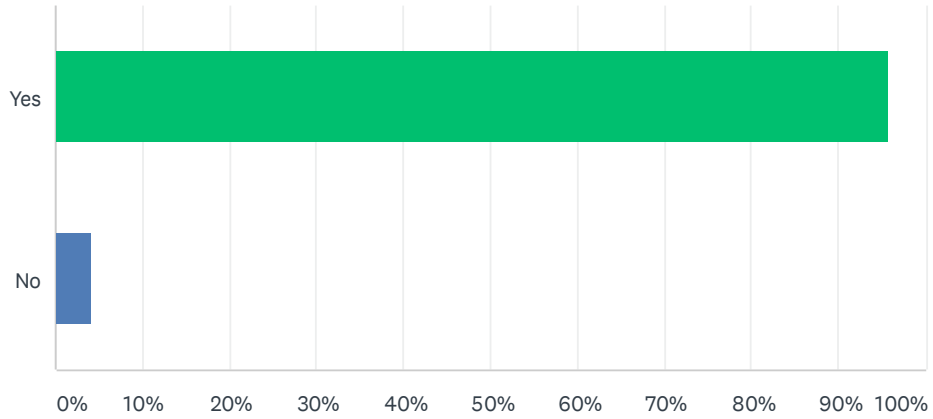


Q1 Looking at the map on page three, do you understand the location and boundaries of the East Rome Choice Neighborhood Plan?

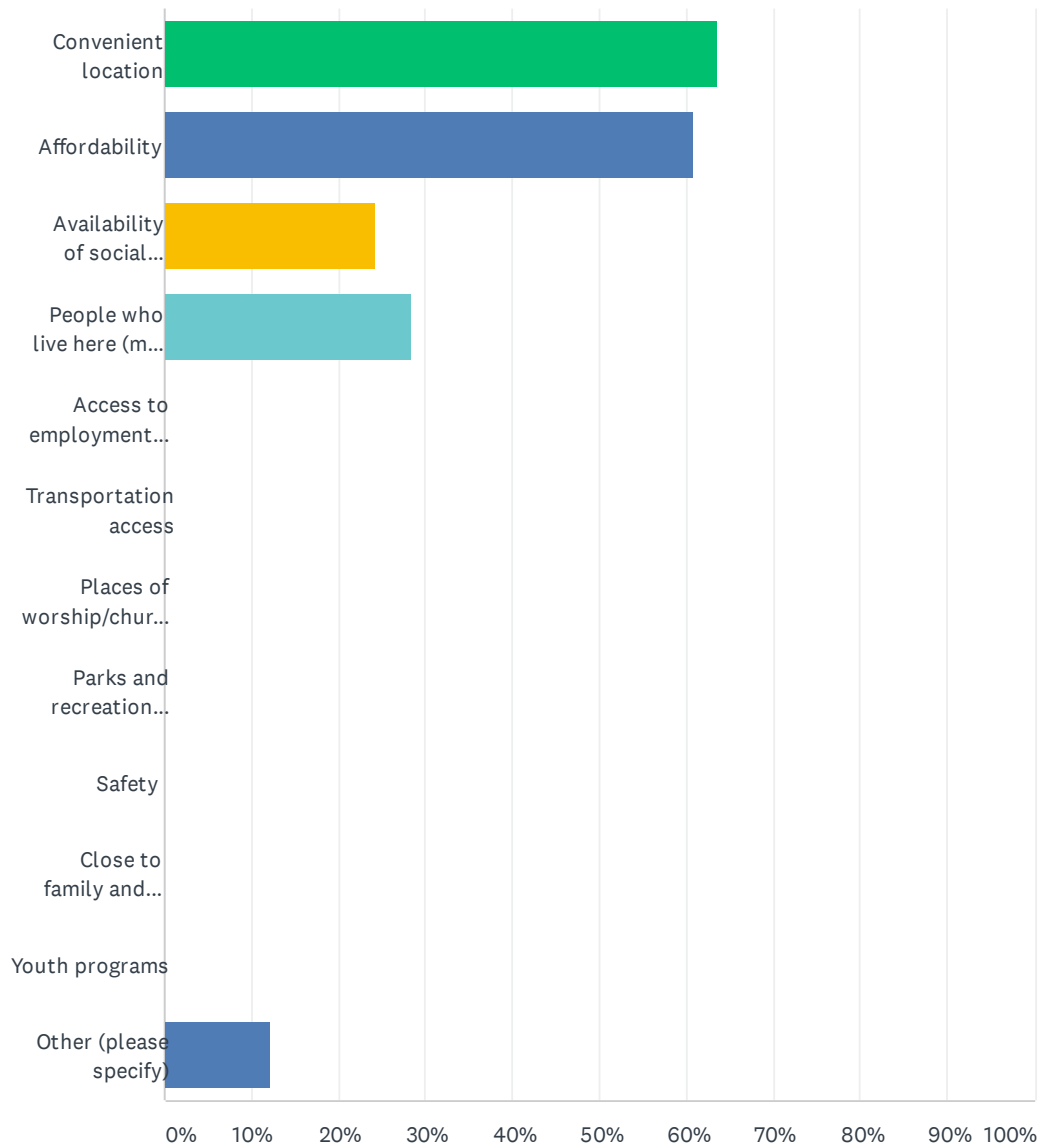

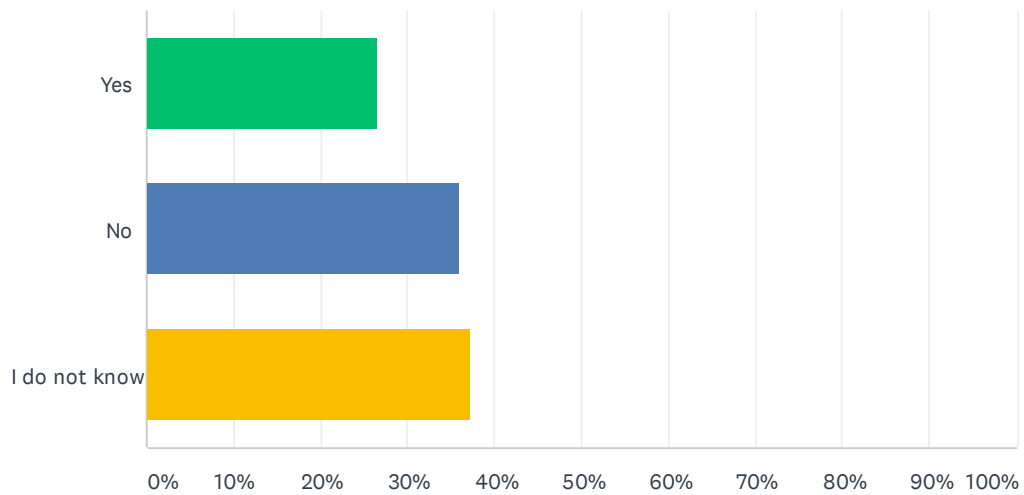

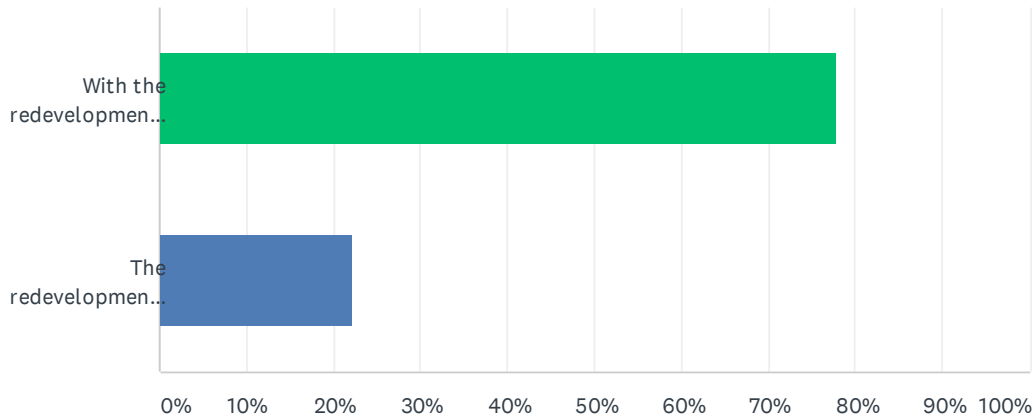

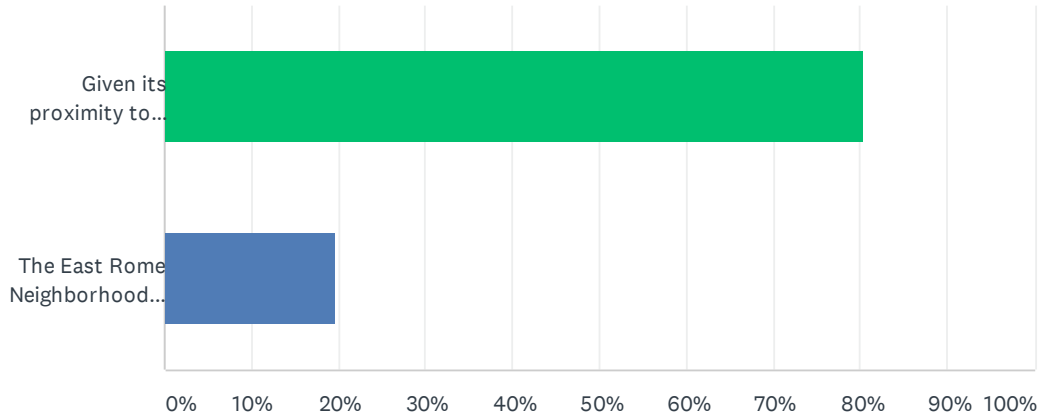

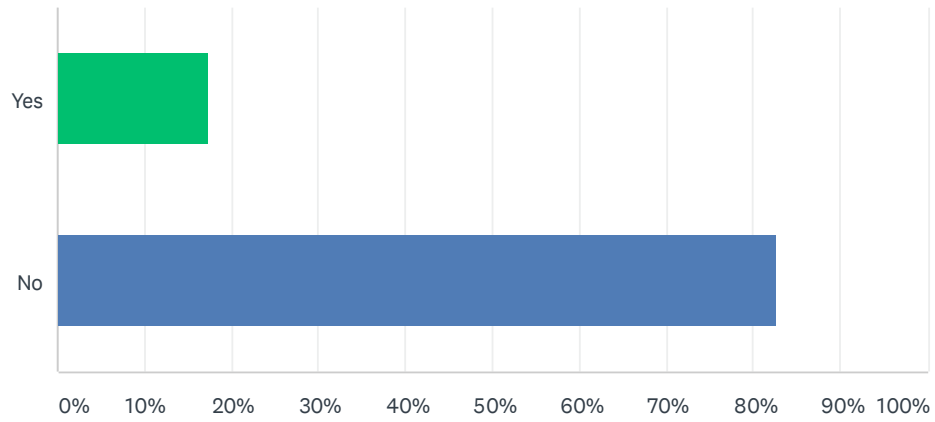

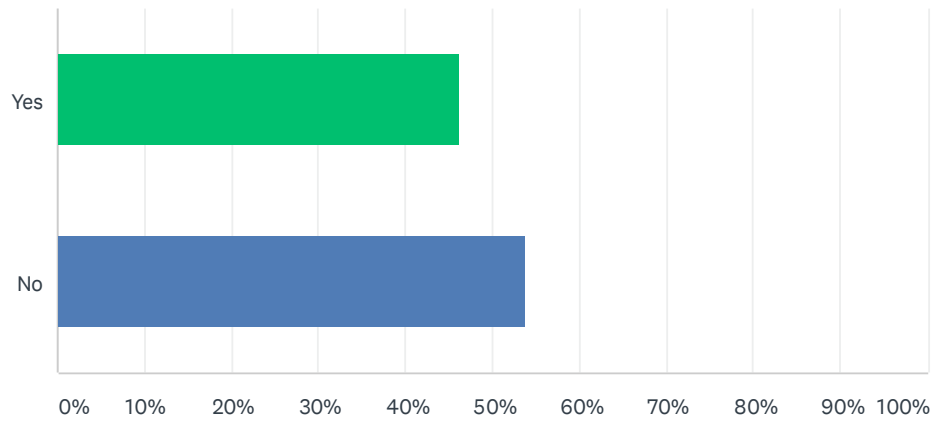

Q7 If you answered “Yes” to Question 6, does the public bus service meet your transportation needs?

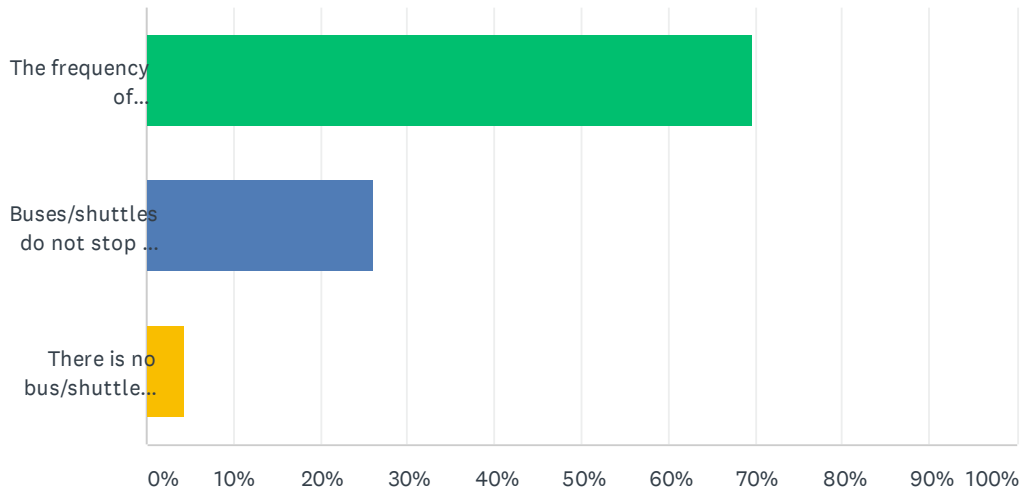

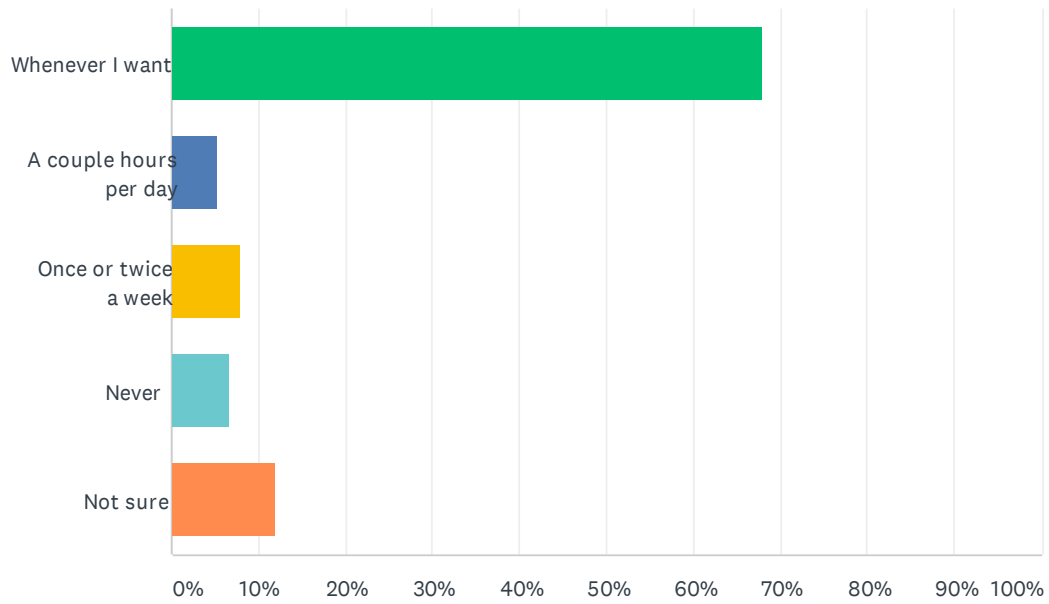

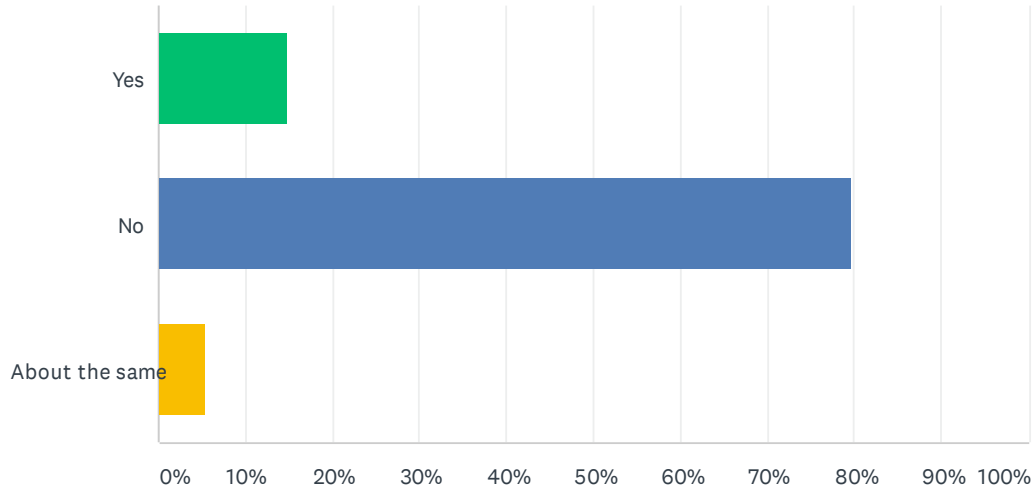

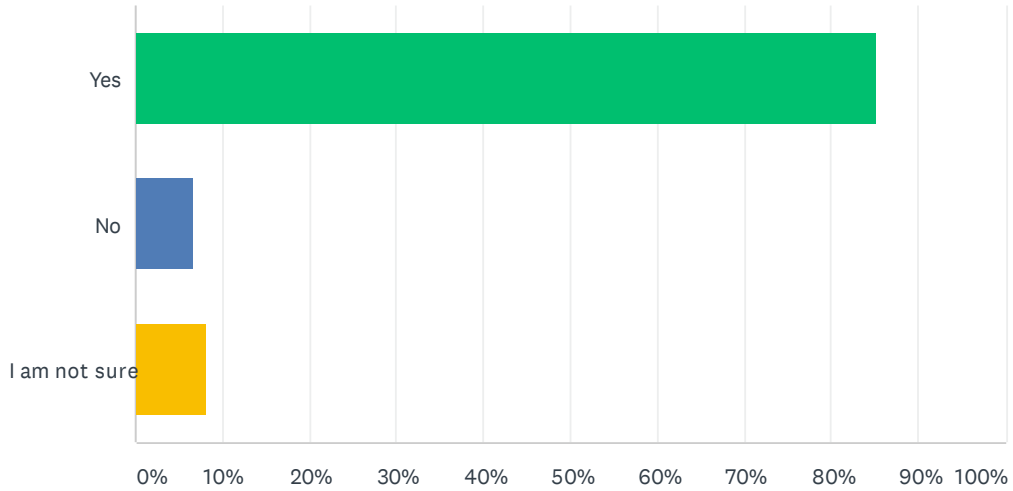

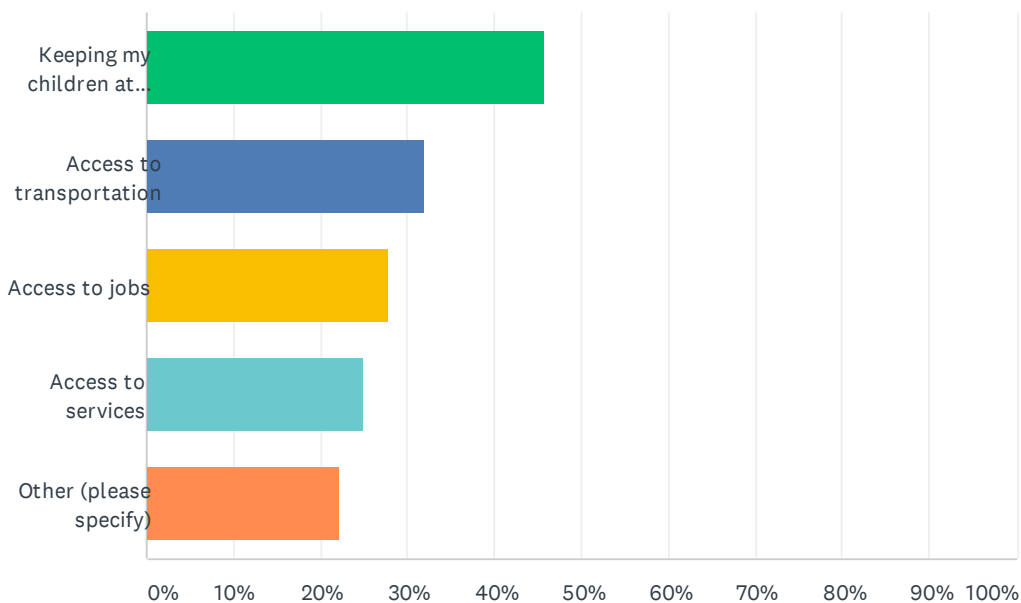

Q13 What considerations are most important to you in making a decision concerning relocation of your household? Please select the three most important considerations

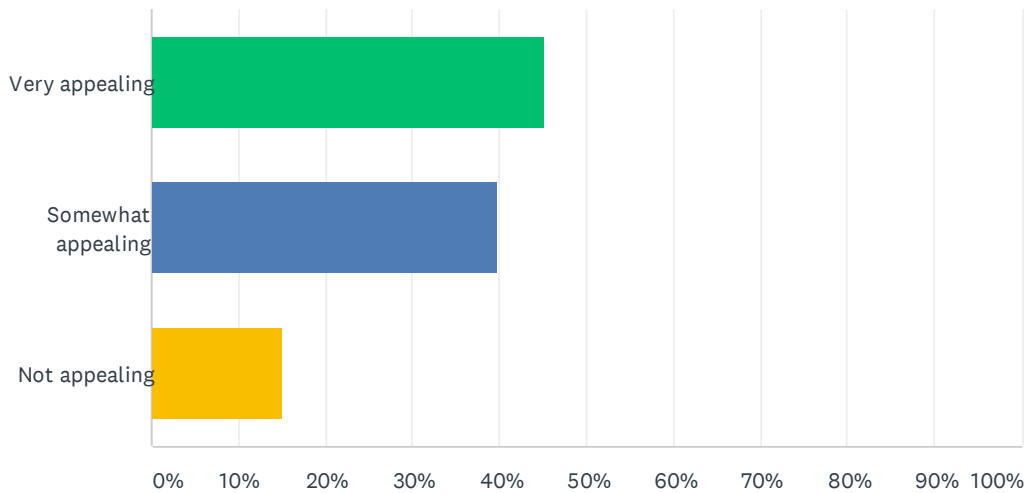

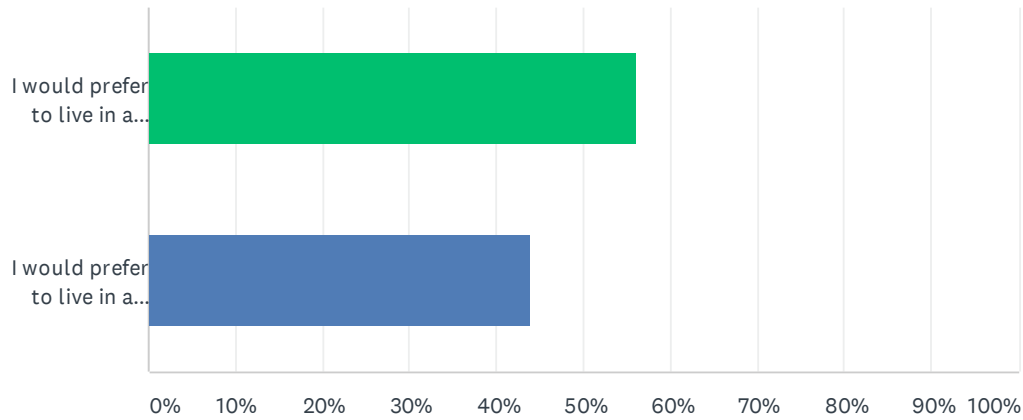

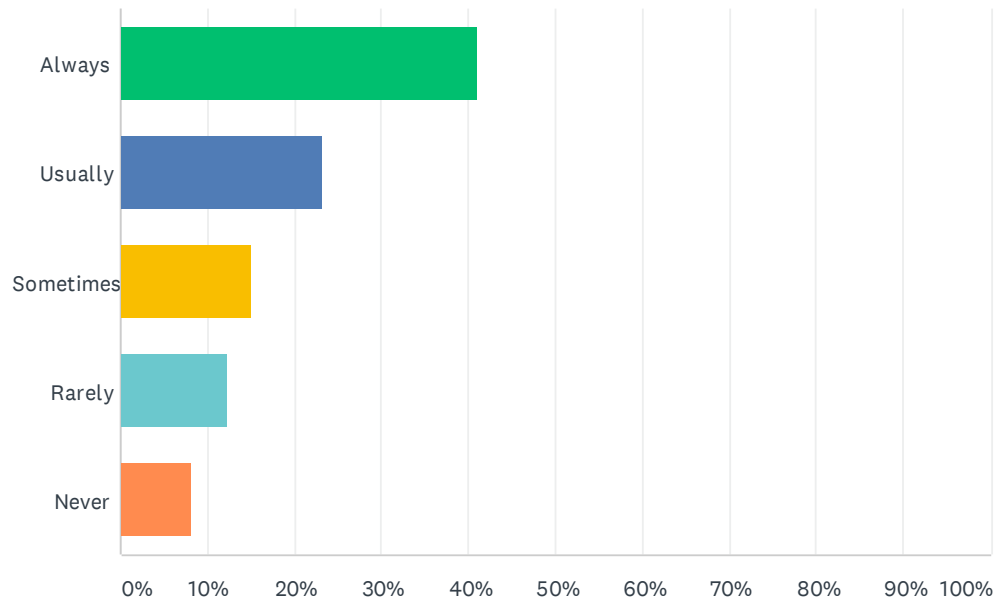

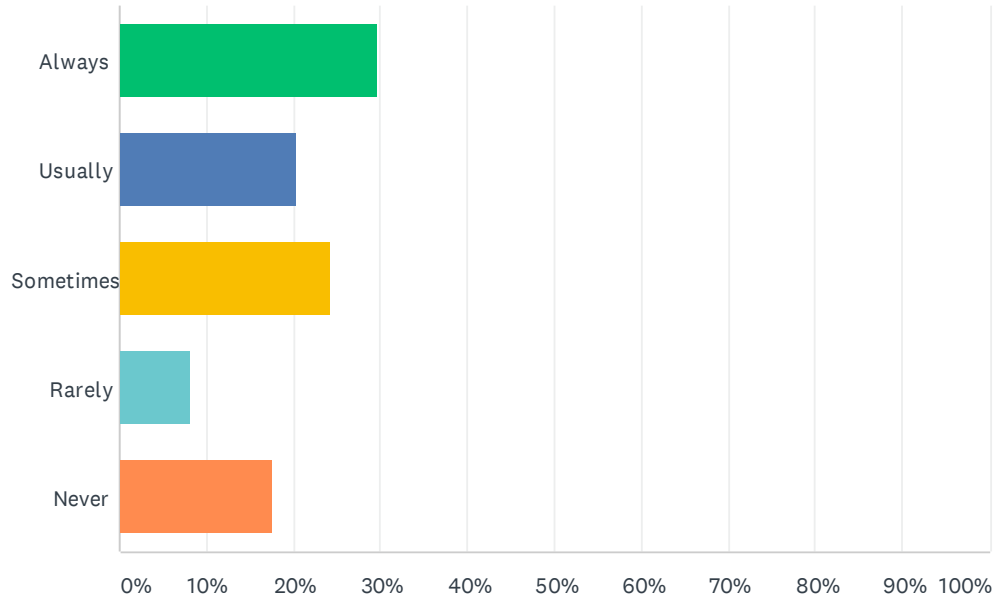

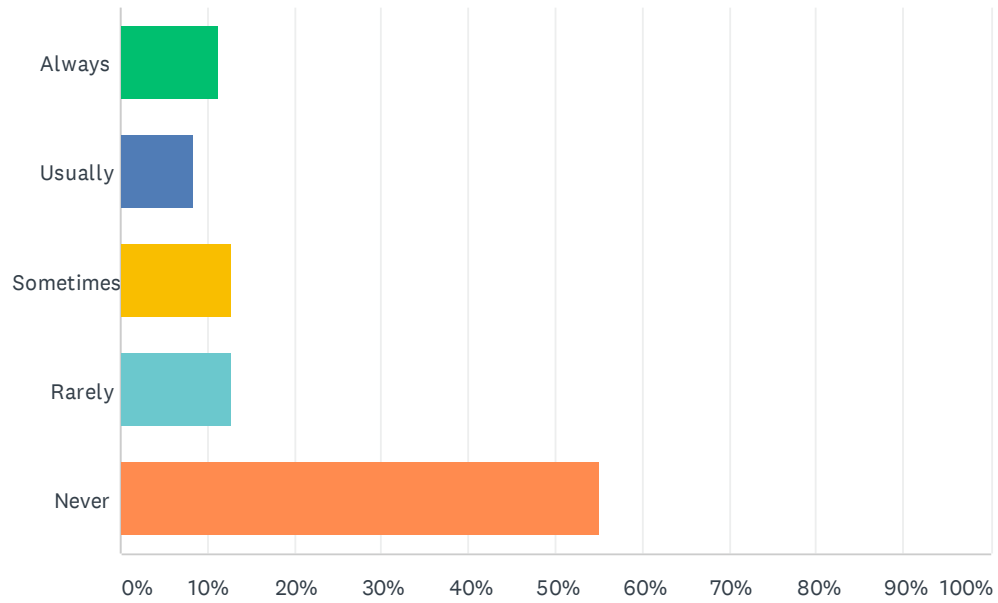

Q18 Do you see people buying/selling/using drugs in the neighborhood?

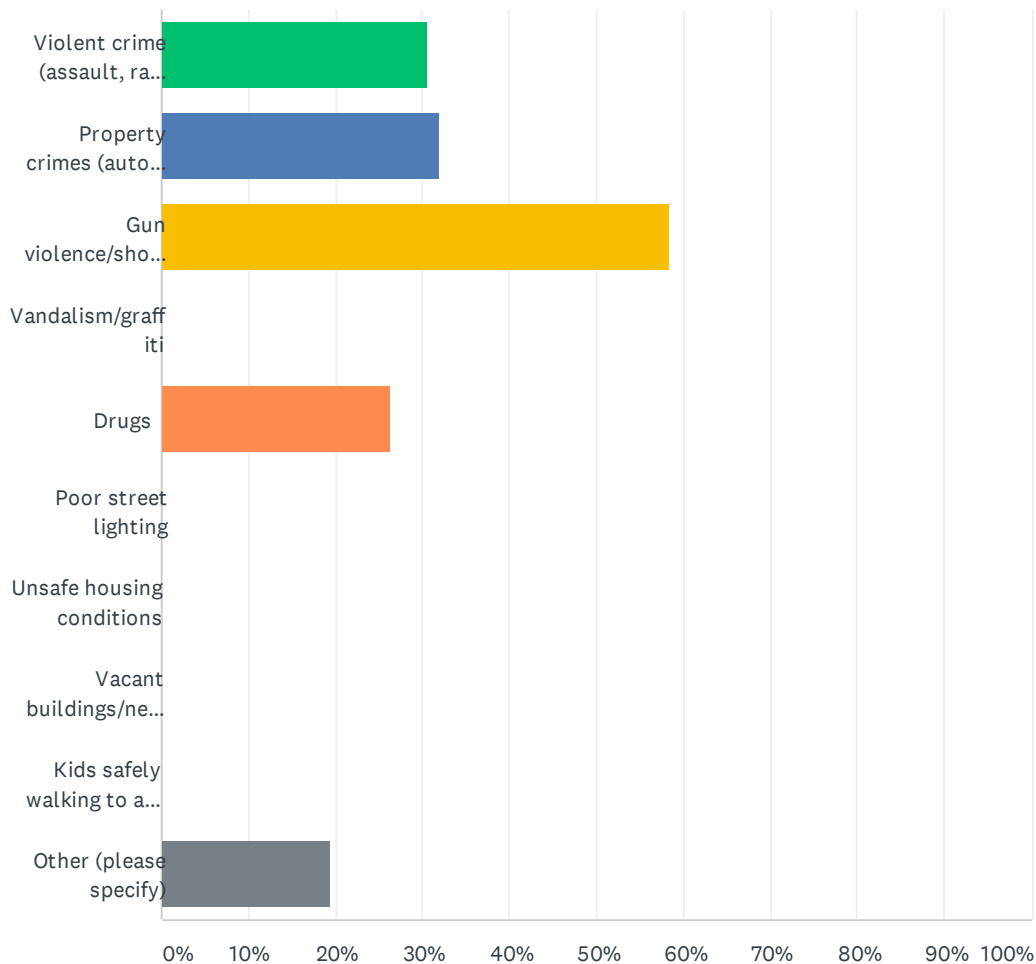

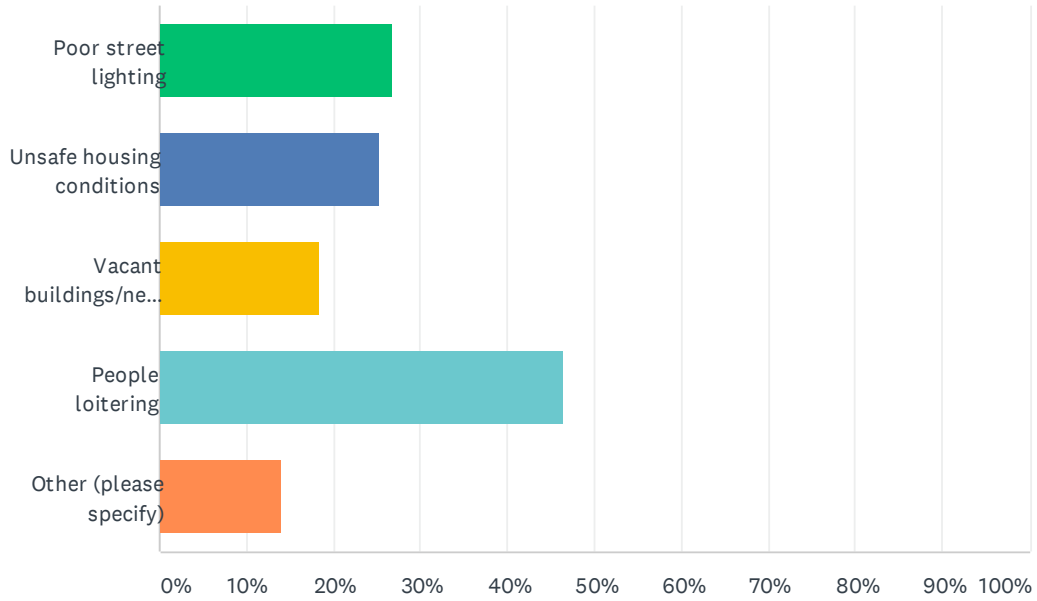

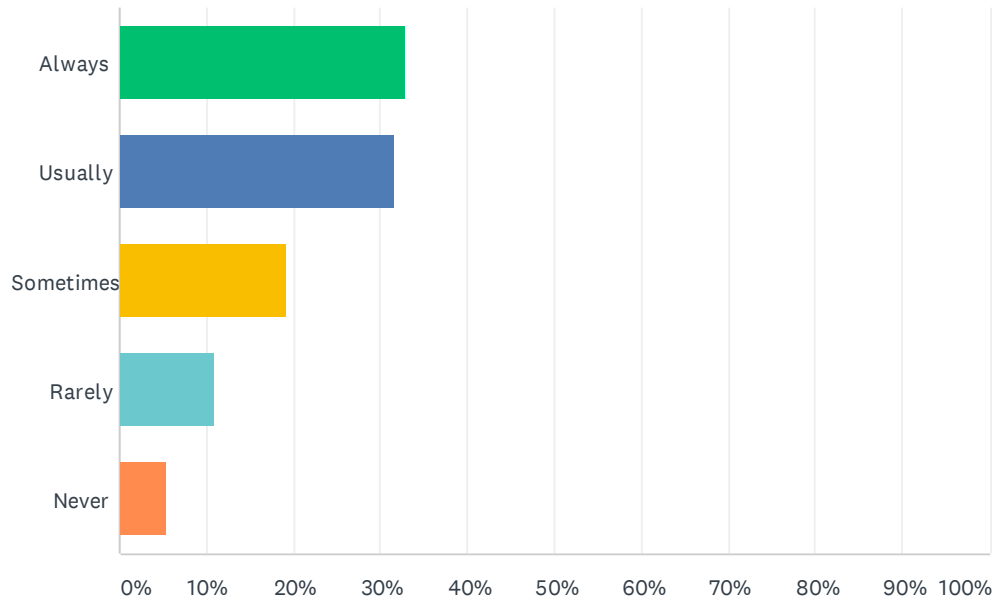

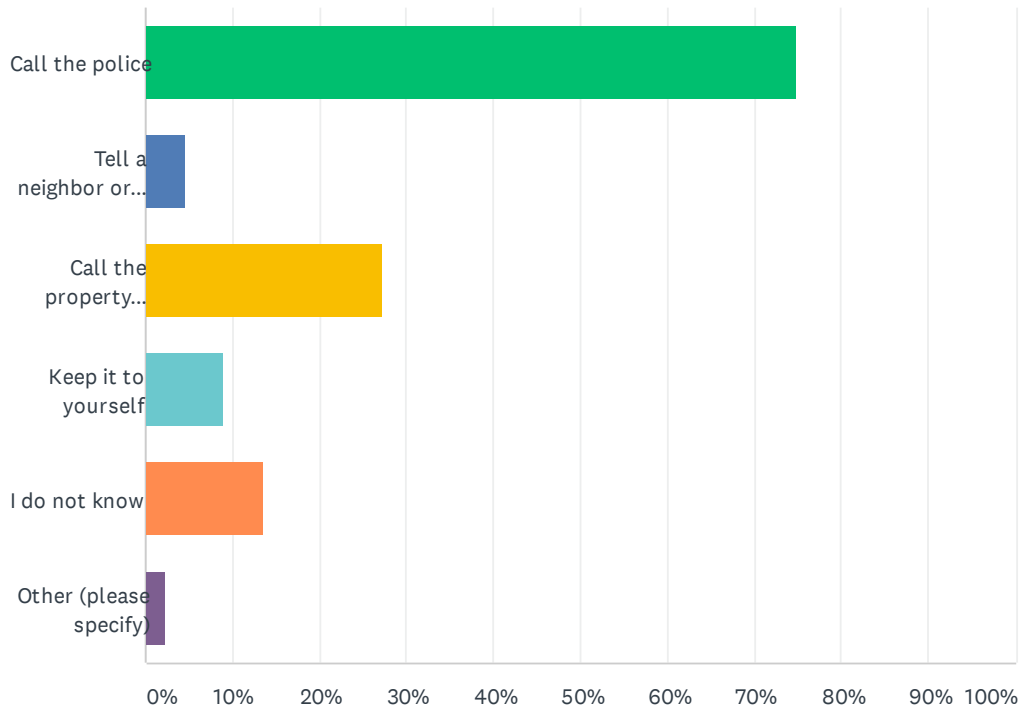

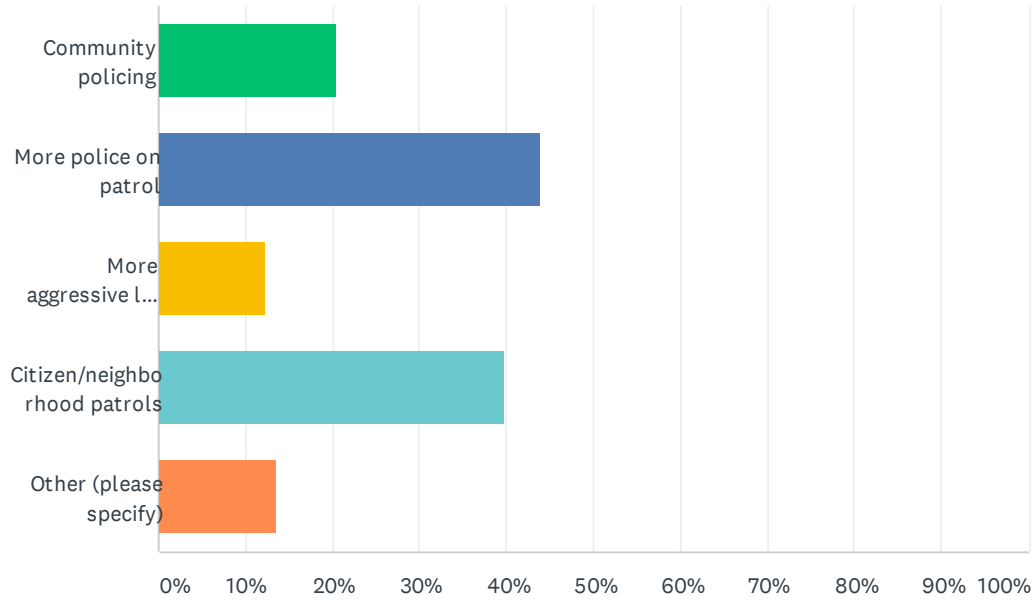

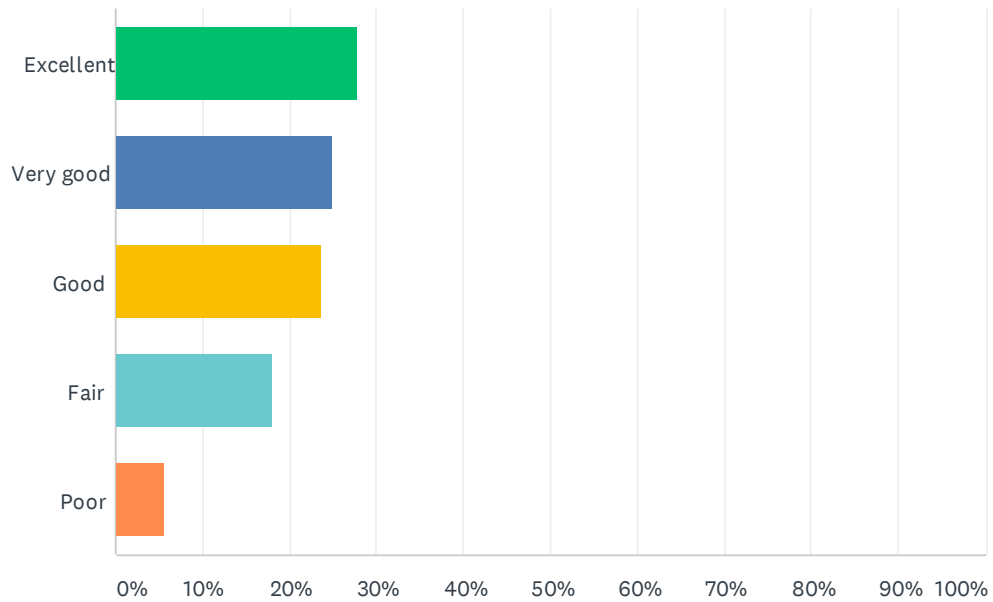

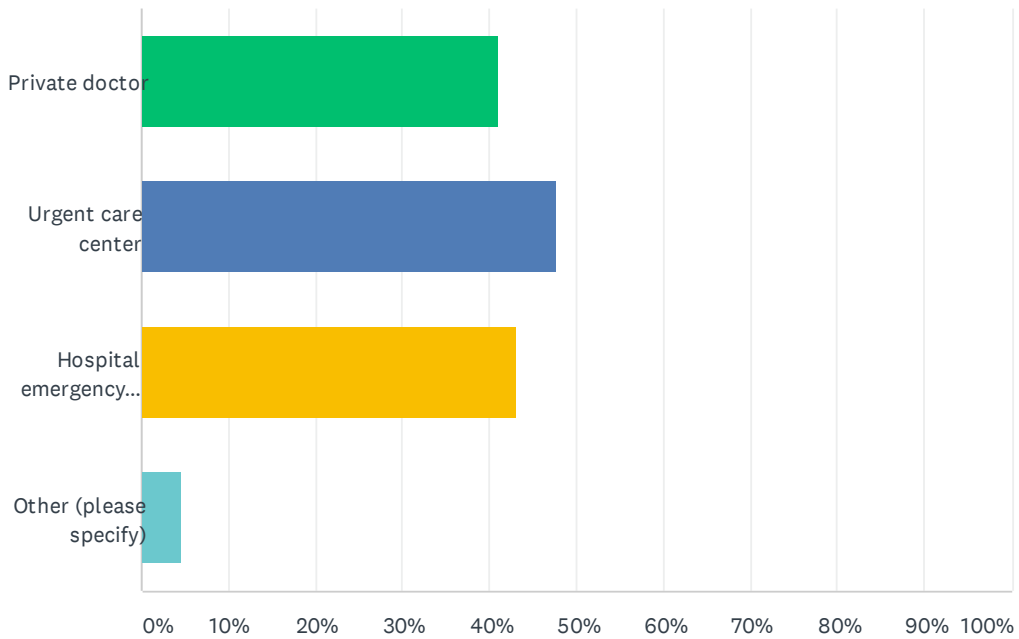

Q25 Where do you get health care when you or a member of your household are sick?

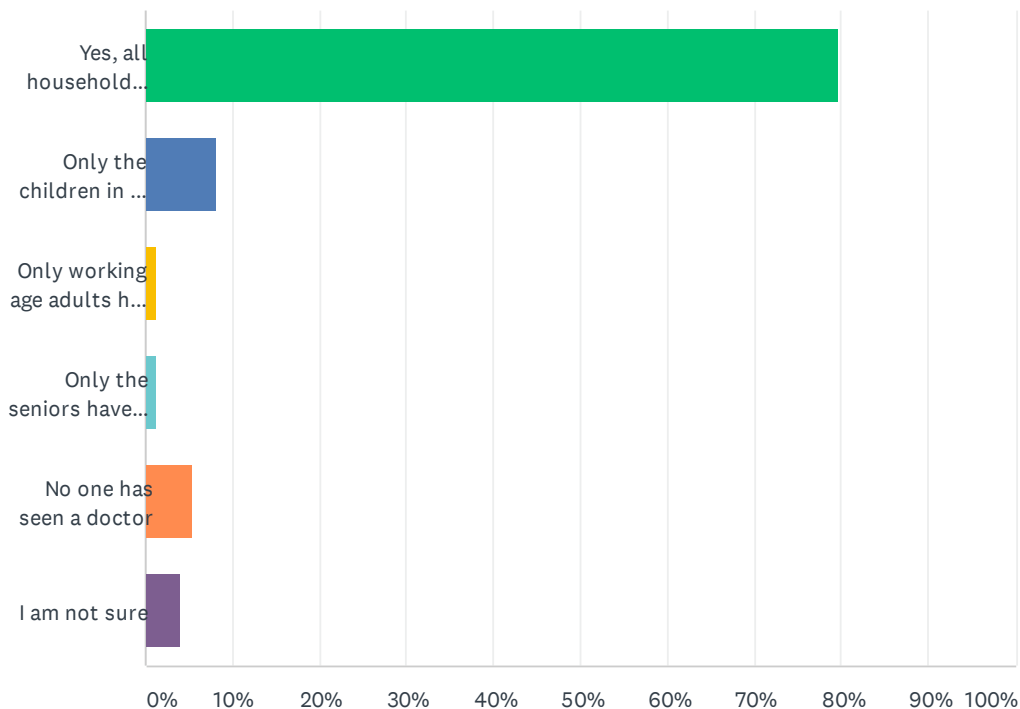

Q26 Have members of your household seen a doctor in the last 12 months for a physical exam/check-up?

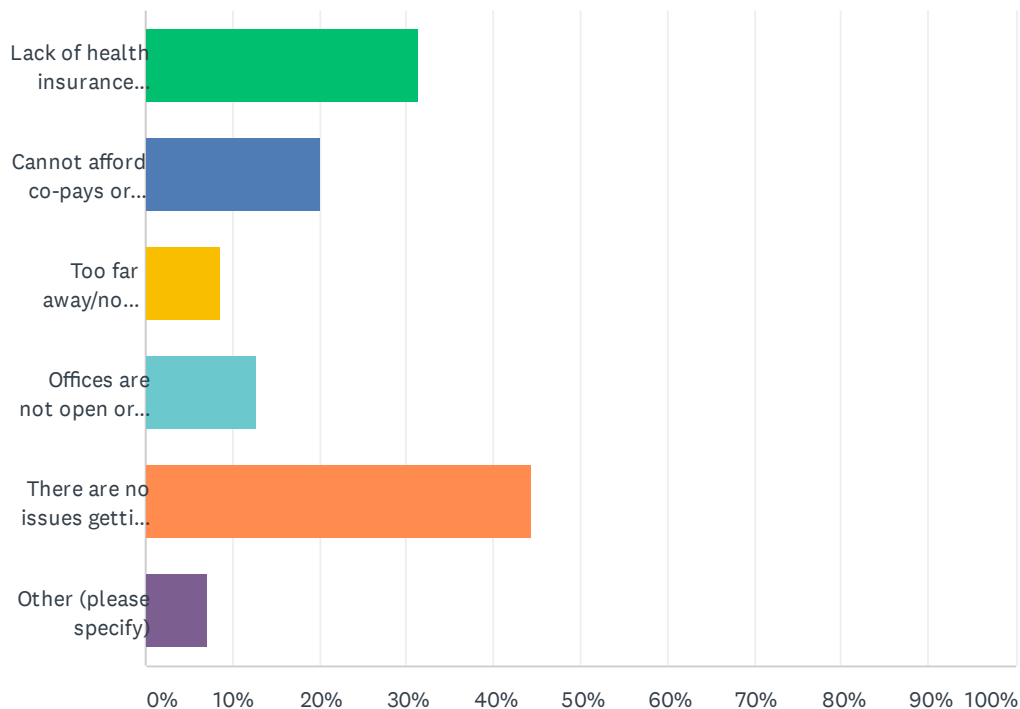

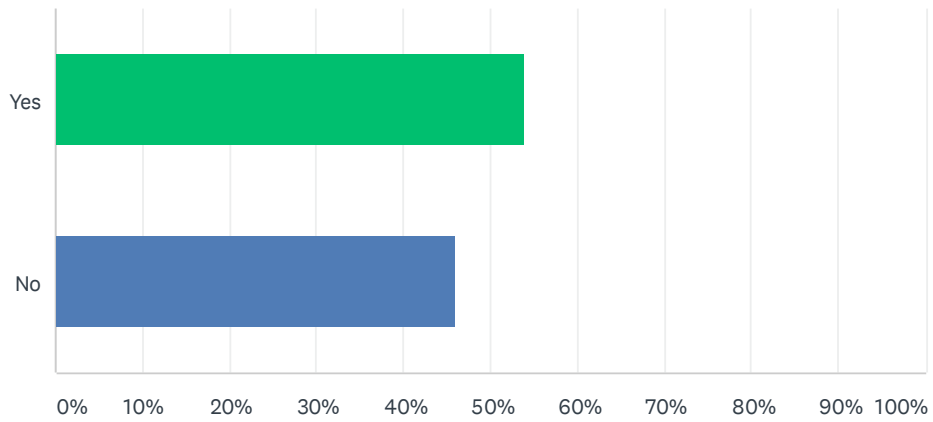

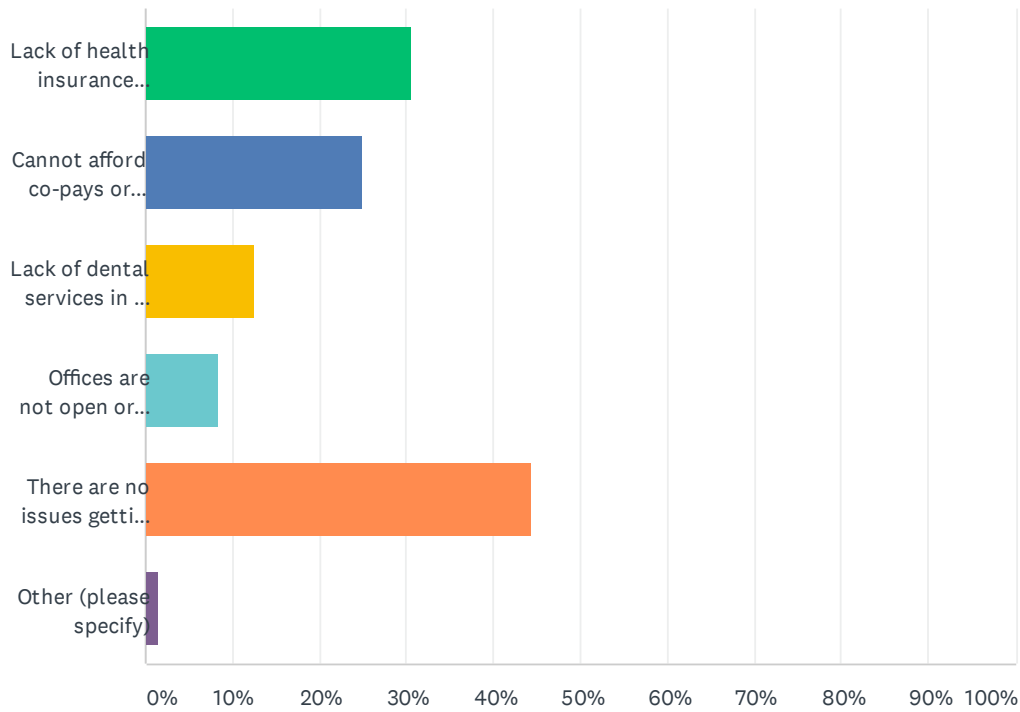

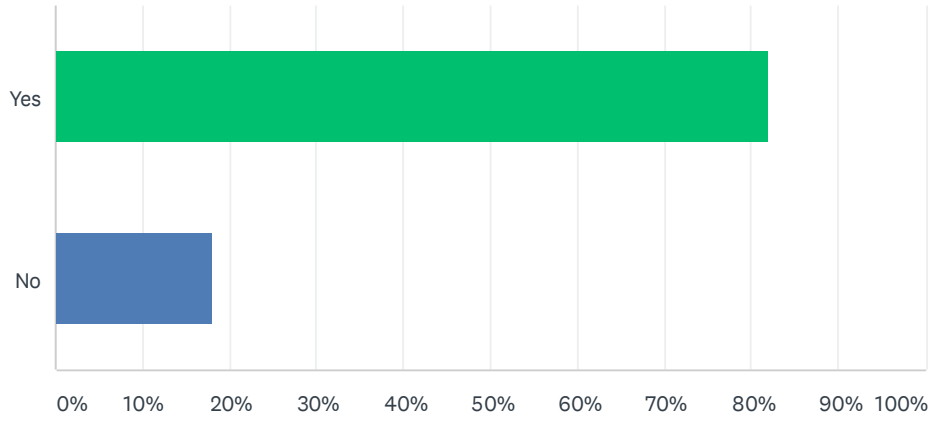

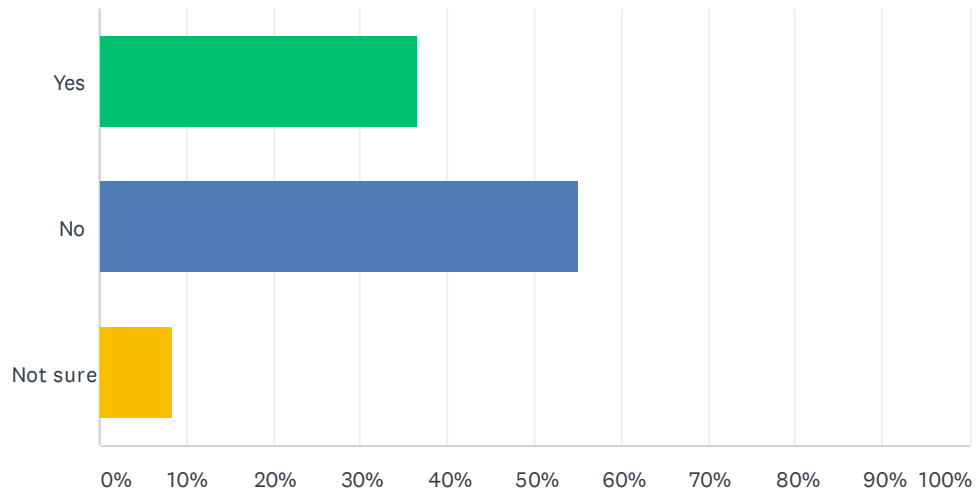

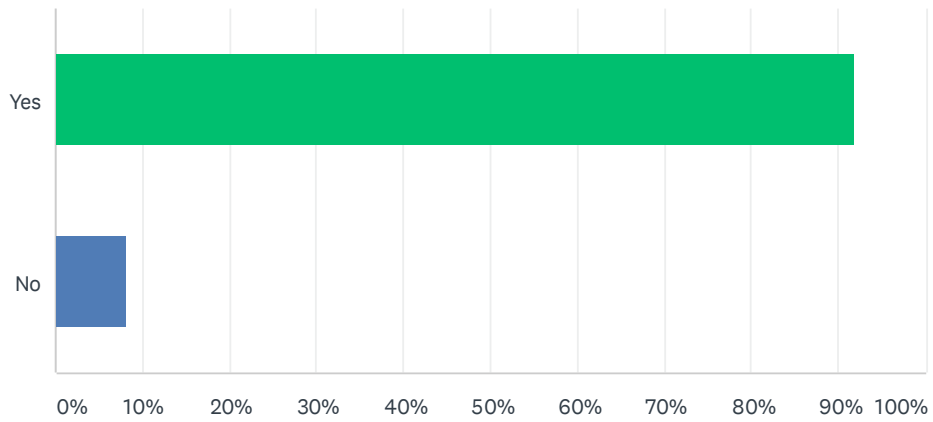

Q32 Do you think access to quality shopping within walking distance is important to the neighborhood?

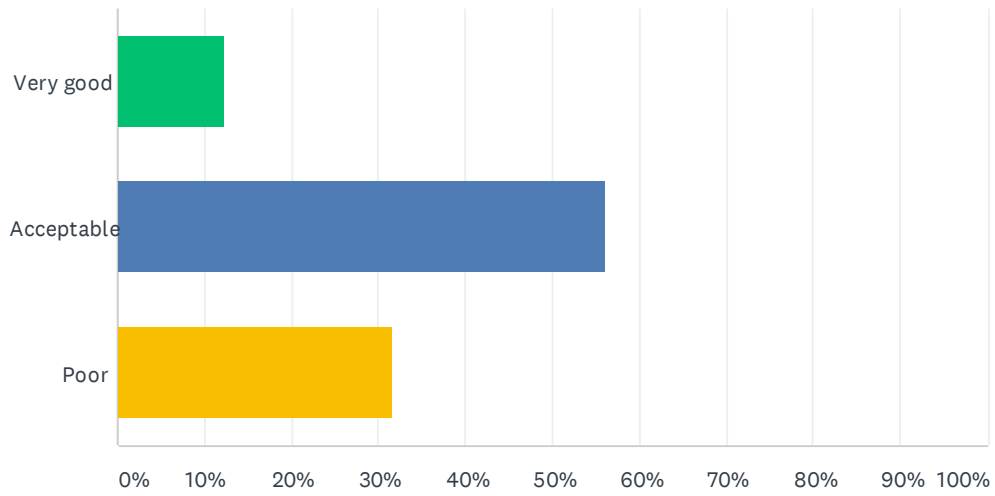

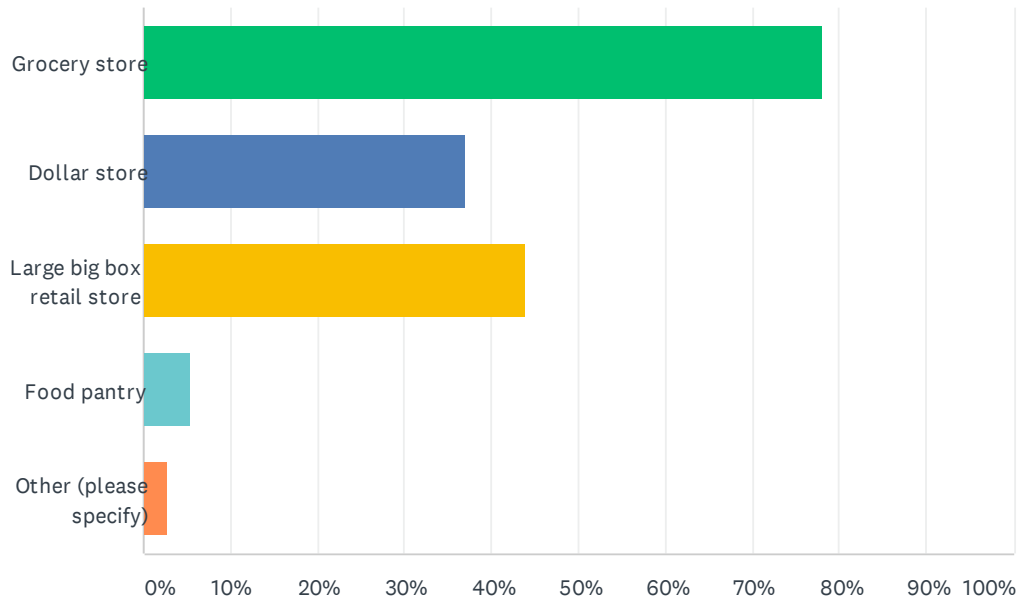

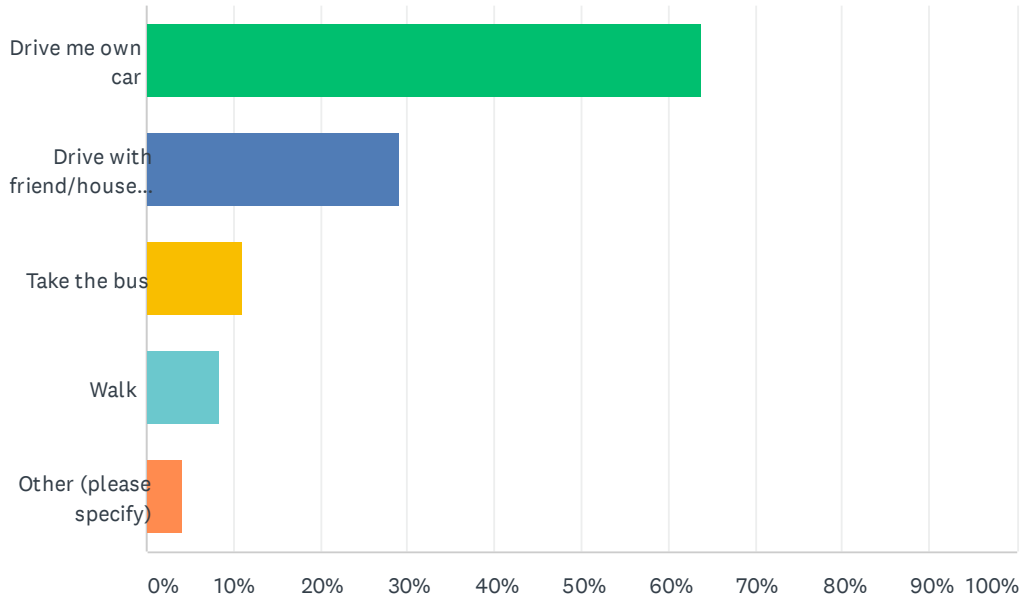

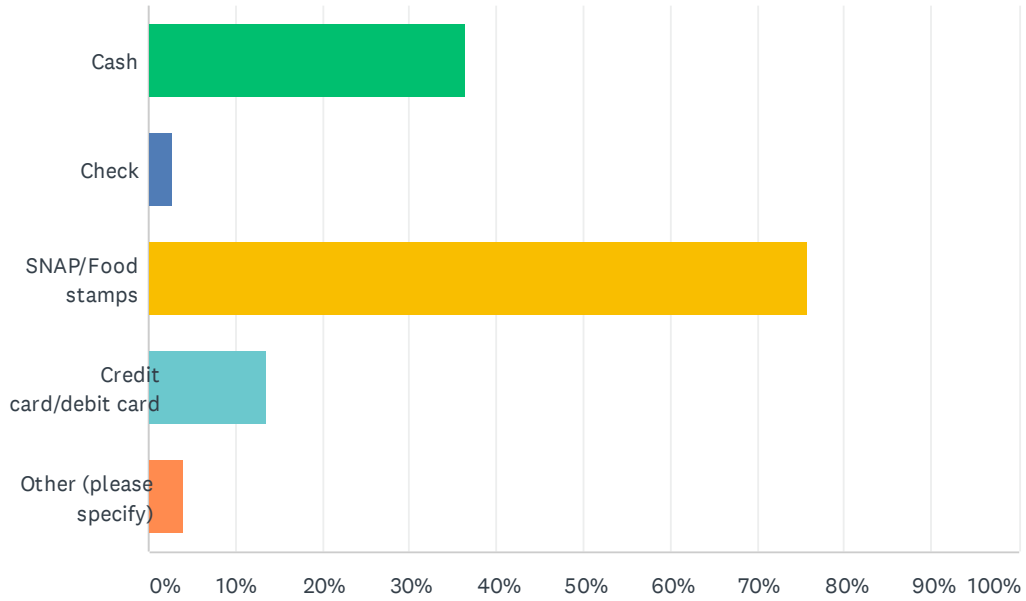

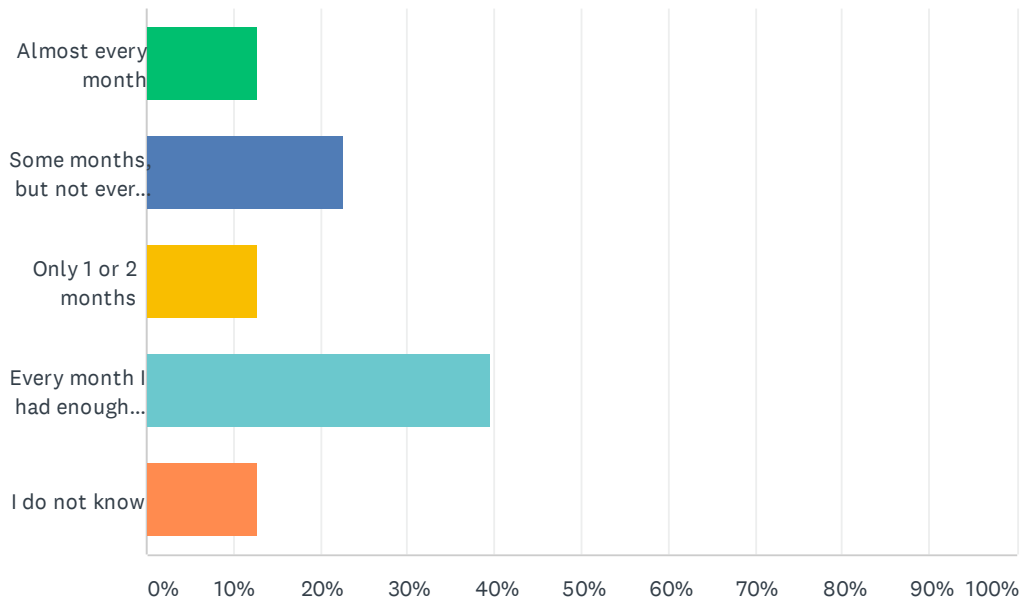

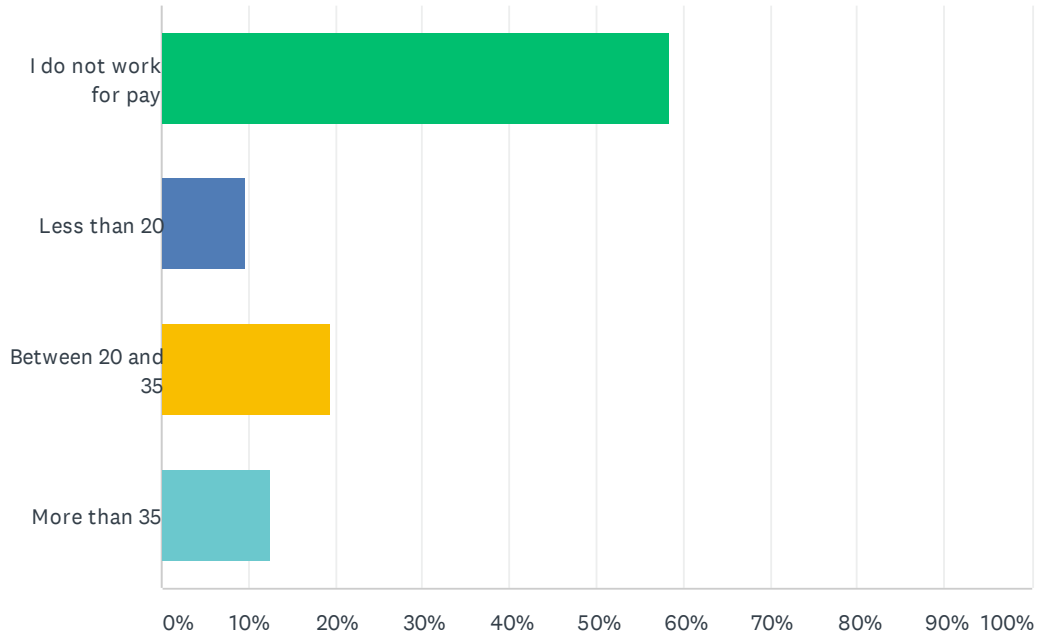

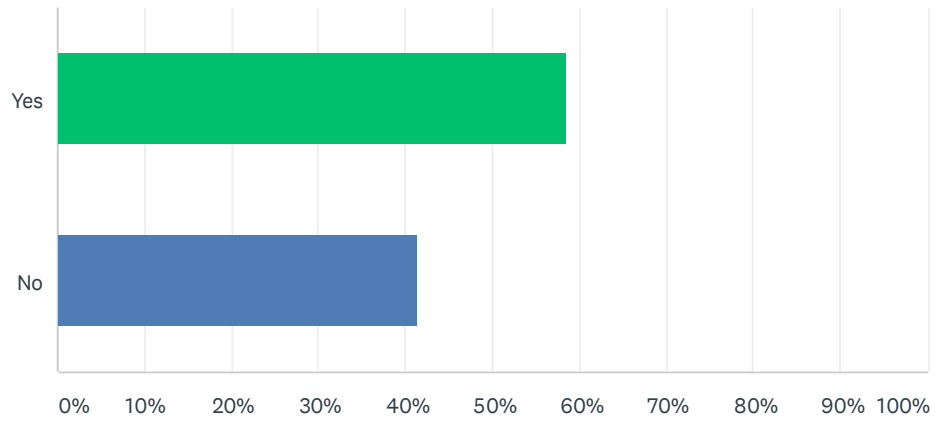

Q40 Are there adults in your household that are not employed?

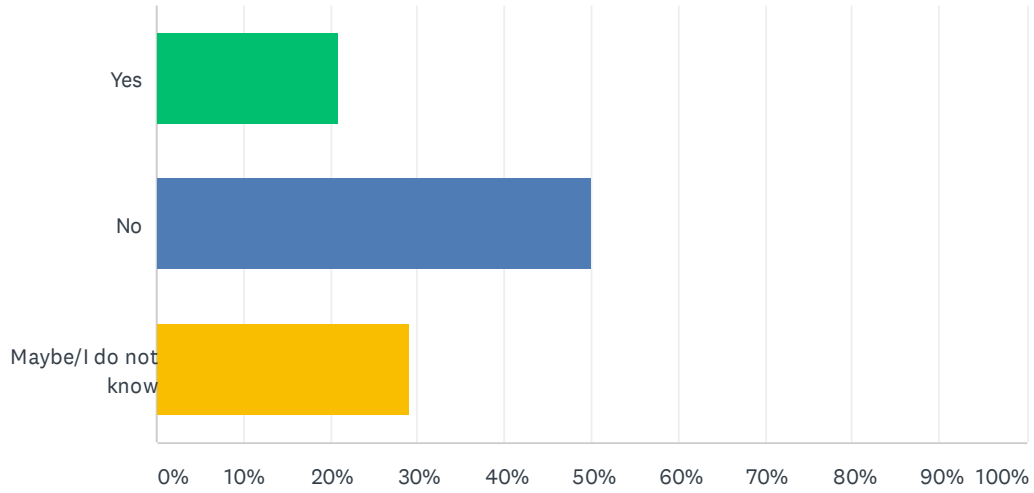

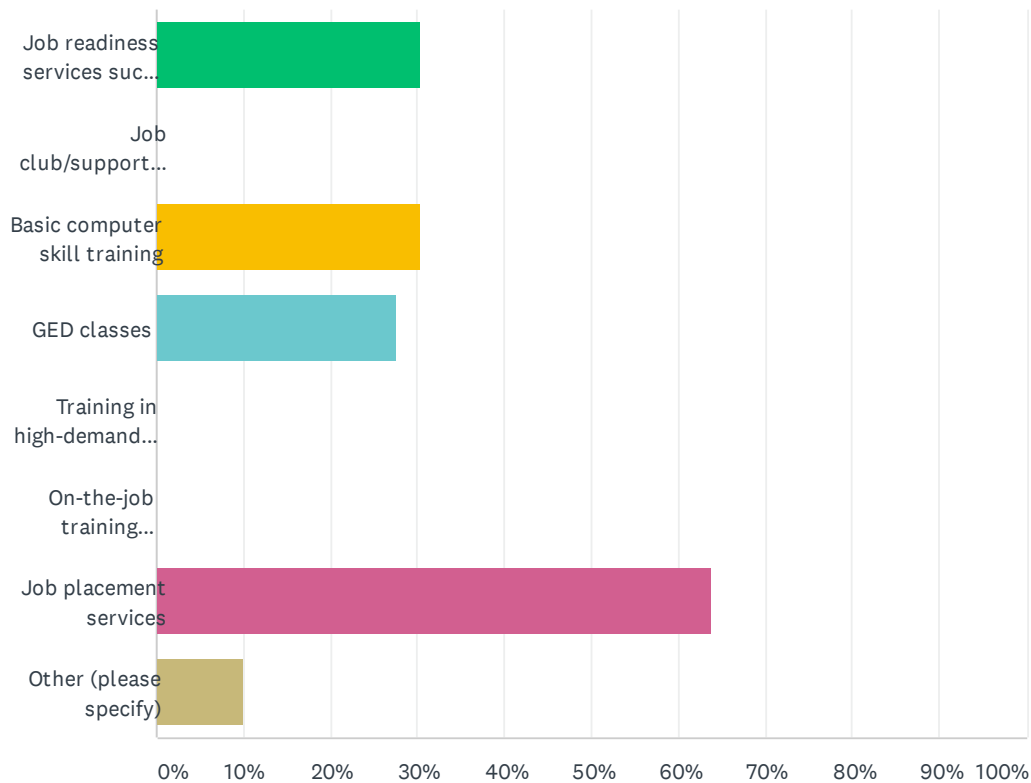

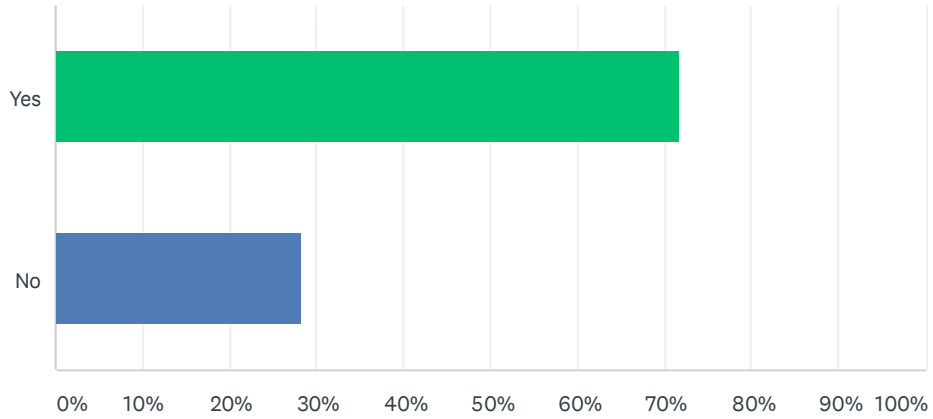

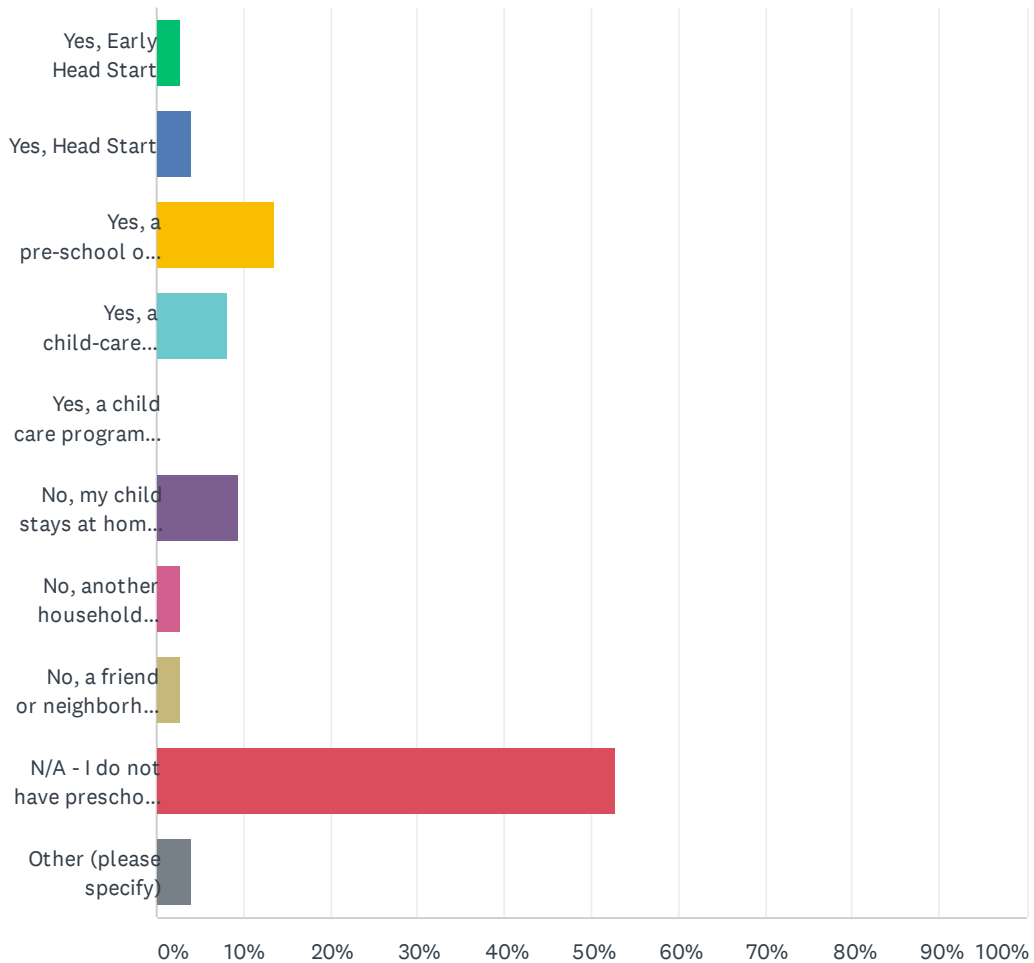

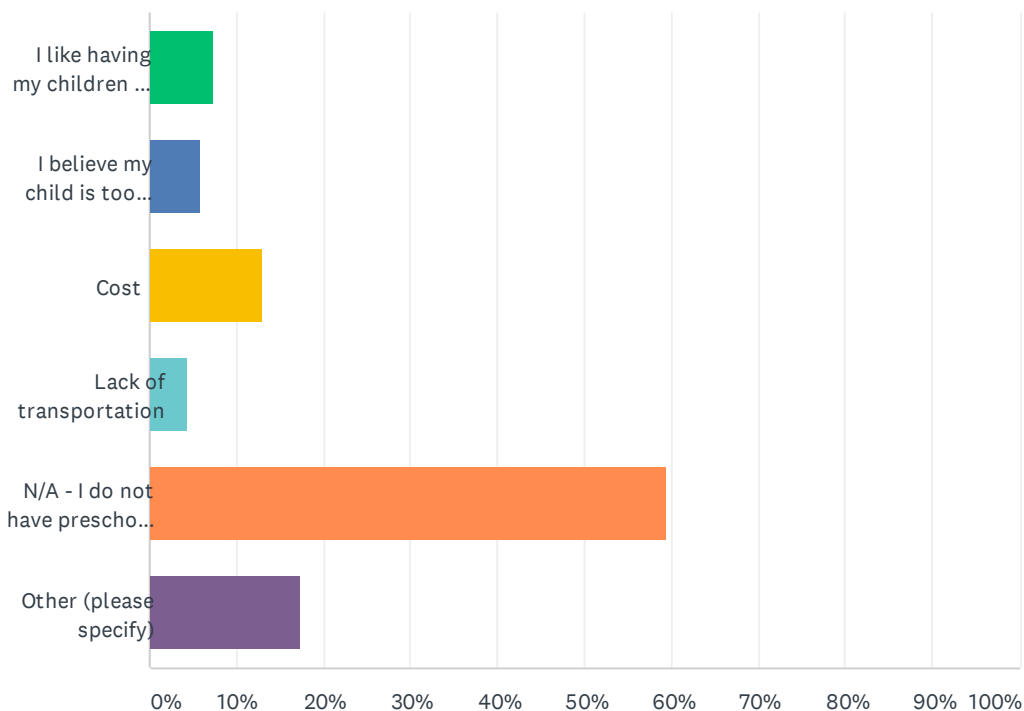

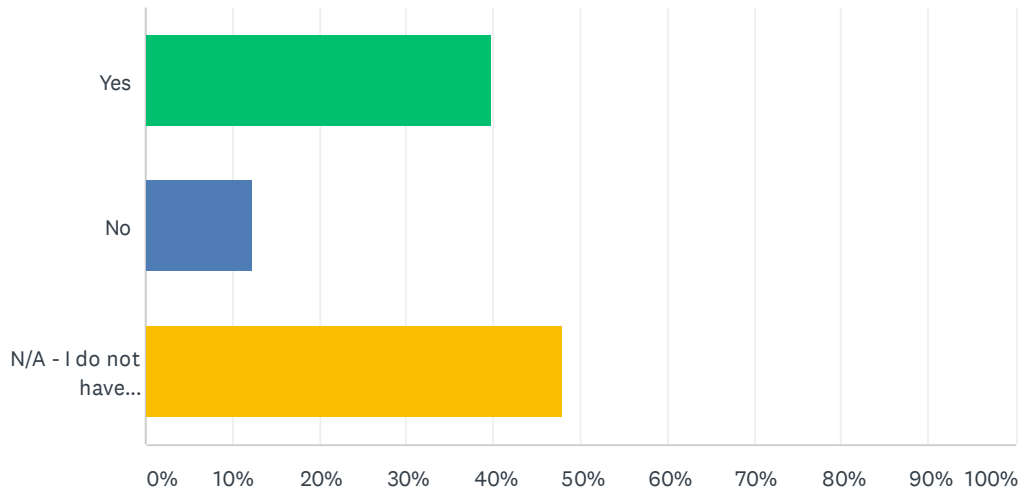

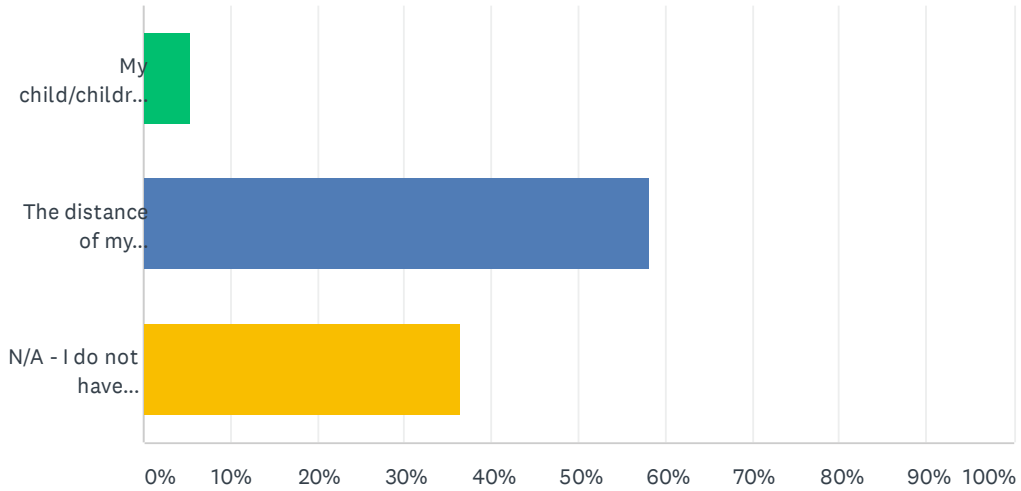

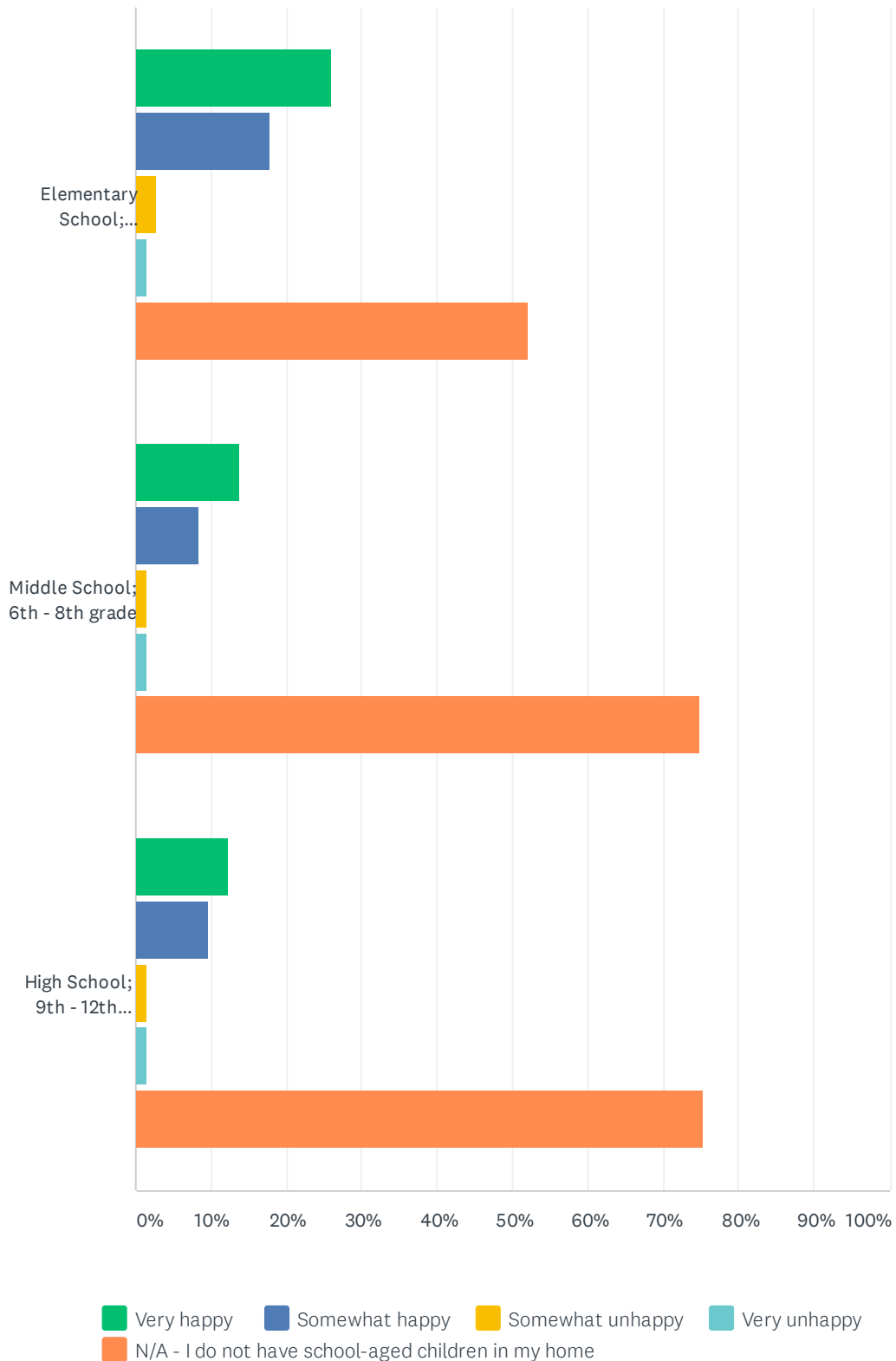

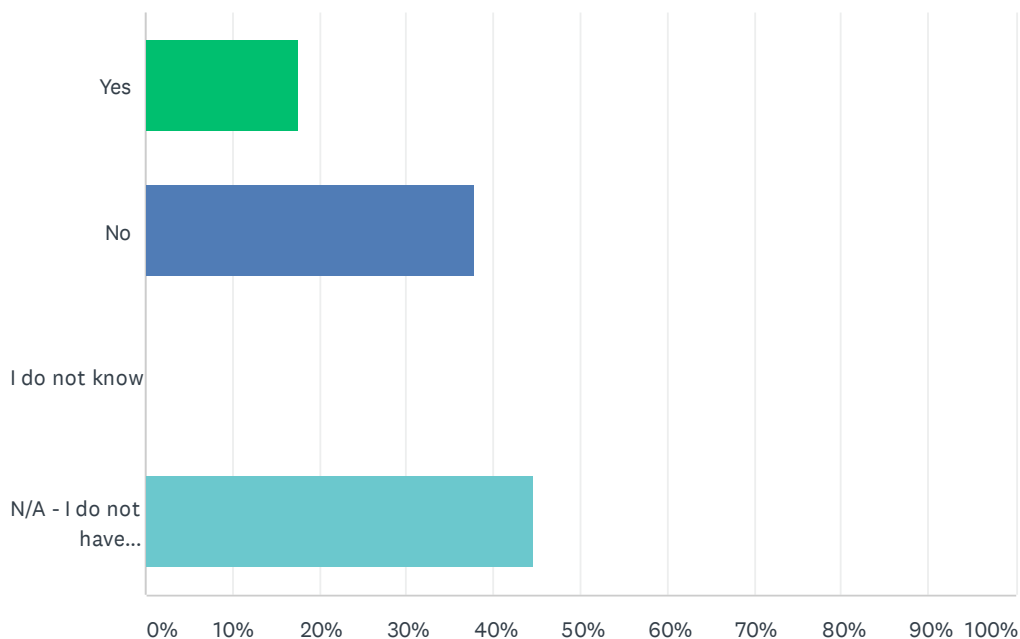

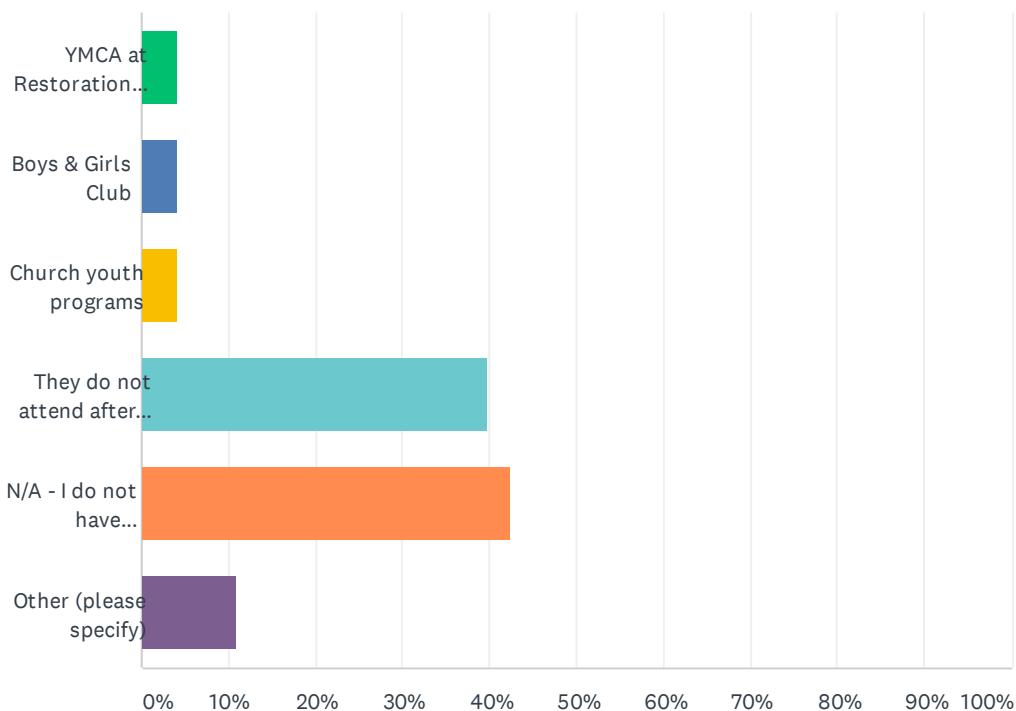

Q50 Where do your school-aged children go for after-school activities on a regular basis? (Choose all that apply)

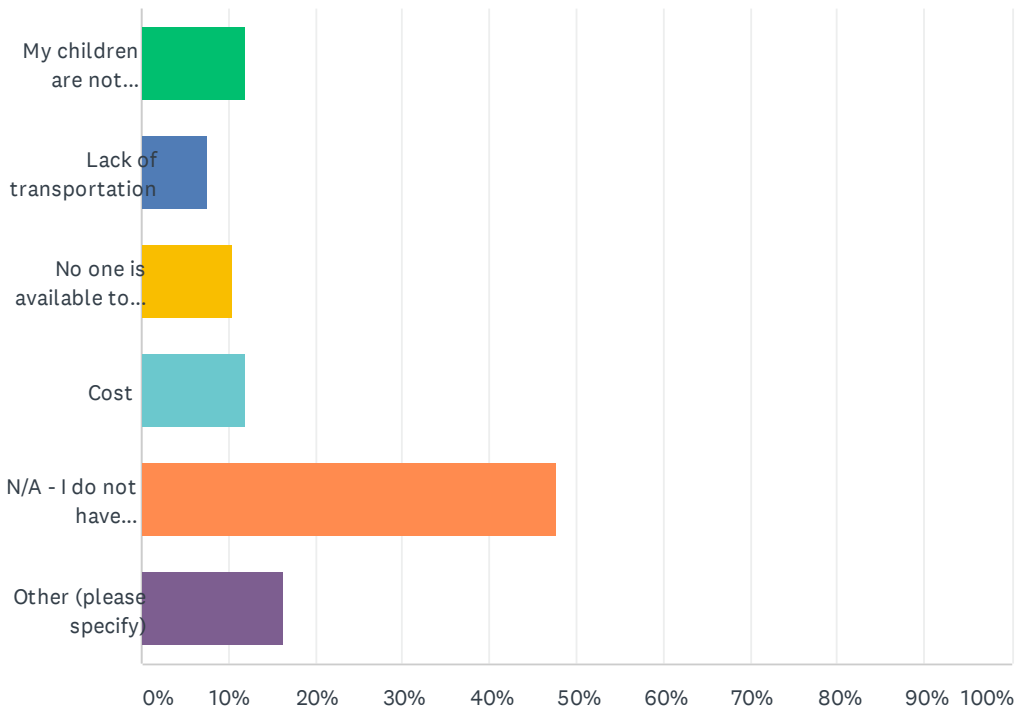

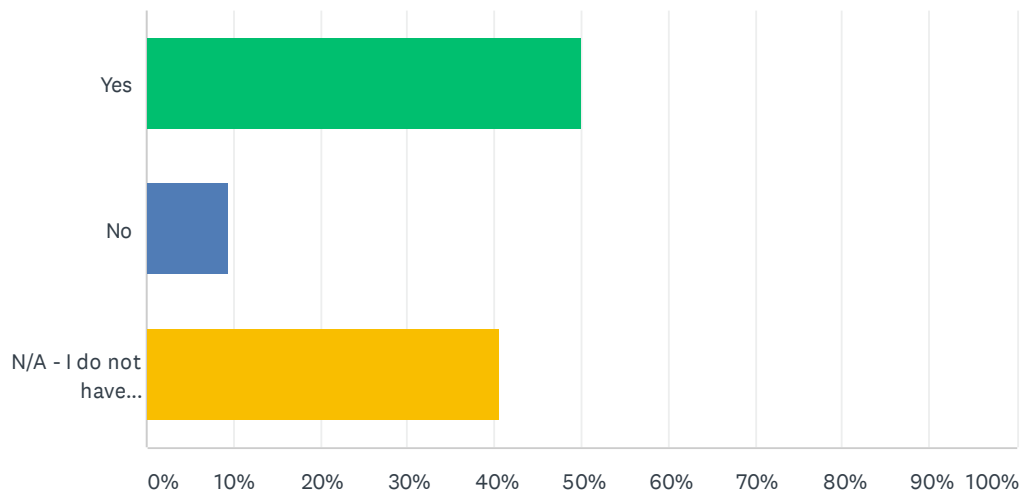

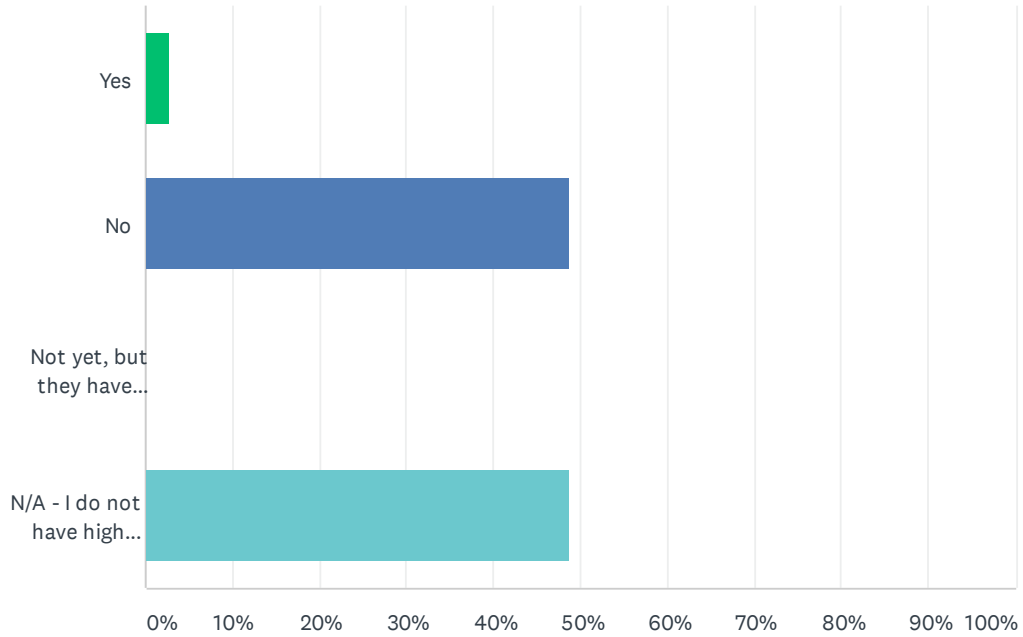

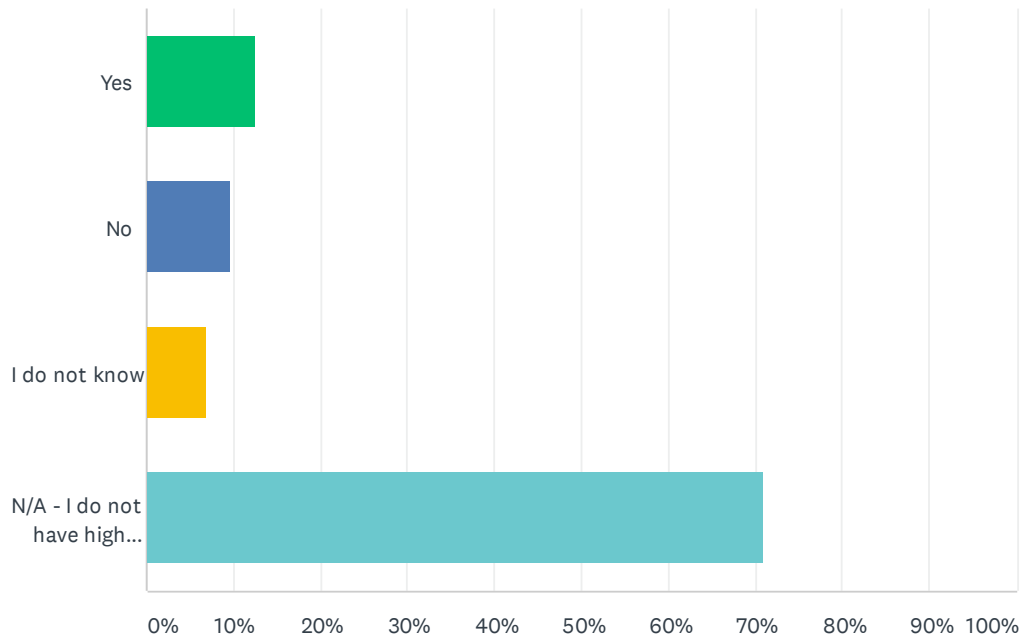

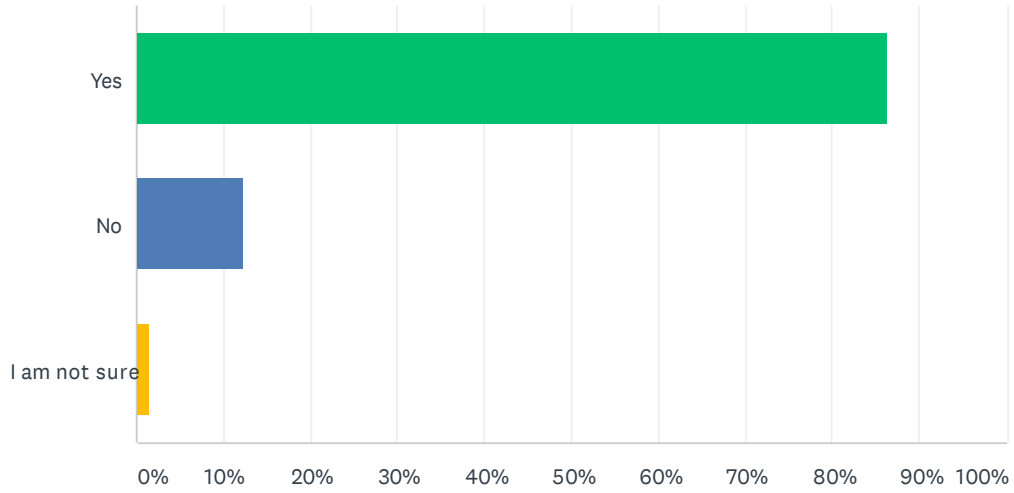

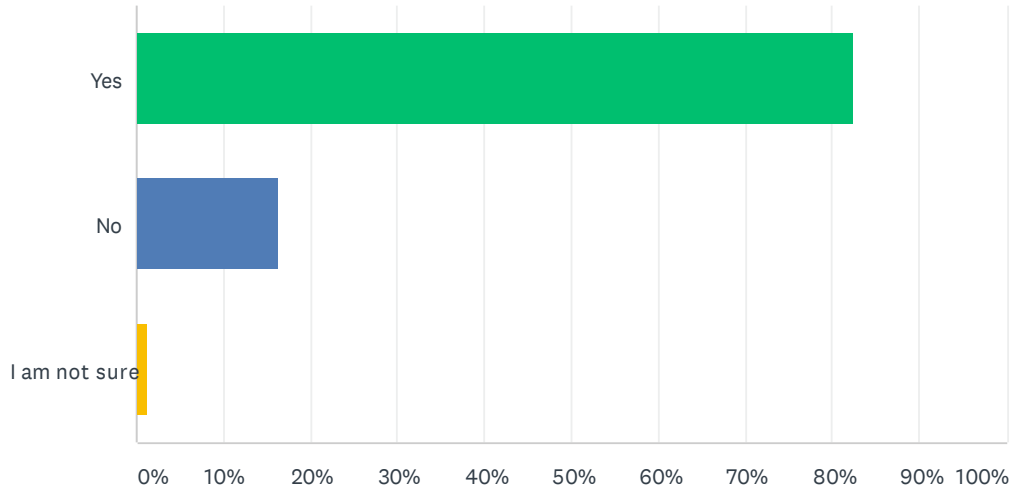

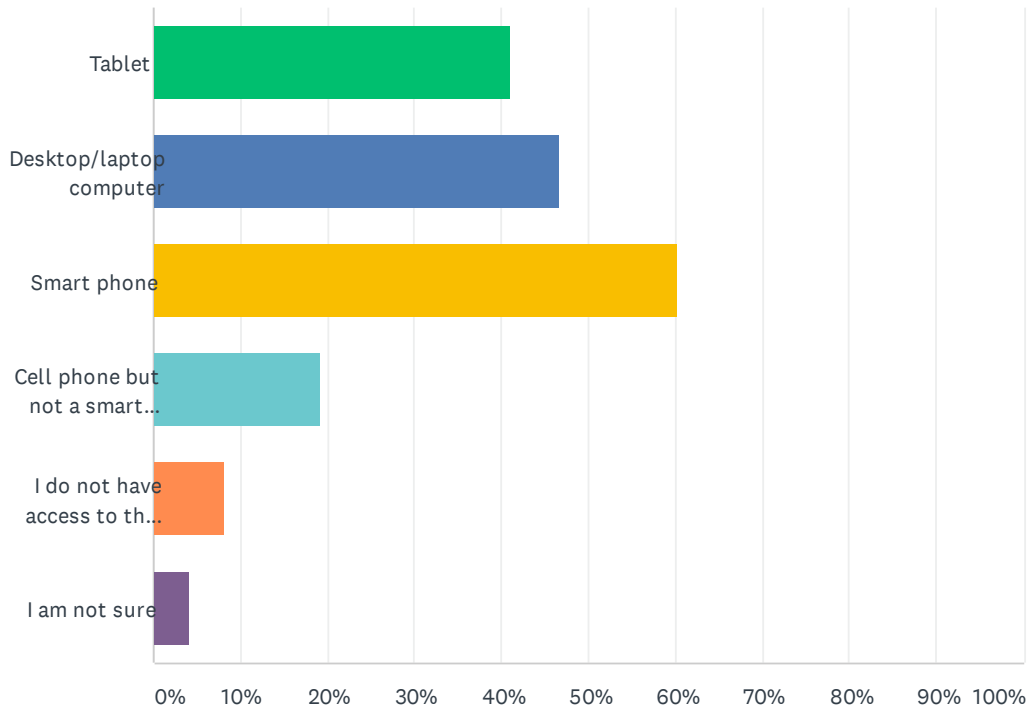

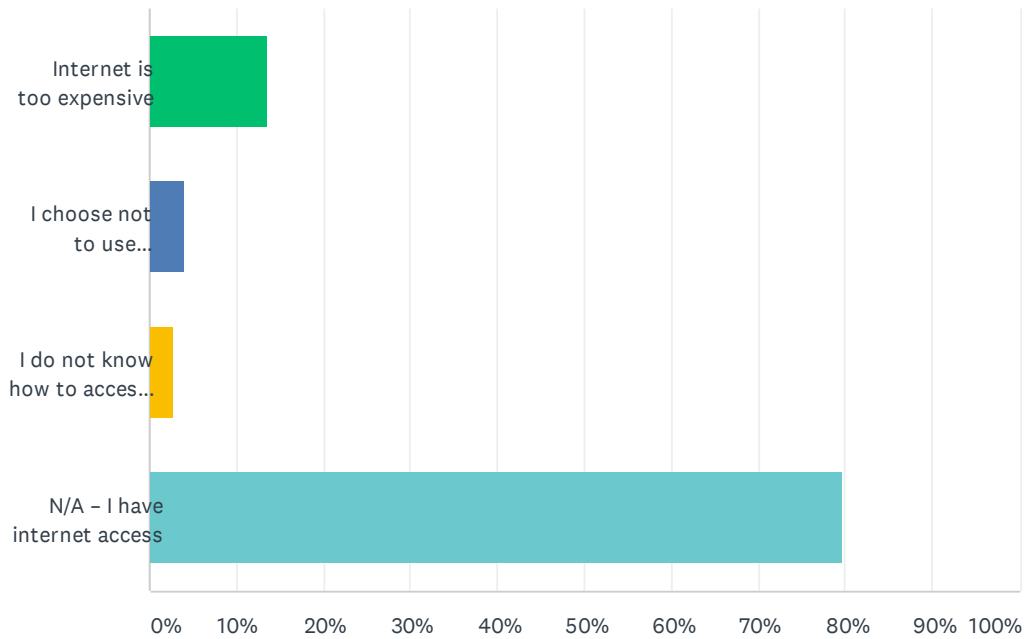
