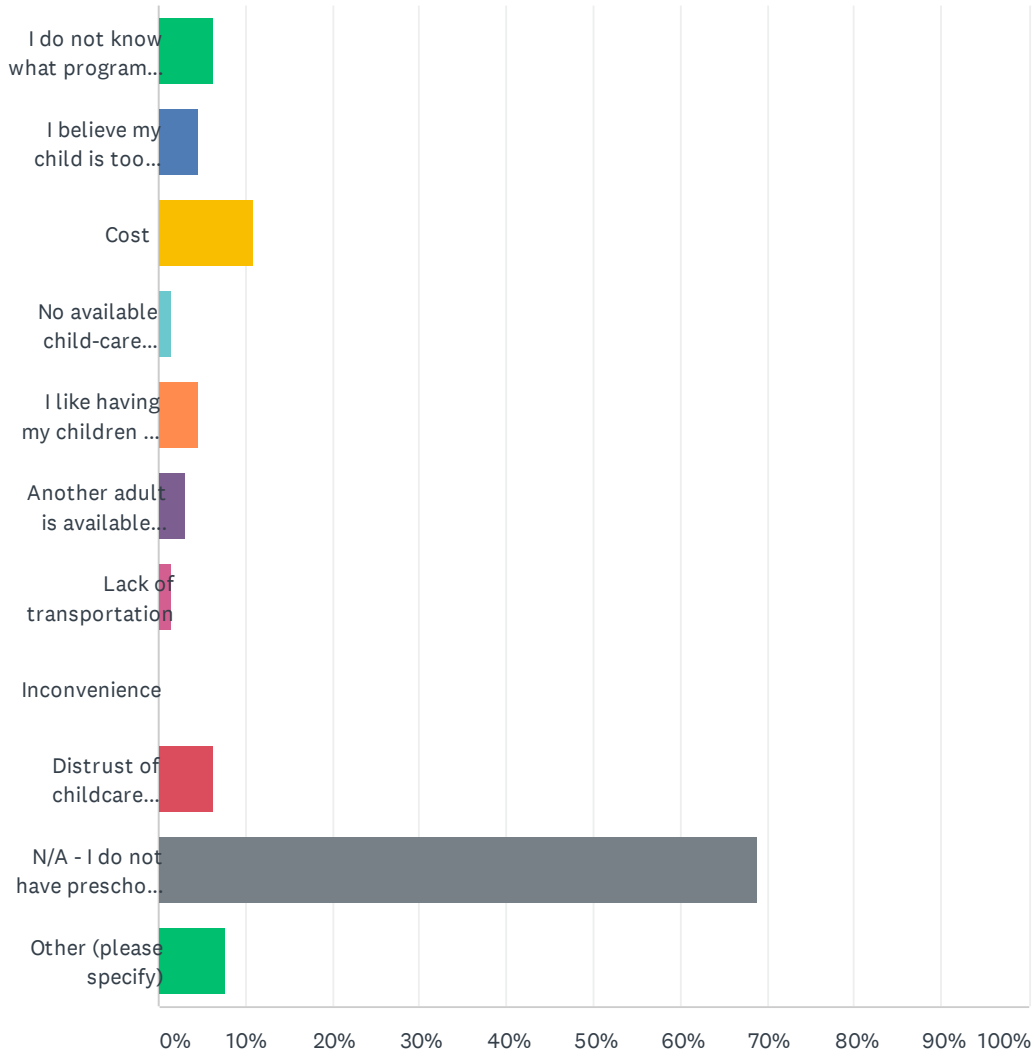

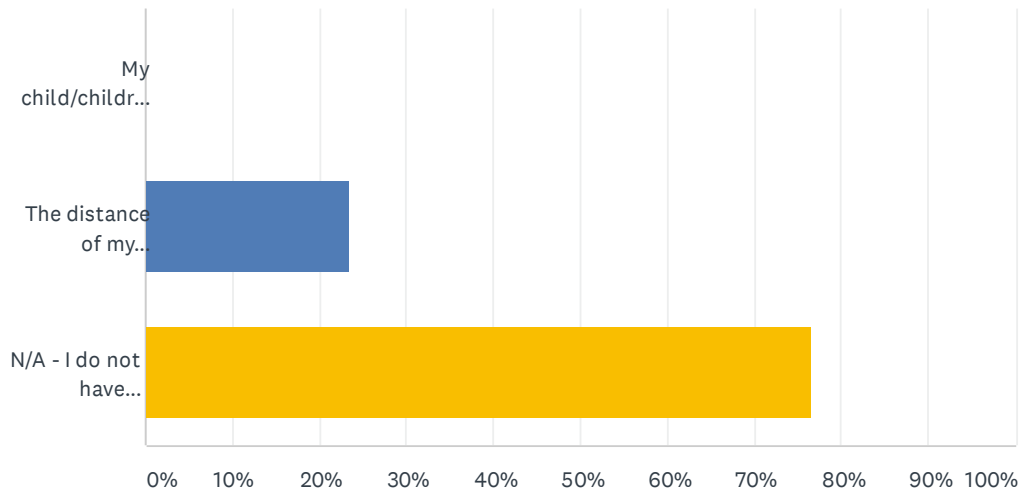

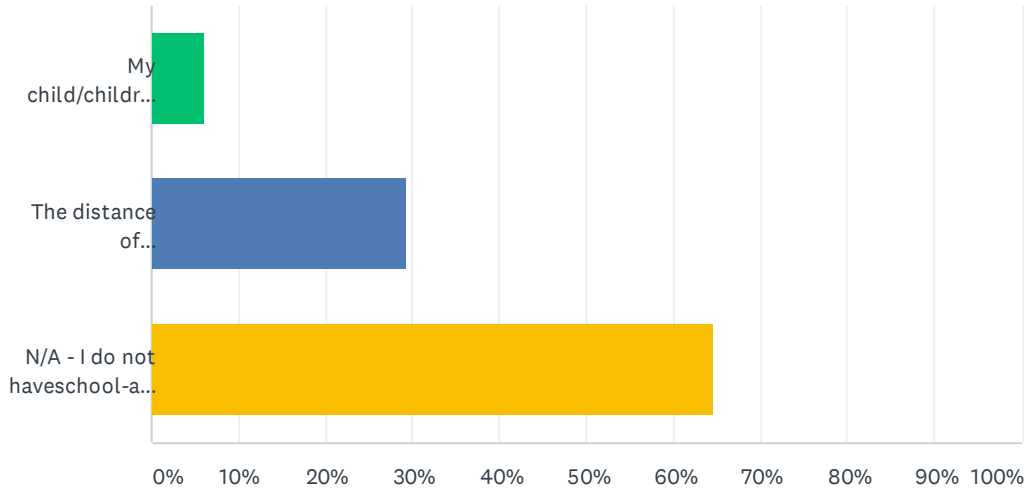

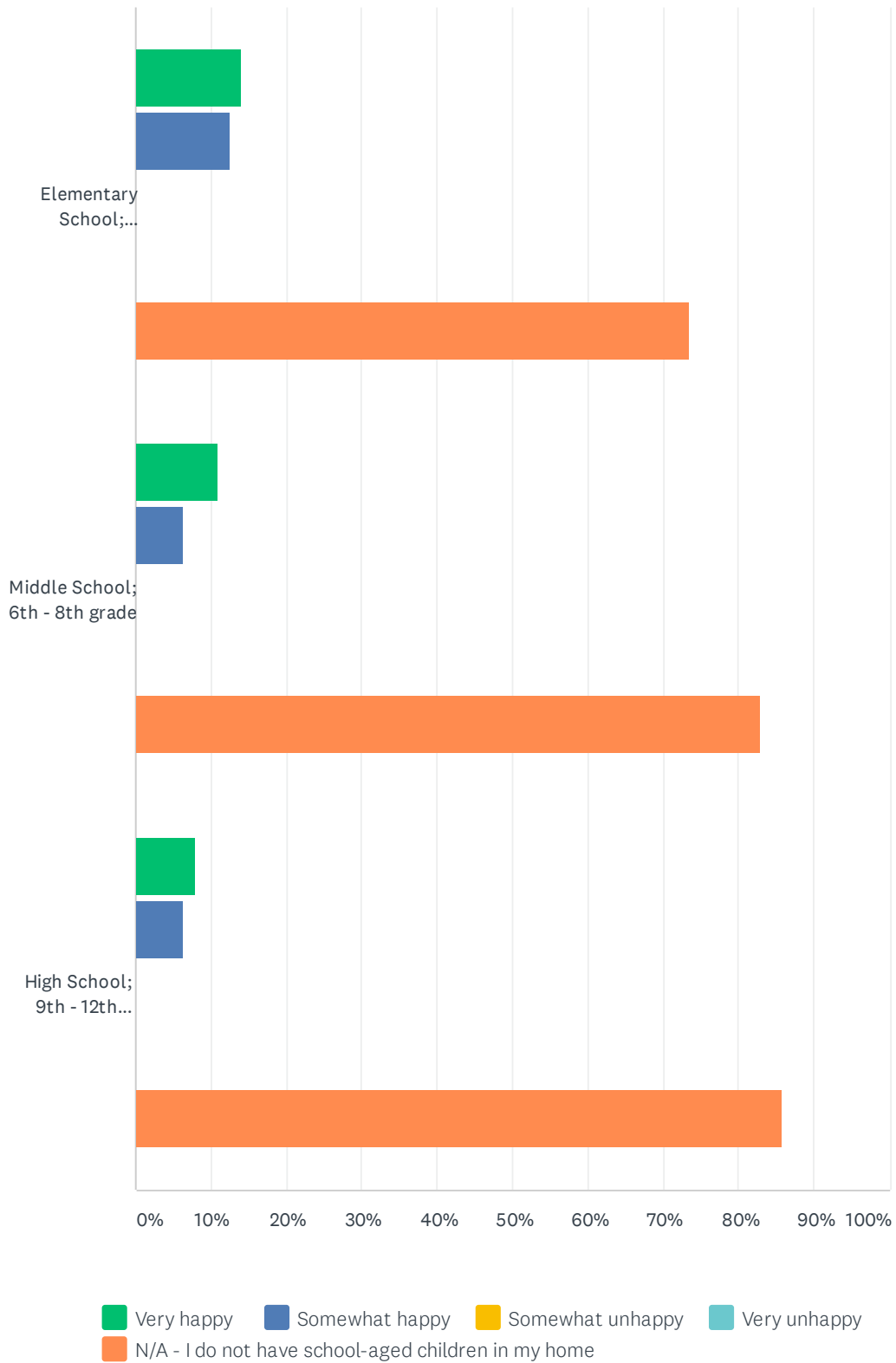

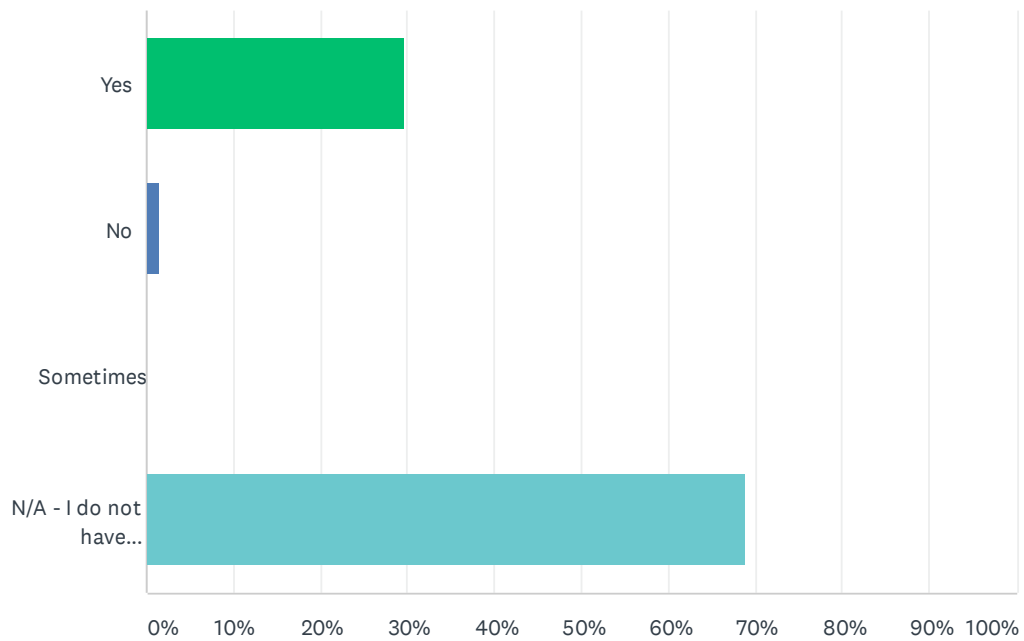

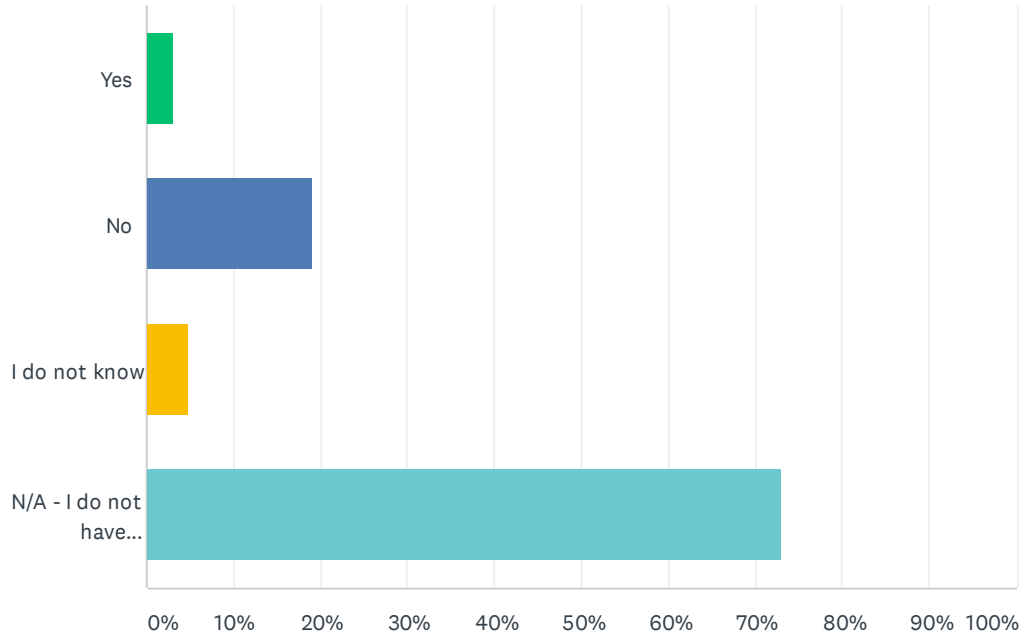

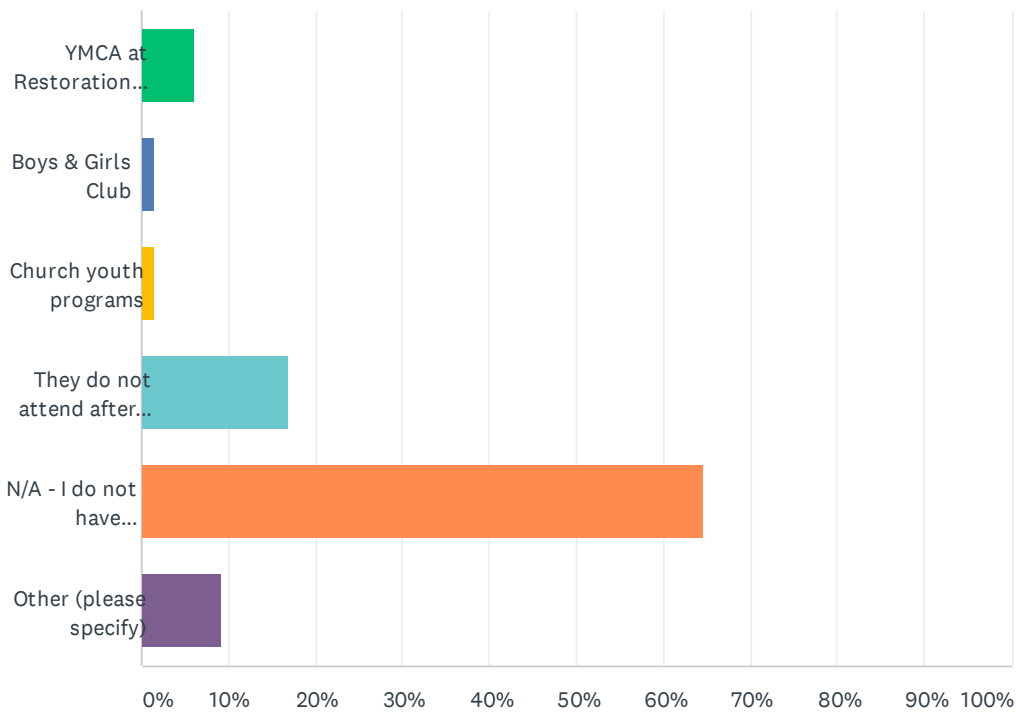

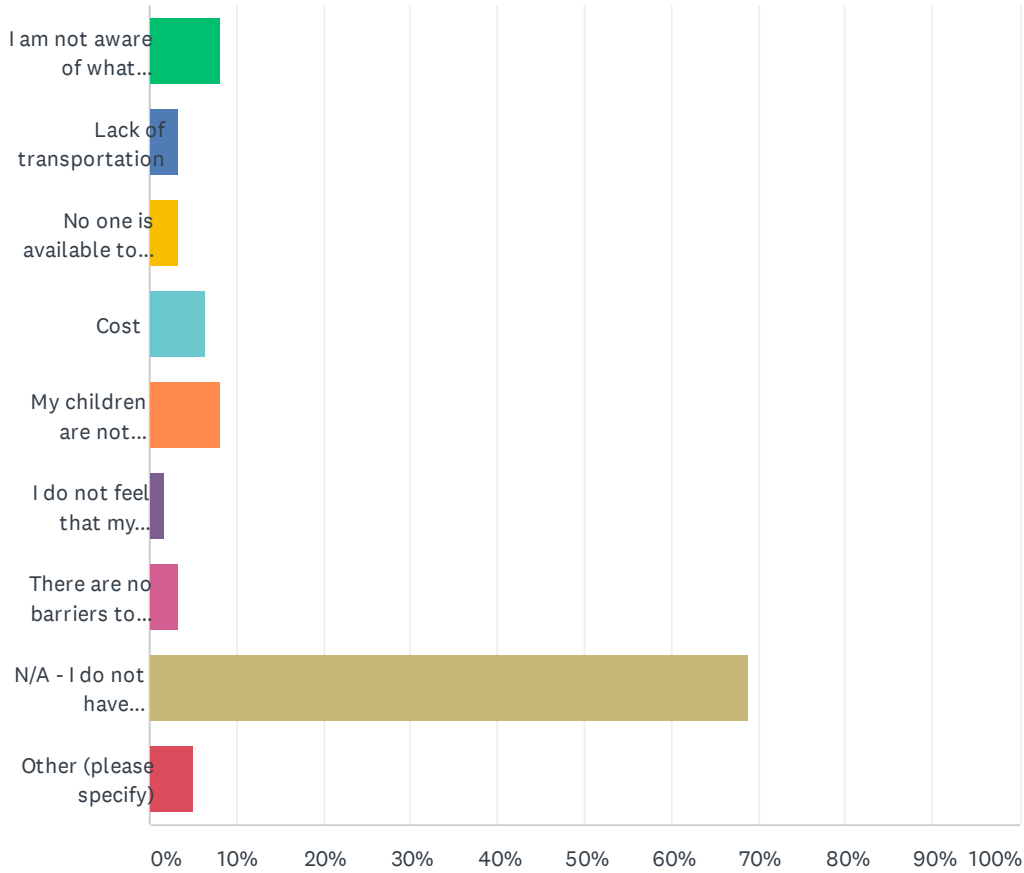

## Q72 If your children do NOT participate in after-school activities on a regular basis, what is the main reason why?

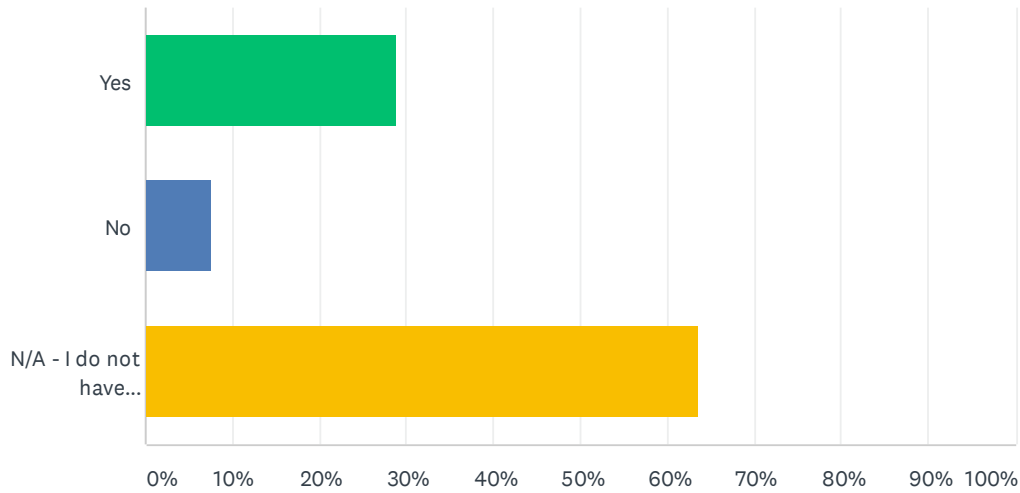

### Q73 Do your school-aged children use a computer on a regular basis?

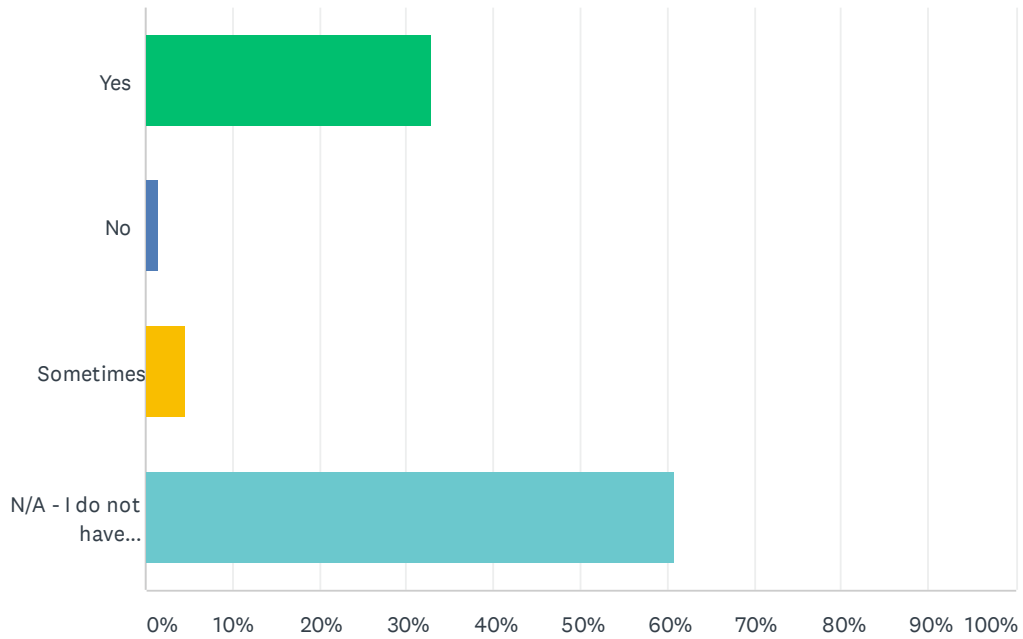

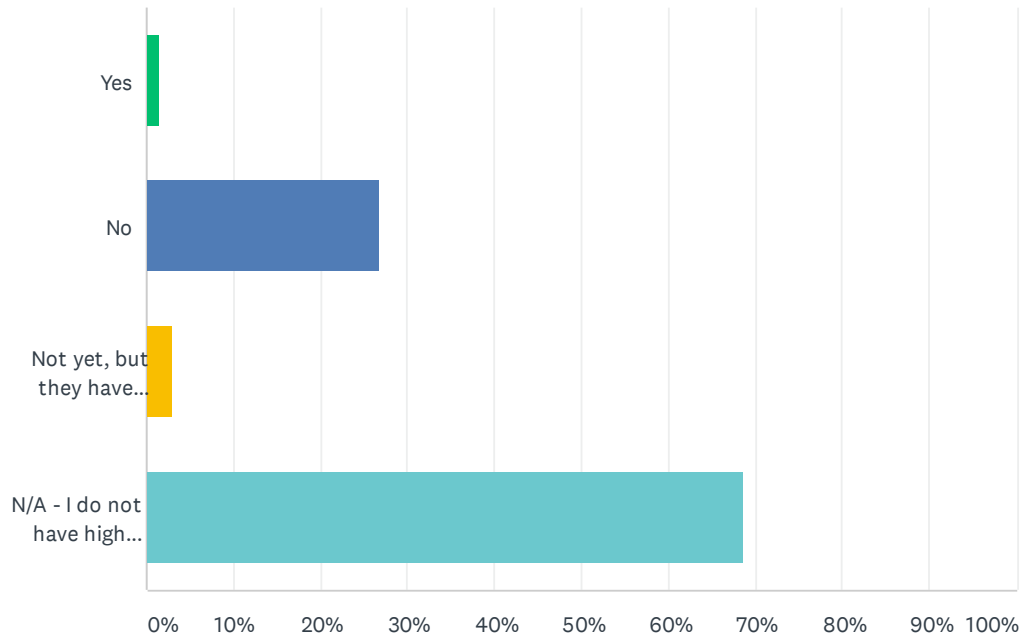

## Q75 Have any children living with you dropped out of high school?

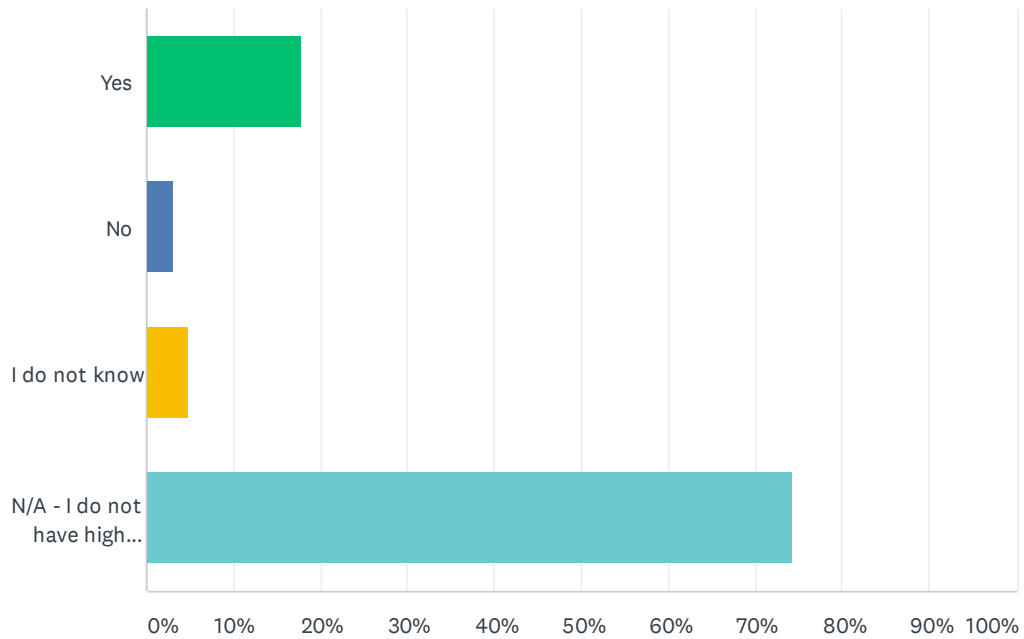

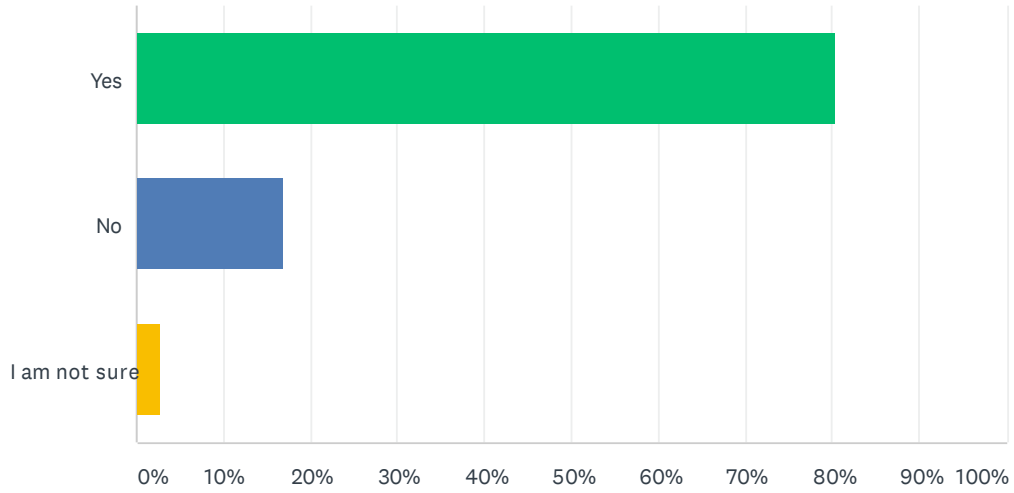

## Q77 Do you have access to the internet at home?

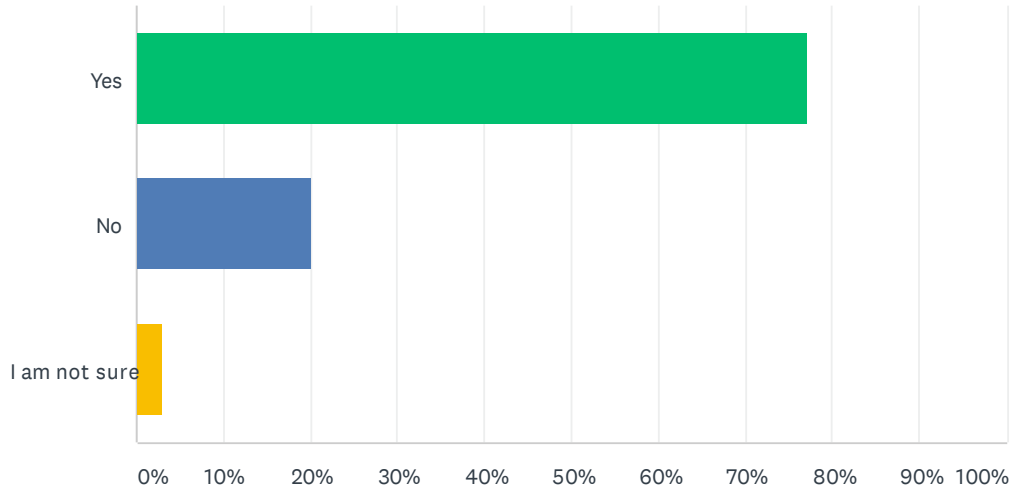

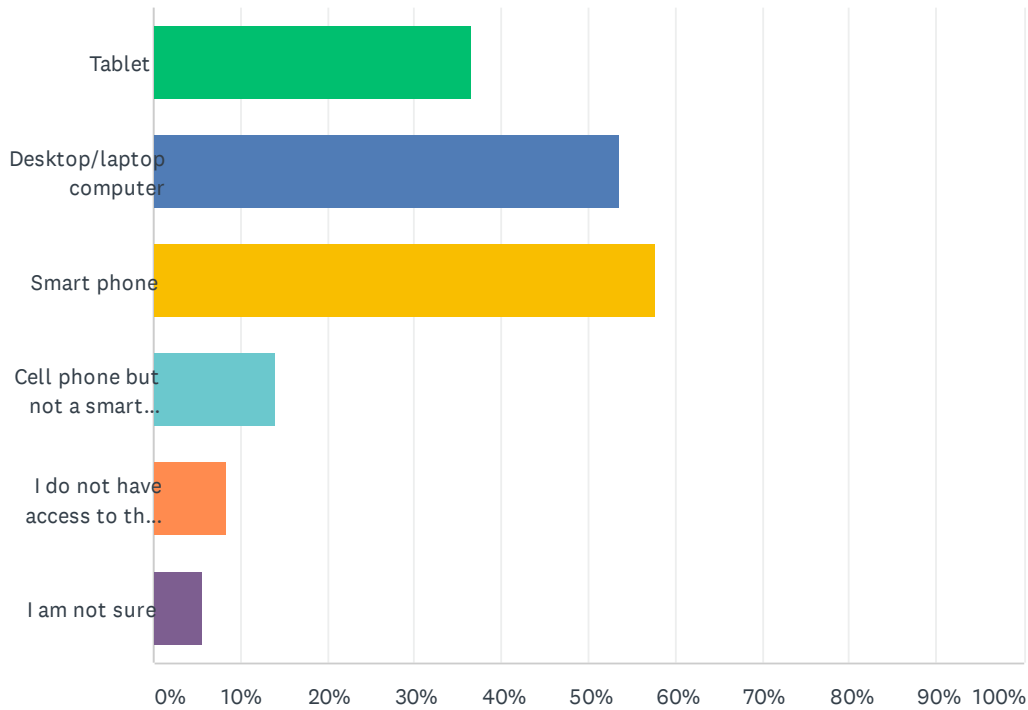

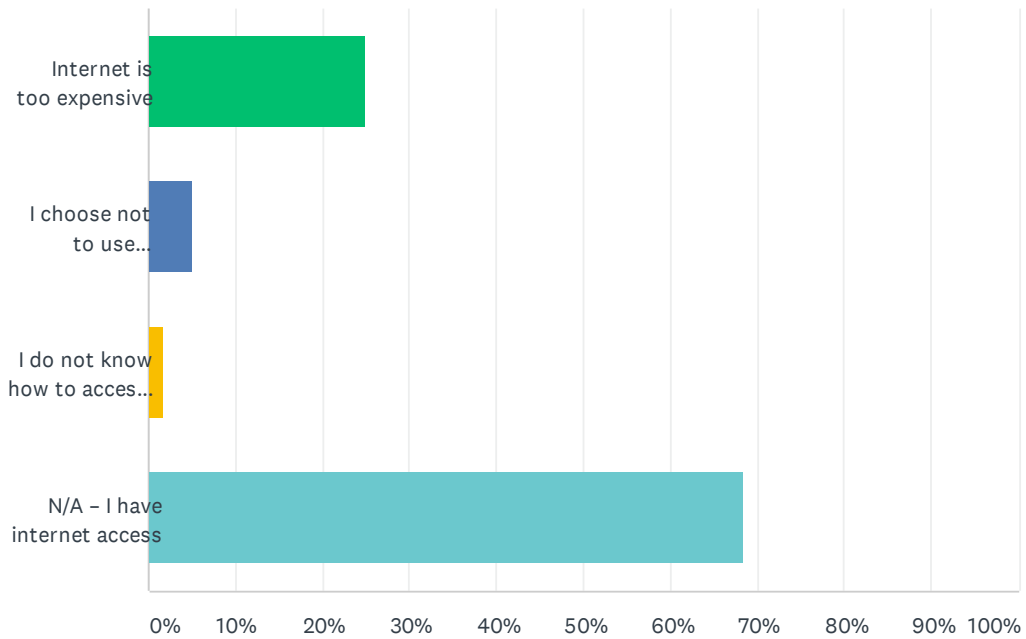

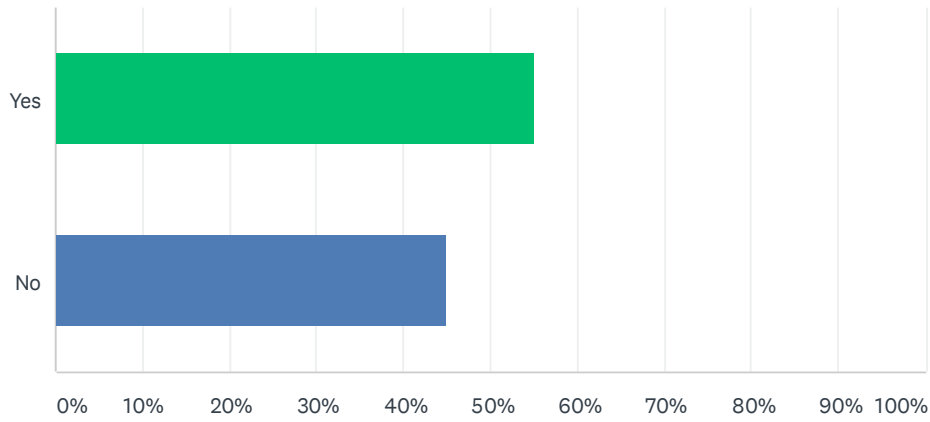

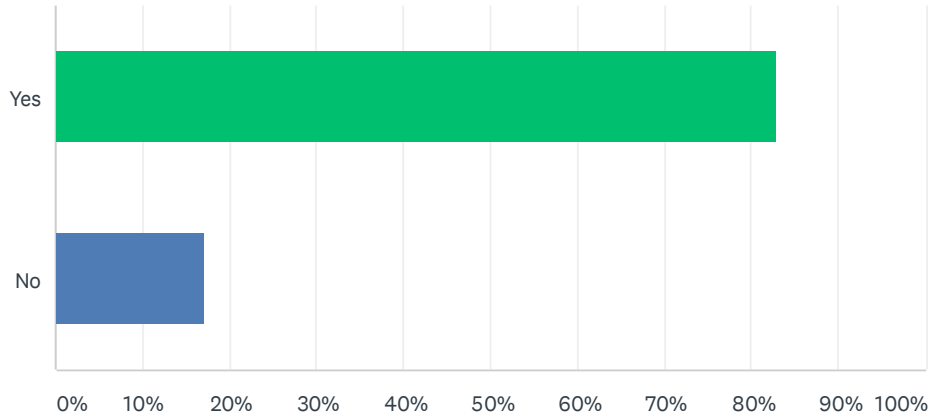
